WASHINGTON : International Campaign envisages to abolish Nuclear Weapons , declared Russia, China, France , USA, Israel, Pakistan, UK, India, and North Korea. Recent Geo- political events and rhetorics have catapulted concerns about the potential use of nuclear weapons leading to enhanced global attention and wider negotiations.

The spread of nuclear technology and the potential for new countries to develop nuclear weapons also contribute to the ongoing worry , anxiety and dialogue. The Arms Control Association and International legacy have engaged in reducing the number of nuclear arsenal and preventing further proliferation which fuels the combustible hostilities . The Arms Control Association is a non



profit organisation focused on reducing threats posed by nuclear, biological and chemical weapons. Their officials

advocate for arms control and disarmament focusing on preventing the spread of nuclear arsenals and promoting their even-



tual i elimination. In essence the ACA ' s role has to be a whistle blower for arms control and disarmament working to reduce the

threat of nuclear arsenal and ultimately create a world free of these weapons. All NATO allies are state parties in quelling the

hostilities and condemn the use of Nuclear , where in end extinction of the mankind would be reaching its threshold. The persistent danger of nuclear conflict has been magnifying due to a new arms race fuelled by technological advancement , increased regional uncertainties , tensions and the erosion of arms control agreements . Like Artificial

Intelligence technology and Cyber capabilities are progressively evolving and changing the Nature of nuclear warfare. Such initiatives are making deterrence more complex, enhancing the risk of miscalculation or accidental use. The development and deployment of artificial intelligence space based assets and missile defence system are. reshaping nuclear strategies and deterrence doctrines.

Chandigarh: Speaking to media persons after attending a meeting convened by the joint parliamentary committee (JPC) led by PP Choudhary , Cheema said that he , along with AAP state president Aman Arora " completely rejected" the move . He added that it would be closely watched if the Congress would oppose the bill in Parliament or decide to lend its hidden support to the Constitution (129th Amendment) Bill , 2024 . A senior SAD delegation led by Dr Daljit Singh Cheema and Balwinder Singh Bhundar presented

the party's concerns to Joint Parliamentary Committee reviewing proposed electoral reforms . voltage fluctuations have have been malfunctioning with generating troubles for every citizen. The elderly, sick, and children are facing persistent hardships. Prolonged power outages in the afternoon or darkness at night have left the public unable to sleep peacefully or find relief in this extreme

Israel launches blistering attacks on the heart of Iran's nuclear installations

Tehran : Iran deployed warplanes and drones previously smuggled into the country to assault key facilities and kill top generals and scientists — a barrage. Israeli military said it was necessary before its adversary got any closer to building an atomic weapon. Iran retaliated by unleashing scores of ballistic missiles of Israel where explosions flared in the skies over Jerusalem and Tel Aviv and shook the buildings below.

Why stampede did occur out of Bengaluru stadium

Things went horribly wrong, leading to a stampede that claimed 11 lives. The government could have redeemed itself if the Chief Minister or his deputy had resigned. It chose to “sacrifice” the police top brass and go after cricket officials! This was a selfish decision, which is sure to boomerang on the party. The tournament is now a yearly affair, much anticipated by youngsters. The goal of breaking down barriers between communities on the one hand and the people living in the slums and the police on the other was achieved. The power of cricket to unify was successfully tested. It has stood the test of time, particularly in riot-torn areas of the city. Where senior police officers got involved, the results were even better. The IPL teams are named and structured on the basis of states (Gujarat, Rajasthan, Punjab) or cities (Mumbai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Chennai, Kolkata, Delhi, Lucknow). The beauty of this arrangement is that the players in each team are drawn from across India and even beyond through auctions. The RCB team that won the tournament this year did not have any player from Bengaluru or even from the state (Karnataka) in its ranks. Yet, the people of the state and its government claimed ownership of the team — because it won. The state government, basking in the reflected glory of the RCB’s victory, ordered that the team, on its arrival at the Bengaluru

airport, be taken to the Vidhana Soudha for a ceremonial welcome by the Cabinet. It issued verbal orders to the police on the phone to cooperate with the m a k e s h i f t arrangements despite the lack of time to plan the bandobast. The winning team had already posted a message on social media that a victory parade would be organised. This message came at 7 am on June 4. The plan to felicitate the team at the Vidhana Soudha was finalised at 10:30 am. A victory in cricket can enthuse every supporter, even those who have never handled bat or ball. In any case, a message from the Chief Minister’s office could not have been ignored by the police top brass. Siddaramaiah, the jubilant CM, obviously expected the Police Commissioner to rise to the occasion. When the tragedy occurred, he promptly shrugged off responsibility and suspended the Commissioner and four others down the chain. He also appointed a one-member commission, presided over by a retired High Court Judge, to probe various aspects of the events that led to the disaster. By doing so, he thought that he had washed his hands of the blame that would, in the usual course of things, come to rest on his shoulders and that of his government. The police could have done a better job, but the government should not have burdened the police with the unnecessary reception at the Vidhana Soudha. Many personnel must have been deployed at

that venue. If even a minor mishap had occurred there, all hell would have broken loose. If the government and the ruling party wanted credit for the RCB win, they should also be ready to take responsibility for the stampede that occurred outside the C h i n n a s w a m y Stadium. Former Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri was the Railway Minister in Nehru’s cabinet when a major rail accident took place. Being a conscientious person, he resigned from the Cabinet. The Karnataka CM, or more appropriately the Deputy CM, who was the most visible dignitary at the Vidhana Soudha function, should have stepped down in the spirit of a noble politician like Shastri. That gesture would have pacified the people. The knee-jerk reaction of the CM and the police to register cases against the RCB management is distressing, to say the least. I do hope that saner counsel prevails and that Virat Kohli and his team-mates are not “punished” for winning the IPL trophy! Three lakh cricket enthusiasts were reported to have turned up at the Bengaluru stadium, which can accommodate only 35,000 spectators. That should have been anticipated. The state’s Home Minister should have monitored the police arrangements. The Mumbai City police have much experience in handling such mammoth crowds.

Eliminate black spots to prevant road accidents : Komal Mittal

MOHALI : Deputy Commissioner Komal Mittal took serious concern about accident-prone locations. She was holding a meeting of the District Road Safety Committee. DC expressed serious concern over identified accident-prone locations and raised the need for emphasised the need for urgent preventive measures and instructed departments, including GMADA, Municipal Corporation and municipal councils, PWD, and NHAI, to prioritise the rectification of these black spots and submit an action-taking report before the next meeting. In order to prevant accidents and ensure smooth road movements, all agencies were urged to take swift and concrete action. She stressed the need for uploading accident details on the E-DAR (Electronic Detailed Accident Report) portal. She said the centralised system simplified accident reporting and facilitated faster compensation disbursement through advanced tools like geotagging and data

sharing. Komal Mittal urged the police and hospitals to promptly update the portal to help the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways identify high-risk areas effectively. In addition, she directed the SDMs to expedite all pending hit-and-run compensation claims, ensuring timely relief of Rs 2 lakh for fatalities and Rs 50,000 for grievous injuries under the relevant scheme. Stressing the importance of road safety compliance, she called for strict enforcement against traffic law violators. Mittal directed the RTO, the police and the district child protection officer to carry out regular checks and take legal action to ensure public safety. Special emphasis was placed on ensuring school buses operated as per the Safe School Vahan Policy. RTO Rajpal Singh Sekhon informed the committee that a total of 1,352 challans amounting to Rs 59,87,600 were issued during the months of April and May.

With minimum 20 workers Amendment to Shop & Establishment Act must materialise

CHANDIGARH : Sanjeev Chadha, president of the Chandigarh Beopar Mandal, along with over 15 representatives from various markets, held a meeting with the Labour Department, Chandigarh. The meeting was organised by Assistant Labour Commissioner Akshay Mital. A Chandigarh Beopar Mandal (CBM) delegation has given a suggestion to the Chandigarh Administration to exempt all establishments having up to 20 workers from the provisions of the Shop and Establishment Act. The Labour Department, Chandigarh Administration, had invited traders for their suggestions on the proposal mooted by the Government of

India for amending the Act. The Mandal advocated for exemption from the Shop Act for all shops employing less than 20 employees, a move expected to provide significant relief to traders burdened by complex laws and regulations. They said that the exemption was likely to generate more employment and revenue in city markets and promote better employer-employee relationships. They emphasised that this move would encourage businesses to grow, create more jobs and foster a more positive work environment. The officers assured that the suggestions would be sent to the government for amendment in the said Act.

CHANDIGARH : A delegation of the Chandigarh Congress comprising Jatinder Bhatia, Achhe Lal Gaur, Haji Zahid Parvez Khan, Harmel Kesari, Rajdeep Sidhu and Gurdarshan Singh opposed the proposal before the Joint Parliamentary Committee. Opposed the proposal before the committee, were part of the city Congress delegation. ‘One Nation, One Election (ONOE)’ idea was supported by the majority of city BJP while the Congress and the Aam Aadmi Party opposed the proposal before the Joint Parliamentary Committee, which sought suggestions and opinions of political parties. A delegation of the Aam Aadmi Party also opposed the proposal before the committee. City AAP chief Vijay Pal Singh, general secretary Omkar Singh

Aulakh, disciplinary committee convener PP Ghai, advocate Ferry Soft and media incharge Vikrant A Tanwar participated in the discussion and highlighted the constitutional, political and social risks the proposal came with. Vijay Pal emphasised that while the ONOE might appear attractive at first glance, its deeper impact was toxic and threatened the very core values of the Indian Constitution. He said, “Our current electoral system has functioned smoothly for decades. There is no pressing need to replace it. Implementing the ONOE would require massive resources — EVMs, security forces, staff and infrastructure — which is impractical and

unsustainable.” City BJP president Jatinder Pal Malhotra extended strong support to the concept of ONOE, calling it a “visionary step towards a more efficient and stable democracy”. Malhotra emphasised that holding simultaneous elections across the country would lead to significant saving of time and resources. “Frequent elections hamper the pace of development and overburden administrative and security machinery. A synchronised electoral system would streamline governance and policy implementation,” he said. He urged all political parties to rise above partisan interests and seriously consider the idea of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, which was rooted in national interest and long-term democratic reform.

Haryana PRIs to get share from 1% stamp duty revenue

CHANDIGARH : Now under the new allocation, gram panchayats will receive 0.5 per cent of the revenue, while panchayat samitis and zila parishads will get 0.25 per cent each. The Haryana Government has announced a significant financial boost for the fund-starved Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) by allocating 1 per cent of the total revenue generated from stamp duty to them. The move aims at strengthen the fiscal capacity of the PRIs, enabling greater autonomy in planning and executing development projects at the grassroots level.

Haryana Development and Panchayats Minister Krishan Lal Panwar said this decision would financially empower the PRIs, allowing them to prioritise and utilise resources according to local needs, thereby accelerating development. Officials informed that nearly Rs 572 crore would be distributed

among the PRIs, with 5,388 gram panchayats receiving Rs 288 crore. In addition to this, 142 panchayat samitis will be allocated Rs 144.08 crore, and 22 zila parishads will get Rs 140 crore. Currently, stamp duty rates in Haryana vary based on ownership type and location. In urban areas, male buyers pay 7 per cent, while female buyers are charged 5 per cent. In rural areas, the rates are 5 per cent for males and 3 per cent for females. For joint ownership, the stamp duty is 1 per cent lower, 6 per cent in urban areas and 4 per cent in rural areas.

Civic body negates disclosing names of property tax defaulters under RTI

CHANDIGARH : RK Garg, a social activist and president, Second Innings Association, had sought a list of government departments which had not paid property tax for years. Mr Garg has sought the list along with pending amounts against these departments from the tax department of the Civic body. He said the department refused to provide the information. Even as the defaulters of property tax are bleeding the civic body financially, the municipal corporation has refused to provide the list of defaulters under the Right to Information (RTI) Act. He said that the department had disposed of his application filed under the RTI Act while observing that the information in question form could not be provided under the Act. He said that while the MC had enhanced the rates of the property tax and burdened the common man, it was not taking any action against the defaulters, due to which people of the city were suffering. Mr Garg said that instead of concealing the names of the defaulters, the MC must name and shame them. The civic body MC must publish the names of the defaulters in newspapers and put

Administrators approves giving free books till Class XII from next session

CHANDIGARH : The UT Administration has decided to provide free textbooks to all students from Class I to XII of government schools from next academic session. Punjab Governor and UT Administrator Gulab Chand Kataria has given approval to the proposal. Earlier, the benefit was limited up to Class VIII. The initiative is aimed at supporting students from economically weaker sections and reducing the dropout rate in higher classes. At present, around 1.5 lakh students are enrolled in 112 government schools across the city. With the Administration focusing on boosting education infrastructure, many parents have opted to shift their children from private to government schools, particularly in Class XI and XII. “Extending free textbooks till Class XII will ensure that no child is deprived of learning due to financial constraints,” said a senior official. This administrative step



comes alongside other measures to boost education in the city such as solar-powered buildings to cut down on school bills and campaigns against drug abuse among schoolchildren. UT Administrator Kataria, who is a former educator, is closely monitoring the ongoing changes in the government schools here. In another significant step, the Administration has decided to prepare government school students for the competitive examinations from next session. Under the proposed initiative, students scoring 85 per cent or above in Class XII will be eligible for free coaching and guidance for the civil services examinations. Recognising that many meritorious students are unable to afford costly

coaching after school, the Administration has begun drafting a plan to ensure that talent is not hindered by financial constraints. Kataria has directed officials to design a framework for this initiative, which will include mentorship, study material and possibly partnerships with reputed institutes providing coaching for the UPSC exams. “This effort is not just about academic support but also opening pathways for the underprivileged youth to dream bigger and achieve leadership roles in society,” stated the official. Recently, the UT Administrator felicitated 16 students — children of group B, C and D employees of the Raj Bhawan — for their exemplary performance in the Class X and XII board examinations. The Governor also felicitated aspiring NEET/JEE students who were enrolled in professional courses (post Class XII) and postgraduates preparing for competitive exams and gave them cash awards.

Bridge on Indrayani River was already declared unsafe : Fadnavis

Palghar : The iron pedestrian bridge on the Indrayani River in Pune that collapsed, killing four persons, had already been declared unsafe dangerous by the district collector, and warning boards had been put up at the site, said Devendra Fadnavis Maharashtra Chief Minister on Monday.

Fadnavis said the contract for a new bridge at the site in Maval tehsil had been awarded and work has begun. Four people died, and 18 were seriously injured when a 32-year-old iron pedestrian bridge over the Indrayani River in Maval tehsil collapsed on Sunday afternoon due to overcrowding by tourists said Fadnavis at Plaghar.

He said that the structure had been declared dangerous by the district collector before the incident, and villagers had also placed warning boards. Tourists might not have been aware of the severity of the bridge's condition, he said.

The CM said the administration had identified



500 dangerous locations, including bridges and water bodies, across Pune district for the monsoon.

"Notifications have been issued, and at some places, police are posted while villagers are also involved in cautioning people. We have to handle this with much more caution," he said, adding that he has instructed the district collector to implement safety measures at these vulnerable tourist spots.

Fadnavis also took part in welcoming students on their first day of the new academic year at the Zilla Parishad school in Durvesh. He highlighted the government's holistic approach to student welfare, which includes providing free uniforms and mid-day meals.

Ambassador to North Korea by India appointed after 4 years

NEW DELHI : Longkumer, a 2008-batch Indian Foreign Service officer, is currently serving as the Charge d'affaires at the Indian Embassy in Asuncion, Paraguay. He is expected to assume charge in Pyongyang shortly, the Ministry of External Affairs said in a statement issued on Monday.

India has appointed Aliawati Longkumer as its next ambassador to North Korea, marking a step in re-establishing diplomatic engagement with Pyongyang after a four-year hiatus.



India reopened its embassy in Pyongyang in December 2024, nearly four years after it was shut down in July 2021 amid pandemic-related disruptions.

Atul Malhari Gotsurve was the last ambassador posted in North Korea before the closure. Ahead of resuming operations, New Delhi undertook security assessments and anti-surveillance measures.

India halted all trade with North Korea in 2017 to comply with UN sanctions but did not sever diplomatic ties. The relationship is underpinned by strategic concerns, particularly Pyongyang's historical support to Pakistan's missile development programme.

Minister of State for External Affairs VK Singh made a visit in 2018. India has also provided humanitarian assistance to North Korea, including food and medical aid, and offered training to its diplomats and scientists. North Korea has a dependence on China.

Enhance validity of All India Taxi Permit validity to 15 years: Deputy CM urges Gadkari

SHIMLA: Deputy Chief Minister Mukesh urged the minister to release a pending amount of Rs 7.63 crore under the scheme for special assistance to the state for capital investment, specifically for incentives related to scrapping old vehicles.

Mr Agnihotri met Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari in New Delhi, and discussed several issues related to the state. The Deputy Chief Minister requested Gadkari to increase the validity of All India Taxi Permits from 12 to 15 years, aligning with the vehicle scrapping policy period of 15 years. Agnihotri said that the Union Minister assured him that he would look into the matter, and issued directions to the authorities concerned.

The Deputy CM also demanded that the Nangal-aijion road be declared a



National Highway, highlighting its importance to the proposed bulk drug park in Una. "A DPR to the tune of Rs 429 crore has already been prepared for the road, and it would be submitted to the Government of India under Gati Shakti scheme," he said.

Agnihotri further demanded that the proposed four-laning of NH 503 A from Amritsar to Hoshiarpur be extended from Bankhandi (HP boundary) to Jhaleda. "This

is a stretch of approximately 15 km and would connect Anandpur Sahib to Mata Chintpurni, which would benefit the pilgrims visiting these two shrines," he said.

He also raised the issue of connectivity between Chandigarh and Baddi industrial area, to which Gadkari said that the matter was under active consideration of the Centre government.

The Deputy CM also sought approval for the upgradation of the link road, Jaijion Modh to Tahlial Chowk via Bhai-Ka-Modh, and three bridges. Agnihotri said funds to the tune of Rs 48.69 crore for the projects could be provided through CRIF. "The minister assured that he would approve it on priority. Besides, he said the DPR under the Gati Shakti scheme may be prepared and submitted to the Ministry accordingly," said Agnihotri.

Sewa Kendras to facilitate 34 more services in Patiala district : Preeti Yadav

PATIALA : Residents no longer need to visit Tehsil offices or Patwaris for basic revenue services. Citizens could now access mutation through inheritance or registry, corrections in Jamabandi, registration of reports and digital copies of land records directly from nearby Sewa Kendras or from home said Preeti Yadav Deputy Commissioner.

Thirty-four new services — six from Revenue Department and 28 from Transport Department — are now available at Sewa Kendras across the district or from home via helpline 1076.

Yadav said a wide range of transport services could also be availed easily. These include applying for learner's and driving licenses, updating address, name or date of birth, issuance of duplicate licences, renewal without tests, licence conversion and issuing of badges for public



service drivers and conductors.

Similarly, services related to vehicle registration certificates (RC) such as duplicate RC, address change, NOC applications, ownership transfers, mobile number updates and fitness certificates for commercial vehicles were also now available at Sewa Kendras.

The DC said all 34 services could be accessed at 42 Sewa Kendras across the district, ensuring ease of access, saving time and transparency.

The initiative is a part of the Punjab Government's continuous push towards digitisation and better service delivery through e-governance.

Pak fighter had shot Gujrat CM plane before 60 years

Ahmadabad : Even a Pak fighter jet shot down Gujarat CM's plane 60 years ago Sixty years before former Gujarat CM Vijay Rupani lost his life in the Air India crash on Thursday,

A sitting Gujarat CM was lost mid-air, not to malfunction, but to a Pakistani strike. During the India-Pakistan War of 1965, a Pakistani fighter shot down Balwantrai Mehta's Beechcraft aircraft, perceiving it as to be a surveillance aircraft.

It was the height of the 1965 India-Pakistan war. And 25-year-old Pakistani Flying Officer Qais Hussain, flying a Sabre jet, was patrolling



the tense skies over Bhuj and eastern Sindh.

On spotting a civilian aircraft, Hussain sought permission and, once granted, fired at the Beechcraft.

Feeling triumphant that he had foiled an enemy surveillance operation, Hussain returned to his base in Karachi.

Hours later, when All India Radio's 7 pm bulletin announced that a plane carrying Gujarat's then Chief

Minister Balwantrai Mehta and seven civilians had been shot down by Pakistan, Hussain's pride gave way to shock, disbelief, and a lifelong burden.

Gujarat CM Balwantrai Mehta, pilot Jahangir Engineer, and a journalist were among the eight people killed after their Beechcraft aircraft was shot down by the Pakistani fighter.

Almost 60 years after Balwantrai Mehta, known as the father of Panchayati Raj, lost his life in an air tragedy, Vijay Rupani, who had served as the Gujarat CM between 2016 and 2021, died in an air crash in Ahmedabad.

Families, kins of crash victims demand full remains burnt in a crash

Commissioner News Service Ahmedabad - Remains of plane crash victims were handed over to the families of the victims.

Officials on Sunday said samples of 80 victims of Ahmedabad plane crash have matched with kin so far, with 33 mortal remains handed over to families.

A total of 270 bodies were brought to the Civil Hospital in Ahmedabad after the deadly Air India plane crash on Thursday. Of the 270 bodies, 241 were passengers and cabin crew on the London-bound flight. The remaining were killed when the plane crashed into a hostel of BJ Medical College.



Families of the crash victims continue to throng outside the Civil Hospital's mortuary as authorities carry out DNA tests.

As per additional medical superintendent of BJ Medical College, Rajnish Patel, a total of 80 bodies have been recognised through the DNA sampling process and 33 mortal remains have been handed over to the families.
