Rs 300 crore allocated tor fast-track Chandigarh-Baddi railway link

<u>Commissioner News Service</u> CHANDIGARH: The rail-ways ministry had allocated Rs 452.50 crore of the total outlay in the last fiscal, giving pace to the Chandigarh-Baddi railway link project. For follow up, another Rs 300 crore was allocated to expedite the completion of 33.23 km Chandigarh-Baddi railway line in the 2024-25 interim budget presented on Thursday.The Rs 1,540-crore rail link, which is expected to be completed by June 2025,

will connect Chandigarh to Baddi, an industrial hub in Himachal Pradesh's Solan district. Land for laying the railway line was acquired over the last four years. Work on the broad gauge line project had commenced in early August 2022. The railways ministry had allocated Rs 452.50 crore of the total out-



pace to the project. The rail line will have one station at Nanakpur and cover a total of 30 villages, including 21 in Haryana's Panchkula. Baddi-Barotiwala-Nalagarh (BBN) industrial belt is the largest pharmaceutical manufacturing hub in Asia. At least seven lakh people employed with the medical units have been waiting for the railway project since the industries started setting up here in the early The hub houses around 350

tion units, with an estimated annual business of Rs 30,000 crore, both domestic and international.As part of the 2024-25 interim budget, the central government also allocated Rs 93.26 crore for the redevelopment of Chandigarh railway station, aimed at improving passenger amenities.Being upgraded at a total cost of Rs 436.29 crore, the redeveloped Chandigarh station will have separate arrival and departure areas to provide passengers a comfortable and convenient travel experience. The revamp also includes a 72-metre-wide roof plaza over the platforms, state-ofthe-art lobbies, a food court, a paid lounge, an enquiry counter, and office and retail spaces. Two state-of-the-art foot-overbridges (FOBs) will also be built to ensure smooth passenger movement.



afford to piggyback on its allies in states where it is weak. Just as the Samajwadi Party or TMC or AAP should not be seeking seats in Himachal Pradesh, Telangana or Chhattisgarh or any other electorally bipolar state, the Congress needs to listen to Mamata in Bengal.

So, the Congress needs to seriously rework its coalition strategy to make its allies equal partners rather than house retainers. The Congress does not

GMDA draws infra roadmap for **Gurugram 2041**

augmentation plan of roads in the metropolitan town has been approved by CM Manohar Lal Khattar. Based on a projection that the city's population is likely to swell to 55 lakh by 2041, the plan put together by the School of Planning and Architecture in New Delhi draws a comprehensive infrastructure augmentation roadmap. Gurugram will be transformed

into the city of future by 2041, according to the first ever Social Infrastructure Development Plan prepared by the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDÁ).

This roadmap shall help authority in deciding, approving and executing its projects and planning budgets. "The authority's sole purpose is the transformation of Gurugram into millennium city and achieve the target in next two decades. This can be called the blue print of the vision, which will systematically direct the development of the city," said CEO PC Meena.

The plan focuses on a roadmap for authorities to follow in five areas education, healthcare, public safety,



recreation and socio-cultural facilities. The plan underlines the need for more schools daycare centres in residential clusters. multi-purpose of campuses government healthcare within facilities three kilometres, parks in colonies, police posts and old-age

In the education sector, the assessment concluded that the five existing universities and another eight nursing and paramedical training institutes would meet the needs of the residents at the district level by 2041

homes.

But the city would need another 750 nursery schools, 430 more primary schools, and 686 secondary and senior secondary schools over the next two decades. Currently, there are 545 nursery schools, 279 primary schools, and 412 secondary and senior secondary schools in the city. On the health front, the city would need two more general hospitals, a civil hospital and six veterinary hospitals. It currently has two governmentrun civil hospitals and five

veterinary hospitals. About 210 speciality hospitals, diagnostic centres would be needed by 2041, 250 dispensaries and clinics, 25 nursing homes and maternity

centres too.
On public safety, the plan noted that there are 25 police posts in sectors, which need at least nine more, especially in Old Gurgaon and the new sectors that are now lined with housing societies.

For recreation the plan seeks four district parks, 26 community parks and 747 neighbourhood parks in addition to sports complexes and a stadium. On sociocultural activities, the key takeaway was the need for cultural centres, old-age homes (22), orphanages (16), night shelters (5), hostels for working people (3), and cremation and burial grounds (24) over the next 18 years.

India to emerge 3rd largest economy with GDP of \$5 trillion in 3 years : Finance Ministry

NEW DELHI: Ten years ago,
India was the 10th largest economy in the world, with a GDP of USD 1.9 trillion at current market prices.

It is the 5th largest with a GDP of USD 3.7 trillion (estimate FY24), despite the pandemic and despite inheriting an economy with macro imbalances and a broken financial sector, said the ministry's January 2024 review of the economy.

India is expected to become the third-largest economy in the world with a GDP of USD 5 trillion in the next three years and touch USD 7 trillion by 2030 on the back of continued reforms, the Finance Ministry said on Monday.

'This ten-year journey is marked by several reforms, both substantive incremental, which have significantly contributed to the country's economic progress,"

These reforms, it added, have also delivered an economic resilience that the country will need to deal with unanticipated



global shocks in the future. The ministry said that in the next three years, India is expected to become the thirdlargest economy in the world. with a GDP of USD 5 trillion. government

however, set a higher goal of becoming a 'developed country' by 2047. With the journey of reforms continuing, this goal is achievable," it said. Nirmala Sitharamanheaded ministry stressed that the reforms will be more purposeful and fruitful with full participation of

The participation of states will fuller when reforms changes encompass governance at the district, block, and village levels, making them citizen-friendly

and small business-friendly and in areas such as health, education, land and labour, in which states have a big role to play, it said. The strength of the domestic

demand has driven the economy to a 7 per cent-plus growth rate in the last three years...in FY25, real GDP growth will likely be closer to 7 per cent," said the review report, and added there is, however, considerable scope for the growth rate to rise well above 7 per cent by 2030.

The review observed that it is eminently possible for the Indian economy to grow in the coming years at a rate above 7 per cent on the strength of the financial sector and other recent and future structural reforms. Only the elevated risk of geopolitical conflicts is an area of concern.

"Furthermore, under reasonable set of assumptions with respect to the inflation differentials and the exchange rate, India can aspire to become a USD 7 trillion economy in the next six to seven years (by
