Pollution Control sleuths breach environmental law on open 'sewages'

Pungent stench being germinated by untreated sewage of town

Zirakpur: Along Sukhna Choe and Ghaggar river heavy quantum of sewage is being dumped round the clock . The consequential pollution there from is being disseminated uncontrolled and unregulated , destroying the human and environmental life. Polluted water is the resultant consequence of the violation of Water (Pollution),

sec 25, 26, act 1974, air pollution sec 21, 22 act 1981 and environmental pollution Act 1986. The unchecked free flow of pollution, though diseased was invisible , still was caught and cognizance taken up on higher pedestal by the Justice (Retd) Sant Parkash, Chairman Punjab State Human Right Commission . The dismal , sluggish outcome is being

watched with serious concern by the spate of poor patients in the hospitals where impatient long queues are seen waiting for their turn. It is now high time , if the 24 hours long continuity of sewage dump is not checked and hammered by the Regional Pollution Control authorities Mohali who has been a mute spectator for the past consider-

able time ,who would cleanse the horizons and enviromental space of Z i r a k p u r . The Sewerage Treatment Plant here had been lying flatly nose dived for the past over 3 years but shown under maintenance which is rubbishly false.. On the contrary, facts reveal no maintenance can be allowed for years together. The plant 17.3 MLD must be serviced

and it's functionality must be brought alive, but is being subjected to scourge . And other side , no construction afresh for another treatment plant is going on , since there is no availability of land, with the sewerage board. The smaller plant fails to shoulder the elephantine sewage load and repeatedly collapses. A large number of govern-

ment , private hospitals are becoming testimony to these harsh proceedings and are seen flooded with the arrival of overwhelming strength of patients. Pollutants nevertheless invisible often implicate our eyes into slow burn, trigger into inflammation and inconvenience breathing difficult and induce lung cancer too. Pollution destroys human and environmental health in

mammoth number. The threat of pollution turns into major cause of premature deaths and diseases, in ultimate known cause of particular lung cancer. It may be underlined that uncontrolled pollution always germinates inflammation, asthma,obesity, breast cancer, joint pains and lung cancer. On contacting Regional Pollution Control I/C, Chief Environmental

Engineer, Rantez Sharma said Zirakpur had had 17.3 MLD STP and bigger was being constructed at Sanouli village. The XEN perhaps didn't have requisite knowledge that no STP was working for the past 3 years as its functionality had collapsed due to heavy load on sewage pipes.The construction of new STP would start only after the land is procured.

CHB cancels allotment of 2 altered houses,vacation ordered

In about 90% of the houses of Chandigarh Housing Board, people have made some changes according to their needs. Allottees have been demanding regularization of need based changes for many years. Now, due to some changes, the allotment of two houses has been cancelled by CHB. One house is in Sector-45 and the other is in Sector-47. During inspection, the board found four different violations in the house of Sector-45. Illegal construction on the



ground floor (new construction), the verandah on the back side was converted into a room. Toilet, verandah and room in front of government land/garage area and shade with glazing in illegal construction on the ground floor. Three of these constructions were old. As per the instructions of CHB,

a show cause notice was given to the allottee for this in 2017. In this, a hearing was called on 24 April 2017, but after several notices and hearings Despite this, the allottee did not remove the construction. After not appearing for the hearing on 26 October 2023, it was decided that the process of cancelling the allotment of the house should be started by inspecting it again. Inspection was done on 30 November 2023, in which the old encroachments were not removed.

Fire Deptt mulls serving seal of coaching centres

Modi to attend swear in ceremony of Nayab Singh govt on Oct 17

New Delhi/P'kula : Nayab Singh Saini will be sworn in as the Chief Minister of Haryana at 10 am October 17, in the presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and senior leaders of the Bharatiya Janata Party, including Mr Saini's counterparts from other BJP-ruled states, sources revealed. The stint of Mr Saini would be reckoned as second term; since his first one began in March after Manohar Lal Khattar had quit to contest the Lok Sabha election. Mr Saini was seen then as a surprise pick to head the party in the heartland state, particularly with a General and Assembly election in the horizon. There has been speculation



amid rumours of a noneffective government and in 5n , t;:view of caste equations - he would be replaced, but BJP sources said that having played a key role in the party's big win, Mr Nayab Saini would be given a second slot. Some state leaders argued for Mr Saini, saying he had implemented schemes meant to benefit traders, youths, backward classes and government employees, turning around the anti-incumbency accumulated over the years against Mr Khattar's government.

Canada rejects Indian ideology on killing of Sikh separatist

Ottawa : Delhi's actions are 'unacceptable', claimed Prime Minister Justin Trudeau as tensions are soaring over Sikh separatist's murder. Trudeau accused India of making a 'fundamental error' as row over the killing of a Sikh separatist on Canadian soil last year, have seen both nations expel each other's diplomats.Mr Trudeau, with Minister of Foreign Affairs Melanie Joly, and Minister of Public Safety, Democratic Institutions and Intergovernmental Affairs Dominic LeBlanc, during a press conference about the probe into 'violent criminal activity in Canada with connections to India', on Parliament Hill in Ottawa, Canada on October 14, 2024. In a sharp escalation of diplomatic row between the



two countries, Canada on Monday (October 14, 2024) dr oveboth countries expel each other's Ambassadors. India "decided to expel" Ottawa's acting High Commissioner Stewart Wheeler, his deputy and four first secretaries. In an unusually sharp response, the Ministry of External Affairs described the Canadian allegations as "preposterous imputations", arguing that the matter was linked with the political challenges that the Trudeau government was facing on the domestic front in Canada.

NC must recalibrate, ground versions are different

In the present context, the political leadership of the National Conference has to be now transformative, seeking to articulate and pursue an alternative way forward for the state. This will, of course, include a social, economic and political vision as also strategies of navigating the process. In the Valley, this election served a major purpose, which was to give vent to feelings of rage and resentment. As in the parliamentary elections, this time too the vote was seen as replacing the stone. Significantly in Jammu, votes were cast in direct contrast to the Kashmir vote. This is akin to a prisoner's dilemma; a paradox that illustrates how two rational individuals acting in their own self-interest can lead to a sub-optimal outcome. The multiple changes — constitutional, legislative and administrative — have altered the warp and weft of the politics in Jammu and Kashmir. Over the past five years, every policy change has been perceived in the context of a threat to identity and a need for self-assertion. With the monopolistic mandate that it has been given by the Valley, along with a strong showing in the Pir Panchal region of Jammu, the party will need to recalibrate its politics, if not reinvent it. Its foundational ideology of “accession on the basis of autonomy” was dismantled in 2019 when Article 370 was abrogated. These elections have resulted in a massive political consolidation in Jammu and Kashmir, with almost all the political start-ups and Independents being decimated. All the smaller parties, proxies or no proxies, have been wiped out. The Peoples’ Democratic Party, which had declared itself to be the kingmaker rather prematurely, has been reduced to a rubble. The Congress has ensured that it stands on the periphery of irrelevance in the state. Where it could have easily won 10 to 12 seats in Jammu, it has managed to win just one, giving the BJP its highest ever tally of seats. The net result is that the new political order in J&K, post the elections, is fundamentally bipolar, with the National Conference on the one end and the BJP on the other. Though the National Conference has swept the Valley, it has not managed to increase its vote share the way in which the BJP has done in Jammu and the Valley. The bipolar political landscape could have been seen as positive development, except that it largely overlaps the regional and religious divide. While the National Conference, has, post the “ghar wapsi” of its rebels, got a handful of seats from Jammu and the regional minority community, the BJP has dominated the Jammu plains and got a presence in the Chenab region. There is no denying the fact that these elections have communalised the context of politics in Kashmir. As such, the mandate that has been given, while decisive, can become difficult and even divisive, depending on how the BJP-ruled Centre decides to play its politics in this sensitive state. Even as Jammu and Kashmir must reclaim its position as a fully empowered sub-national government, statehood and the legislative competence of the newly elected Assembly, what is important at this juncture is to recognise and redress the apprehensions, anxieties and aspirations of the people. Post August 5, 2019, saw a phase of desperation, leading to despair. As such, first, the National Conference government must give the people of Kashmir a voice and articulate the existential anxiety they have felt over the past five years.

Serious outages faced by telecom subscribers in Punjab, Chandigarh

CHANDIGARH : A large number of subscribers reported no access to the Internet and intermittent disruption in connectivity. As a result, they faced call distortion and data connectivity issues. Subscribers of major telecom companies in the Punjab circle including Chandigarh reported network outages around noon. According to users, the subscribers of Airtel and Vodafone Idea were impacted. A majority of subscribers complained about data services and some subscribers even reported network outage, especially during voice calls, even at the time of

filing this report. Many took to social media to highlight their plight. One of the Navdeep Singh wrote on X,” Calling system down in my area since 2 to 3 hours. Kindly solve the issue. Areas including Khanna, Mandi Gobindgarh & Amloh. @airtelindia” According to sources, the subscribers are facing issues because of 5G core issues. Sources further said that the telcos are working on the issues and will be rectified soon.” However, official communication regarding the issue was not received, till the filing of the report, despite being made attempt.

45 acres land orchestrated by Punjab for Metro depot in New Chandigarh

MOHALI : Forest Department, the Punjab Government has now confirmed that the land was ready to be released, pending final approval of the Chief Minister. In a boost to the long-awaited Tricity Metro project, the Punjab Government has finally agreed to allocate 45 acres (18 hectares) in New Chandigarh for the construction of a Metro depot. The depot will be crucial for inspection and maintenance works related to the upcoming Metro lines. The issue of land allotment for the depot had been a persistent hurdle in the project's progress. The UT Administration had sent multiple reminders to the Punjab Government, urging them to clarify their stance on the matter. A senior official said it had been decided to release 45 acres in New Chandigarh for the construction of the depot. The file has been sent to the Chief Minister for final approval, which is expected within a week. Once approved, the land will be handed over to the UT Administration, he



added. The matter was a key agenda item during the Unified Metro Transportation Authority (UMTA) meeting held on September 2. While this marks a positive step for the New Chandigarh depot, the Punjab Government has declined to provide land for another proposed depot in Zirakpur. In its place, an alternative depot will now be constructed in Sector 27, Panchkula, with approval already secured from the Haryana Government. The depot allotments are part of the larger Metro development plan for the Tricity, which will see construction beginning in 2027 as part of the first phase, with completion expected by 2034. Phase 2 of the project will commence post-2037, further expanding the city's metro connectivity.

UT brings ‘Colours of India’ in 10-day mela at Kalagram from November 29

The UT Administration has decided to hold 10-day 14th Chandigarh National Crafts Mela at Kalagram from November 29 to December 8. A meeting in this regard was held under the chairmanship of Hari Kallikkat, Secretary Culture. The main objective of the mela is to display traditional Indian handicrafts,

handlooms, folk traditions, flavours of rich Indian cuisines, folk music, folk instruments and folk dances of India. The timings of the mela will be from 11 am to 9.30 pm daily. The theme of the mela will be “Colours of India”. During the 10-day mela, there will be star cultural nights in which renowned artistes/groups will perform. To draw more footfall, theme-based photography competition will be organised by Lalit Kala Akademi.

12 sites allotted for sale of green crackers in Diwali festivities

CHANDIGARH : The Cracker Dealers Association has expressed resentment over the delay in starting the process for issuance of licence for selling firecrackers in the city. With the approaching of Diwali festival, the UT Administration has planned to give licence to 96 vendors for selling green firecrackers at 12 designated sites across the city. The UT Administrator has given approval to start the process of allotment of the sites to firecracker sellers. The office of the Deputy Commissioner (DC) is likely to issue a notification on the schedule for allotment of sites to vendors on Monday, in which the date of online application as well as the date of draw will be mentioned. There will be eight to 10 shops at each site. Vendors will be allowed to sell firecrackers for only three days. Last year, 790 people had applied for 96 sites. Applications will be sought from the interested vendors

online and the draw will also be held online ensuring transparency and ease of access for vendors. The Administration has decided to allow bursting of only green crackers for two hours between 8 pm and 10 pm on Diwali, October 31. On Gurmurb, November 15, the window will be from 4 am to 5 am and from 9 pm to 10 pm. Chirag Aggarwal, general secretary of the association, stated that the festival season had already started, but the UT Administration was yet to start the process for allotment of sites. Nearly, a fortnight was left for Diwali, and they were yet to place the order for purchase of green crackers, he said, adding that the delay would affect their business, as it would be difficult

to procure firecrackers at the last moment. In a letter to DC Vinay Pratap Singh, the association had requested that the process of draw of licences should have been initiated before the onset of the festival season so that only the successful applicants can make bookings with wholesalers. For availing the stock of crackers, the order booking have started by the wholesalers elsewhere. However in Chandigarh, the successful applicant could purchase crackers only after the draw of the licences by the administration, whereby the vendors suffer from last minute harassment.

Legislature Party Leader to be elected by Haryana BJP MLAs on October 16

CHANDIGARH : Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Home Minister Amit Shah, ministers and chief ministers of BJP-ruled states will attend the ceremony. The date for the oath-taking was “finalised” after Saini met Home Minister Amit Shah and other senior leaders in New Delhi following confirmation of PM Modi's availability from the Prime Minister's Office (PMO). The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has called a meeting of its newly-elected MLAs to elect their legislature

party leader here on October 16. The BJP has named Union Home Minister Amit Shah and Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav as central observers for the legislature party meet. Nayab Singh Saini, the CM face of the saffron party in

the Assembly poll, is expected to be chosen as the leader of the legislature party ahead of the swearing-in ceremony. For the second time in 10 years, Panchkula township in Chandigarh's periphery, will witness VVIP-studded swearing-in ceremony of the BJP government in Haryana on October 17. The BJP secured a third term in the Assembly polls in Haryana, results of which were declared on October 8. It won 48 seats against the Congress' 37 in the 90-member Assembly in the northern state.

Strength of stray cattle in Panchkula city to be surveyed by MC

PANCHKULA : The issue of conducting survey of stray cattle was discussed during a meeting of Panchkula development advisory committee. The Municipal Corporation has been sending stray cows to shelters. These shelters have already exhausted their capacity and are not in position to accommodate more animals. MC officials pointed out that they had till date sent 2,721 cows to different cow shelters in and around the city. He said, “But the cow shelters have now stopped accepting more animals citing shortage of space.” The local Municipal Corporation will now carry out a survey to count the number of stray cattle head in the city as well as those being kept

at various cow shelters to take a decision regarding the setting up of new cattle pounds and transportation of strays. Haryana Assembly Speaker Gian Chand Gupta said they should carry out a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters. He said, “Conduct a survey of animals being kept at cow shelters and those roaming around in the city. We will see if we have any space to keep the animals in the existing shelters else requisite land can be provided to

interested NGOs to open and run cow shelters.” Officials present at the meeting also discussed the dog bite incidents and sought stringent action in this regard. They said the district had recorded registration of as many as 5,699 dog bite cases at health institutions in merely six months this year. Gupta pointed out that the district administration had spent Rs 4 crore on the development of a pound at Sukhdarshanpur village for keeping stray dogs, but remained unsuccessful in its initiative. MC Commissioner Sachin Gupta said, “The law provides provisions for sterilisation of dogs. The canines also have to be dropped back to the place from where they were picked for sterilisation.”

Compounding regime of synthetic milk

Artificial imitation of natural milk remains harmful to human health. Its excessive use inflict very serious damage on human body causing swelling in the eyes and many other complication in the liver and kidney. The journey of synthetic milk, now a days, has been heading

from urban area to rural populace to acclimatise to their propensities. Our nation has been notoriously becoming famous, leaving concentration away from genuine natural milk. Now fait accompli, we are tolerating assortment by of chemicals, urea, by compulsion as the occupation of genuine dairy farming has been going in very lackadaisical race even government controlled units are losing curiosity in natural milk. What a catastrophic approach, but against whom? remains puzzling.

Working holiday visa opened
by Australia, 40000
Indians apply

AUSTRALIA : The newly opened visa, allows Indians aged 18 to 30 to live, work, and study in Australia for up to 12 months, marks a key step in strengthening ties between the two nations, he said at the launch event of Australian Working Holiday Maker programme. About 40,000 applications have been submitted in just two weeks for 1,000 spots under Australia's new Working Holiday Maker visa programme, Australian Assistant Minister for Immigration Matt Thistlethwaite said on Monday. The visa ballot process opened on October 1 and will close by the end of the month. Afterward, successful candidates will be randomly selected, and those chosen can begin their stay in Australia early next year, he said. Thistlethwaite noted that the visa offers young Indians an



opportunity to immerse themselves in Australian culture and gain work experience across various sectors. "The great thing about the Working Holiday Maker visa is that there are no restrictions on the jobs you can do. Till now, 40,000 applications have been received for the 1,000 visa spots," he said. While many participants are expected to work in hospitality and agriculture, they will also have the option to pursue short courses or improve their English skills, he added. This initiative reflects the close and growing relationship between the two countries, with nearly one million citizens of the Indian heritage now residing

in, Thistlethwaite said. He further emphasized that the visa program offers young Indians a "taste of what life in Australia is like," potentially encouraging them to return later on a student or skilled worker visas. Thistlethwaite highlighted the growing partnership between Australia and India. "The (Australian) Prime Minister used his experience and friendship with the Indian Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, to ensure improved and increased opportunities for young people from both communities to experience each other's cultures," he said. An official said that the program will run every year.

Top medical branch of
Army, Navy are led by
Women officers

CHANDIGARH : A tri-service entity, the Directorate General, Armed Forces Medical Services, directly reports to the Ministry of Defence on overall medical policy matters relating to the Armed Forces and the functioning of military medical establishments. Medical officers can be cross-posted to any of the three services, during which they wear the uniform and badges of rank of the respective service. With the appointment of Surgeon Vice Admiral Kavita Sahai as Director General Medical Services (Navy) on October 14, the medical branches of two out of the three Armed Forces are now headed by women officers. Earlier this month, another woman three-star officer, Surgeon Vice Admiral Arti Sarin, had scripted history when she took over as Director General, Armed Forces Medical Services (DGAfMS),



overseeing medical services in all three services. On August 1, Lt Gen Sadhna Nair had become the first woman officer to be appointed as Director General Medical Services (Army). Prior to this, she was serving as Director General Hospital Services (Armed Forces), in the equivalent rank of Air Marshal and was also the first woman to hold this post. There are a total of 10 posts of Lieutenant General and equivalent in the medical stream across all three services out of which three, including the top post are at present held by women officers.

Congress demands thorough
probe into discrepancy of EVM's,
Deepak Babaria offers to resign

NEW DELHI : Congress' Haryana in-charge Deepak Babaria on Monday said he has offered to resign from his post, taking moral responsibility for the assembly polls defeat. Babaria said he offered his resignation to the high command soon after the result of the Haryana assembly polls came out last week but no decision has been communicated to him over the matter. "Last week, after the results, I offered to resign. I offered to the high command that you can replace me. My health is not well and also it is my moral responsibility in the wake of the results. Keeping that in mind, I had told this to the high command that 'if you deem fit, you can replace me'," said Babaria. After the Lok Sabha polls also, I had offered to resign



as in-charge of Delhi, but no decision has been taken on that. Similarly, no decision has been taken (for Haryana), but it was my responsibility to offer (to resign)," he said. The Congress top brass last Thursday held a review meeting on the party's shock defeat in Haryana Assembly polls and decided to form a fact-finding team that will speak to all its candidates to find out the reasons for the debacle. Sources said the leaders during the meeting discussed the possible reasons for the "unexpected"

results in Haryana and decided to set up the team to ascertain the reasons behind such results and also look into complaints of "discrepancies" in EVMs, as alleged by party candidates. Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, former party chief Rahul Gandhi, AICC general secretary organisation KC Venugopal, AICC senior observers for the polls Ashok Gehlot and Ajay Maken, as well as AICC secretaries for the state, participated in the review meeting. AICC in-charge of Haryana Babaria joined the meeting online. The Congress has also demanded a thorough probe into "discrepancies" found in some Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) during the counting of votes of the Haryana polls and demanded that such EVMs should be sealed and secured pending the inquiry.

Amritsar NGO demands
enforcement of MC bylaws for
cleanliness in cities

AMRITSAR : The Amritsar Vikas Manch, along with its office bearers including Manmohan Singh Brar, Principal Kulwant Singh Ankhil, Dr Charanjit Singh Gumtala, president Harjap Singh Aujla and general secretary Surinderjit Singh Bittu stated that the Punjab Municipal (Sanitation and Public Health) Bylaws 2003 was enacted by the state government in 2003 on the lines of Singapore to ensure the cleanliness of cities. Social activists have demanded the strict implementation of Punjab Municipal (Sanitation and Public Health) Bylaws 2003 to make all villages and cities of Punjab, including Amritsar, free of pollution. Apart from this, garbage cannot be dumped, nor can anyone dump debris and other dirt on roads, parks and streets. It is prohibited to



wash cars on the roads and axe trees. Even during the cleaning of houses, water can't be used to wash floors as it is prohibited under this law. Several other instructions and guidelines under the Act have not been implemented by the Punjab government even after 21 years. Office-bearers of Amritsar Vikas Manch stated that this law applies to all types of municipal bodies, including villages. Just as challans are issued for traffic rule violations, challans should be issued to those who

violate these municipal bylaws, only then will there be improvement in cleanliness, the activists said. According to this law, a fine of up to Rs 1,000 can be imposed. The Chandigarh Municipal Corporation is issuing challans to those who dump plastic and garbage in the streets, footpaths, parks and create pollution. "The sanitary inspectors have been given body cameras which can make eight hours of video of the respective places. The Punjab government should also provide such body cameras to the sanitary inspectors. Our politicians and officers live in Chandigarh or often come and go to Chandigarh, they should also pay attention to this aspect so that our cities and villages can become clean and tidy," said Charanjit Singh Gumtala, patron of AVM.

Fake enforcement
directorate embezzles ret'd
professor of Rs 75 lakh

ALIGARH : 'Digital arrest' is a new cyber fraud, where the accused poses as law enforcement agency officials, like CBI or customs officials or ED, and threatens people of arrest by making video calls in the name of fake international parcels of banned drugs or money-laundering cases. A retired Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) professor was allegedly duped of more than Rs 75 lakh by fraudsters posing as Enforcement Directorate (ED) and putting her under 'digital arrest' for 10 days, police said on Sunday. An FIR was lodged on Friday by Qamar Jahan and the police immediately issued an alert to the banks concerned. Police found that the money had been routed through 21 different bank accounts, they said. Transactions worth Rs 13 lakh were blocked due to police intervention, they said. Cyber police station inspector VD Panday, who is investigating the case said the

victim was kept under "digital arrest for more than 10 days" during which the accused pressured Jahan to pay money to avoid arrest. The complainant told the police that she received the first call on September 28. The accused posed an Enforcement Directorate official and told her that she had conducted some dubious transactions, involving her in a money-laundering case. To avoid arrest, Jahan must deposit some money to the court, the accused told the victim. He gave her some bank account numbers and the victim complied with the demands and deposited more than Rs 75 lakh. However, two days ago she sensed that she had been duped and filed a complaint at the police station, they said. During the past few weeks, several cases of digital arrest have been reported in the state the police have issued advisories to the public stating that there is no provision for digital arrest.

This was the first FIR lodged this season for burning crop residue in Yamunanagar district, officials said. Prasad urged the officials to utilise satellite data and ground reports to actively track stubble-burning incidents and work

closely with the relevant departments and pollution control boards for swift response. He also stressed the need for effective outreach programmes to educate the farmers on the harmful effects of stubble-burning, urging the district authorities to promote eco-friendly crop residue management techniques and government subsidies for equipment like super seeders and happy seeders.

The civic body has received replies from a majority of the schools, following which the estate branch of the MC is busy segregating replies based on certain parameters.
"Since many schools, operating in the MC's jurisdiction, have claimed that they have been operating before 2017, when a fresh notification regarding closure or non-operation due to building bylaws of private schools in villa- ges came into existence, the department is now



segregating that how many schools have been operating before 2017 and how many after that. The school education department of the Chandigarh administration has communicated with the civic body in this regard too. The MC notice which Owas served on these private unrecognised schools said, "In compliance with the directions issued by the Chandigarh deputy commissioner in a meeting held on September 10 with regard to unrecognised

schools, running in Chandigarh, the MC has got a survey of the schools conducted as per the list shared by the DEO (district education officer) which are operating in violation of building bylaws (Chandigarh rural in-habitations construction and reconstruction building by-laws for villages falling in the UT, Chandigarh 2024). As per the said rules, notices have been issued to defaulters."

Chandigarh Polo club offers amenities for Arena polo



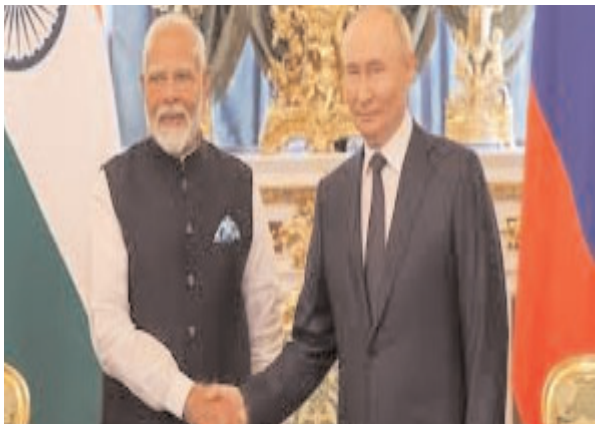

The committee noted that nuclear arsenals are being modernised, and the norm against their use is under pressure as new threats emerge.



The Nobel Committee praised Nihon Hidankyo for their unwavering efforts to generate and sustain global opposition to nuclear weapons, noting that their testimony has provided a unique, first-hand understanding of the incompressible pain and suffering caused by such weapons.

By sharing their personal stories of the devastation they experienced in August 1945, the Hibakusha - the survivors of Hiroshima and Nagasaki - have helped shape the international "nuclear taboo," a powerful norm stigmatising the use of nuclear arms as morally unacceptable. Japanese organisation Nihon Hidankyo has been awarded the Nobel Peace Prize 2024 for its efforts to achieve a

world free of nuclear weapons.
