DERABASSI : Nothing gigantic happens in a day or two, it takes a month or more to overcast dense pollution fabric of green house gases. The quality of air, upkeep of environmental status help in determining the disease free life span of living beings and additional-

ly human beings along. In accordance with the data tabled on 1 August 2025, a few days ago, in the Lok Sabha under the NCAP (National Clean Air Air Programme) the most sensitive and flamboyant issue caught national attention. "Prompt, innovative, remedial series of action yet remains to be taken, as I was newly posted two day ago", said Navtesh Singla Chief Environmental Engineer incharge at the Regional Pollution Control Centre,

Mohali. The well orchestrated details of curing the environmental affliction reaching 98 ug/m3 during 2024-25 from 88 ug/m3 of during 2017-18, under the utter neglect of environmental regulation and violation of the Air (Prevention and Control of pollution act) section 21, 22, 1981, Water (Prevention and Control of pollution act) section 25, 26 section 1974, greenhouse gases, effluents were being wilfully discharged and neglected for want of unsaid peanuts. division has bagged despi-cable and worst designate in contravention of superb epitome as it has persistently been showing purportedly upward catastrophic alarms, nevertheless remained neglected in pres-ence of wide dissemination

of toxic gases.

Why the title of DeraBassi echoed might be due to the distinct quantum of emanation of green house gases from their chimneys and discharge unchecked effluents However, it was once Nectar Life Sciences disseminating carbon gases on Barwala road, was raided by the incumbent legislator,

action (due to unknown reasons) against the persistent breach of environmental law as never had there been a single challan against the discharge of toxic gases in the Dera Bassi Sub Division despite media's vociferous drum beats and wide coverage over green house gases and discharge of industrial effluents.

Several inhabitants of the sub division including Lalru located in close vicinity like Colonel DP Singh(Retd). Sunita Retd Biology teacher, Raj Rattan, (Retd) Industrial plant supervisor and Snr Journalist Madan Sharma have demanded stern action against the over lapses perpetrated by the pollution authorities.

Since the day, they learnt the lok Sabha event, have been cursing, condemning the role of pollution control centre. No control over pollution but inflammation had been created as unusual bodily pain, headaches are experienced for the past recent 3 ,4 months, but has recently been revealed by the parliamentarians in Lok Sabha. 
Mr Madan ,once eminent scribe of "Charrdi Kalan" pleaded louder about his unrelentable, unstoppable

#### Over 10 lakh economically weaker children deprived of education due to non-enforcement of law in the state: Jagmohan Singh Raju

CHANDIGARH : Issuing warning of contempt petitions in Punjab and Haryana Hıgr Court as government doesn't act immediately . All state governments are legally bound to provide free education to economically weaker children under the Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009, but the Punjab government has utterly failed to implement this law said Omkar Nath, Convenor of the RTE Act 2009 Action Committee, Punjab (Retired IAAS), and Jagmohan Singh Raju, Chairman of the K.S. Raju Legal Trust, Chandigarh (Retired IAS), during a press conference held at the Chandigarh Press Club.



#### Tree felling, illegally logs being sold, probe ordered by NGT

with an application submitted by Hardik Bhanot, unidentified individuals were cutting trees for commercial purposes on land protected under the Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 (PLPA), where such activities are strictly prohibited.

The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has taken cognisance of alleged illegal tree felling in a garden located in Bhainsa Tibba village, Sector 3, Mansa Devi Complex.

During the hearing held on July 29 before the Principal Bench in New Delhi, a three-member bench comprising chairperson Justice Prakash Shrivastava, Dr A Senthil Vel, and Dr Afroz Ahmad heard submissions from the applicant's counsel, Siddharth Mittal and Sumit Kumar Sharma. The applicant supported his allegations with specific khasra number details and submitted video footage (Annexure A-4) as evidence of the illegal felling, which he reportedly witnessed on



claimed to have seen logs being transported for commercial

gain. The tribunal has issued notices to the respondents and directed the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (PCCF), Panchkula, to conduct an immediate site inspection. The PCCF has also been asked to prevent any further illegal activity and take action against the responsible individuals if the claims are substantiated.

A separate action taken report must be filed by the PCCF at least one week before the next hearing scheduled on October 30. The NGT has also instructed the applicant to serve notice to all respondents and file an affidavit of service accordingly.

#### 30 services of transport deptt now available through Sewa Kendra from 8 am to 8 pm

Commissioner News Service MOHALI : Citizens may now visit the Sewa Kendra at their convenience to avail themselves of various govt services.

To facilitate easier access to public services, the operating hours of the Sewa Kendra located at the District Administrative Complex (DAC), Mohali, have now been extended from 8 am to 8 pm, Monday to Saturday. The Punjab Government has

significantly expanded the range of services offered through service centres and doorstep delivery. Notably, 30 services of the Transport Department, including those related to Registration Certificates (RC) and Driving Licences (DL), have now been made available via these channels. As a result, residents no longer need to visit the RTO office or depend on different agents to complete these

formalities. Deputy Commissioner Komal Mittal stated that the Transport Department services recently launched through the Sewa Kendras and doorstep delivery include a wide range of driving licence-related facilities, such as new applications, change of address. change of name, duplicate learner's licences and duplicate licences. Additional services include renewal of licences (where there is no requirement to visit the test

track), replacement, correction



pre-registration, extract. surrender of licence, badge for public service vehicles, renewal of conductor licences, extension of the validity of learner's licences and international driving permits.

Similarly, RC-related services now offered include issuance of duplicate RCs, change of ownership of non-commercial vehicles, continuation of hire purchase agreements (in cases of ownership or name change), endorsement of hire purchase agreements and the issuing of fitness certificates for commercial vehicles—whether heavy, medium, three-wheeler four-wheeler, or LMV-as well as the collection of additional lifetime tax in cases involving

change of ownership. Citizens can now avail themselves of these services by calling the 1076 helpline and completing the process from the comfort of their homes, without the need for repeated office visits. The convenience charge for doorstep delivery services has also been reduced from Rs 120 to Rs 50.

#### **Special Intensive Revision prompts INDIA** bloc to meet over dinner on August 7, march to EC office on August 8

Commissioner News Service NEW DELHI : Opposition parties planning to take out a march to the office of the Election Commission of India on August 8 in protest against the SIR of electoral rolls exercise, they said.

Opposition INDIA bloc leaders are likely to meet over dinner on August 7 to discuss strategy over the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) issue, sources said on Sunday.

This comes amid a standoff on the SIR issue in the Session Monsoon Parliament, which has been a washout as the Opposition's demand for a discussion has failed to draw a positive response from the ruling alliance

According to the sources, the INDIA bloc party leaders will hold a dinner meeting on August 7 to discuss their strategy on the SIR issue. The meeting also comes as the election for the post of Vice-President has been announced, and several leaders have



indicated that they may also field a joint candidate.

Opposition parties have expressed apprehension over the SIR exercise in Bihar, warning that it would lead to disenfranchisement of many, and have termed it as "votebandi" and "vote-chori". The INDIA bloc parties have been protesting inside and outside Parliament. Affairs

Parliamentary Minister Kiren Rijiju on Friday cited a ruling by former Lok Sabha Speaker Balram Jakhar that the House cannot debate the functioning of a constitutional body like the EC to suggest the government's disapproval of the Opposition's demand for He, however, added that it

was for the Chairs of the Lok

Sabha and the Rajya Sabha to take a call on the issue.

Opposition parties, meanwhile, have said they will continue their protests to press for the debate, and if the government does not agree to a discussion on the issue in Parliament, the Monsoon Session may end up being a wash-out.

Trinamool Congress leader Derek O'Brien on Sunday said the Opposition will give "tutorials" to the "shaky coalition" Modi Parliament procedure and how to discuss the issue. The ruling BJP is "scared" of discussing the SIR under way in Bihar, he said and called

the exercise "silent invisible rigging."

## **Bharatiya Bhasha Pustak** scheme to provide digital access

NEW DELHI: Groundwork for implementation of digital access has been done. Not only the books will be translated but original content will also be created under the scheme said an official of the Union Education Ministry.

Higher education students will be able to study textbooks in 22 Indian languages as the Bharatiya Bhasha Pustak Scheme will be implemented to provide digital Indian language books.

This initiative will enhance learning by enabling students to understand subjects better in their own languages.

The scheme, announced in the Union Budget 2024-25, aims to make digital textbooks available in Indian languages for students. It will cater to all disciplines.

"The rollout will be digital.



For example, if a student of mechanical engineering is studying machine design. The initiative is to produce four books in different languages. The language will be of the state in which the college is located and the other languages will be based on the number of students in the class who want the book in their languages," an official

The scheme is rooted in the vision of the National Education Policy, which emphasises the use of Indian languages in education.

"We have done the mapping to identify the courses in

higher education institutions and the textbooks associated with them. There will be original books written as well. For example, in Manipur, a book will be translated in the local language followed by other languages. And original writing will also be done. Books in all disciplines will be written," the official said. At the undergraduate level, the courses in disciplines such as arts, commerce, science, law, agriculture and medicine will be included. The effort is being spearheaded by Grants University Commission and the Bhartiya Bhasha Samiti under the Ministry of Education.

"It will help students from linguistic different backgrounds to understand the subject better. It will also promote Indian languages," the official added.

## FSSAI seizes 273 kg "dates" of expired delivery from Flipkart ware

Commissioner News Service Coimbatore: The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) officials seized 273.6 kg of expired "dates" from a warehouse of e-commerce major Flipkart India Private Limited in Coimbatore district.

The stock of expired dates was found in the warehouse at Okkilipalayam

Palladam Road near Othakalmandapam July 17. The Food safety officers destroyed the expired dates and served a notice to the company, seeking explanation.

T. Anuradha, Designated Officer for FSSAI in Coimbatore, disclosed a total of 37 warehouses of e-commerce companies in Coimbatore district were searched in a threeday drive, based on instructions from the Health Secretary and the Commissioner of Food Safety, Tamil Nadu. As the warehouse of




Flipkart at Okkilipalayam was inspected, the FSSAI team found two batches of expired black dates of brand 'Manna', totally weighing 273.6 kg. While packages of one batch expired on May 19, 2025, the expiry date of others ended on May 30, 2025.

"Though expired, those packages were kept on storage racks along with other products meant for sale. Expired products should be kept separately and marked as 'not for sale'," said Dr. Anuradha. Though the company stated that it would return dates

manufacturer, the FSSAI did not permit it and destroyed the product. A statement from Flipkart said "In this instance, the expired products were already identified and segregated as part of our regular quality checks designed to remove nearexpiry or expired items from active inventory. These items were stored in a designated zone and were never intended for sale. Our advanced technology and robust processes ensure that only items with sufficient shelf life reach our

customers".

#### Modi flaunts Trump saying India would continue to purchase Russian Oil

Commissioner News Service New Delhi : Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi struck a defiant tone in the face of US President Donald Trump's tariff threats, and said it would continue to buy Russian oil. He has urged the nation to preferably buy local goods as his administration has signalled favourable economic trends.

Modi's government hasn't given India's oil refiners instructions to stop buying Russian oil, and no decision has been taken on whether to halt the purchases. Those people who are familiar

with the situation told Bloomberg, asking not to be named due to the risk ridden sensitivity of the matter. Both state-run and private refiners are allowed to buy from preferred sources, and crude purchases remain a commercial decision,



several of the people said. Over the weekend, Modi underscored the importance of shielding India's economic interests during uncertain global conditions. The comments came just days after the Trump administration imposed a 25% tariff on Indian exports to the US. The White House is stepping up threatening more action if India continues Russian oil purchases. 'The world economy is going through many apprehensions there is an atmosphere of insta-bility," Modi said at a rally in

'Now, whatever we buy, there should be only one scale: we will buy those things which have been made by the sweat of

an Indian."

India has become one of Trump's top targets as he looks to pressurise Russian President Vladimir Putin to end his war in Ukraine. The US president lashed out at India last week, criticizing it for joining the BRICS grouping of developing countries and maintaining close ties with Russia, saying "they can take their dead economies

down together.' The rebuke marked a stunning shift in tone for the US, which for years had overlooked India's close historical ties with Russia as it courted the nation as a counterweight in Asia to China.





## **Cultural tussle** remains behind Thailand,

Putrajaya (Kuala Lumupur) Both countries Thailand and Cambodia have agreed to an "immediate and unconditional" ceasefire in an effort to resolve deadly border clashes, said Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim

Acting Thai Prime Minister Phumtham Wechavachai and Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Manet met on Monday for ceasefire talks at Anwar's official residence in Malaysia's administrative Putrajaya.

"We have seen very positive development and results that would augur well for Cambodia and Thailand," Anwar said as he was flanked by Phumtham and Hun Manet.

The talks between the two warring Southeast Asian countries hosted by Anwar were aimed at halting fighting over a border dispute that has killed at least 35 people and displaced more than 270,000 from both sides of Thailand-Cambodia border. The ambassadors of the United

States and China were also present at the meeting. Anwar said US President Donald Trump and China's



countries as well as Malaysia "to find a peaceful resolution to the conflict"

He said on Monday that both Cambodia and Thailand have agreed to a ceasefire effective at midnight (17:00 GMT). A meeting between the military commanders of both nations will follow on Tuesday, he added. "This is a vital first step towards de-escalation and the restoration of peace and security," Anwar

Hun Manet said he had "a very good meeting and very good result that we hope to stop immediately the fighting that have caused many lives lost". He also praised Trump's "decisive" role in paving the way for the talks and the ceasefire, adding that he hopes the agreement will lead to the "rebuilding of trust and confidence' bouring Thailand.
