#### Court summons RO firm's regional head on August 10

Marwaha, Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Chandigarh, has summoned Rakesh Sharma, regional head, M/s Kent RO Systems Limited, Sector 59, Noida (UP), to appear before the court on August 10 to face trial for the commission of offence punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

The court passed the order on a application filed by Puneet proprietor of M/s Enterprises, Mani Goval counsel through Maira. Ramesh Kumar Bamal under Section 156(3) of the Criminal Procedure Code (CrPC), 1973, for directing the police to register an FIR against directors, vice-president and senior GM of M/s Kent RO Systems Limited, Noida (UP), for committing an offence of forgery, cheating, breach of trust, misrepresentation and other provisions of the IPC.

Puneet was working as the distributor of Kent RO Purifiers. In the application, he said accused Rakesh Sharma visited his office. After discussion, Puneet started purchasing Kent RO from accused against advance payments

He claimed that Rakesh asked him to deposit Rs 8.70 lakh for release of 60 units of water purifier. He deposited the total amount against two bills on September 19, 2019. He said after the receipt of payment, the accused neither sent the goods nor refunded the amount against two invoices. He said the invoice was also cancelled



He said a complaint was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, UT, but no action was taken by the police. The court, vide order dated April 20, 2022, treated the as criminal application complaint and the case was adjourned for the preliminary evidence of complainant.

After hearing the witnesses and perusal of the records, the court said it was clear that specific allegations had been levelled against accused No. 9

i.e. Rakesh only.
"It is clear that there is evidence that Rakesh induced the complainant to make payment of Rs 8.70 lakh for purchase of Kent RO Systems. Despite legal contract and having received the payment from the complainant, neither the goods were delivered nor the amount refunded. As such, prima facie, the complainant is able to fulfil all ingredients of offence of cheating as defined in Section 415 of the IPC and punishable under Section 420 of the IPC. In light of the discussion, there is prima facie sufficient ground to proceed against Rakesh for commission of offence punishable under Section 420 of the IPC. As such, Rakesh be summoned for August 10, 2023," said the court in the

### **HAL** envisages manufacturing of 480 fighter jets

Commissioner News Service NEW DELHI: In the next 14-15 years starting February next year, India needs to produce 480 fighter jets on its own — 380 for the IAF and 100 twin-engine jets for the Navy. How quickly can these jets be produced will define country's military readiness and self-reliance.

Indigenous Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas completed seven years of service in the Indian Air Force (IAF) on July 1. However, key questions remain on the speed of production of jets by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL).

The delay in making the first 40 Tejas (the ones the IAF is using now) jets is a bad memory. The IAF ordered 20 planes under a Page 2012 20 planes under a Rs 2,813crore contract in 2006 and another 20 under a Rs 5,989crore agreement

December 2010. All 40 were to be delivered by December



However, deliveries were completed in February this year years behind schedule.

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Defence, in its report to the House on March 21 this year, had spoken about the delay in making the Tejas jets.

The existing production capacity of HAL is up to 24 jets after the opening of a new facility at Nashik. In order to meet the target of 480 jets, the production capacity has to be enhanced to 40 jets per annum. "The deliveries of the 83

These four types of jets are about 250 in number and are operating on an extended lifecycle.

"A kilogram of tomatoes was sold at Rs 200 to Rs 250 per crate last year, but this year price ranged from Rs 1,200-1,600 for a crate of 24-kg and it was picking up on a daily basis by Rs 100 to Rs 200," said Rajiv

Kohli, a wholesale tomato trader who has been in business since 1970.

Traders are expecting the rates to soar further since tomatoes are not available in other states. It is for the first time that traders from as far as Uttar Pradesh are arriving at Solan to buy tomatoes. Despite being locally available, tomatoes are being sold at Rs 100 per kg in the market.
"We usually cater to the

northern states, besides states like Rajasthan. However, since the tomato

crop has suffered losses in Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka, buyers from all over the country are arriving in Solan," Kohli said. He added that the quantum of damage was higher than the previous Suresh Thakur, who has

been in the trade since the last 20 years, said, "Such exponential rise in the price of tomatoes was unprecedented and it is likely to rise further in the coming days.'

Solan will not be able to cater to the growing demand as a significant chunk of the crop was lost due to waterlogging in the fields. But, the growers are hoping to offset the losses with high prices. "The arrival of produce is at least 50 per cent less this vear," Thakur said.

that may have taken place during 2021-22 and 2022-23. The notification al so asked higher educational institutions to provide the information on the university activity monitoring portal of UGC by June 30.

"If any such incident comes to the notice of the authorities, action should be taken against theer ring official or faculty member promptly. The university and

its constituent or affiliated colleges should ensure that no official or faculty member indulges in any kind of discrimination against any community or category of students," the notification added. It also said that the univesities may constitute a committee to look into the complaints of discrimination received from SC/ST/OBC students or teachers and nonteaching staff.


