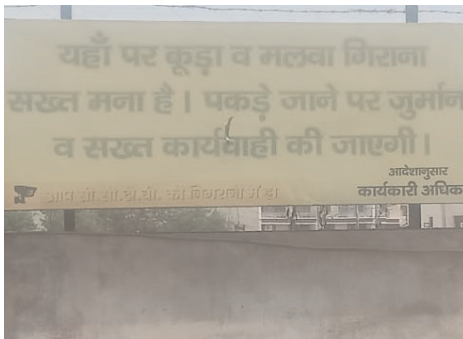
## EO's suspension doesn't salvage aggravating pooling of refuse

Derabassi : An adage about the place of "Swacchta" in a developed country occupies a significant slot, there remains no chance for its persistent negligence. The all times veracity and uprightness for upkeep of Swacchta need not be over emphasised . The local civic institution must shoulder its responsibility to sanitise about 1 km area along Barwala road, as the traders have been demanding for long time yet no sanitary workers took care for the past about 11 months despite the then accountable Executive Officer had displayed notice quationing the penalty of Rs 1000,

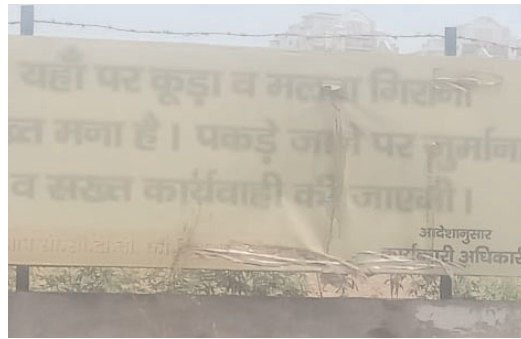

### Lawyer denied bail, might malign noble profession of advocacy- HC

New Delhi : The accused lawyer and his brother allegedly assaulted a software engineer in Feb , who was on his way to Deoli Road on a two -wheeler . The victim sustained injuries in what the accused termed 'mere road rage '. Refusing to grant bail to a lawyer in case of road rage , Delhi High Court has said that granting relief for "broad daylight violence " in a public place would send "wrong signals " to a society , suggesting that the aggressor walked free because of his legal profession.



Justice Girish Kathpalia , in order issued on Thursday , remarked that all individuals are equal before the law , and making an exception would "malign the noble profession of advocacy . HC said that granting anticipatory bail "in the broad daylight violence of the present nature at a public place would send wrong signals across society that the

aggressor took the law into his hands and walked free just because he happens to be an advocate . All are equal in the eyes of the law , and none can be treated to the accused / applicant , would also malign the noble profession of advocacy ." The court strongly discharged . Citing CCTV footage , Justice Kathpalia said the visuals helped "fully understand the magnitude " of violence by two " powerful persons of society" one an advocate, the other president of a political organisation-.

### Operation Sindoor fresh visuals of military action shared

New Delhi :The Indian Army shared fresh visuals of military action carried out under Operation Sindoor, calling it justice and not revenge for the Pahalgam attack in which 26 civilians were killed. The video shared on the Army's Western Command X handle showed military firing and shelling on Pakistani territory as part of the strikes on May 7 and later.



In the video captioned as "Planned, trained and executed", the soldier is heard saying that all In addition, queries are also being received if a DGMO-level

talk is scheduled on Sunday in hostilities, as decided in DGMOs talks. The Centre also announced a list of fifty-one political leaders, parliamentarians and former ministers from various political parties who will be part of the seven delegations travelling to world capitals to put across India's resolve to tackle terrorism against the backdrop of Operation Sindoor.

### Administration demands utilisation certificates of Rs 50 Cr spent under village development scheme

liabilities under the revenue head were allocated to municipal body .The directive in the face of consistent failure of previous utilisation certificates prompted the administration to call for immediate submission of detailed utilisation certificates. About 4 years have lapsed when the funds were despatched, sources revealed.

### Michael Rubin slams Donald Trump allowing Pak \$1 billion from IMF

New York : Michael Rubin US military strategist and former Pentagon official has slammed Donald Trump administration for not blocking a \$1 billion bailout to Pakistan from the International Monetary Fund (IMF), calling the move a blunder mistake , ignoring Pakistan's terrorism links. Rubin went on to say that the IMF funding came shortly after Pakistan-based terrorists infiltrated India and executed civilians, and releasing the funds not only helps a "terror-addled, pro-China regime" but also undermines US foreign policy goals. "This is not just about Pakistan; it's about the IMF thumbing its

nose at President Donald Trump," he stated, signalling the instance that



Trump has recently claimed that he is looking to de-escalate tensions between New Delhi and Islamabad. Last week, before the IMF approved the financial assistance to Pakistan, Rubin had warned against funding Islamabad. "When an alcoholic uses donations to buy hard liquor, the answer is not to up his allowance; rather, it is to cut him off,"

### Protecting rights of street vendors in limbo

Mohali : The prolonged deadlock has left street vendors without designated spaces while causing inconvenience to residents due to unchecked roadside encroachments .



Implementation of the Street Vendors ( Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending ) Act , 2014, has been delayed for the past eight years due to lack of consensus between the Mohali Municipal Corporation (MC) and Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA ) over vending zone allotments . The Act which came into

effect on May 1 , 2014 , was aimed at protecting of street vendors .The Civic Body Mohali initiated the process of identifying vendors in 2015 by hiring a private firm to conduct a survey . Initially 2,295 vendors were identified , but inconsistencies led to a reassessment and in 2017 , MC finalized a list of 973 stationary and mobile vendors .

Why vulnerability to liquor addiction

Entire communities, deprived of mental health care, meaningful employment and adequate infrastructure, find themselves vulnerable to addiction. In this dire context, liquor whether legal or illegal transforms into both a refuge and a trap. Each tragedy follows a painfully predictable script: media outrage, arrests and hastily convened inquiry committees. Yet, year after year, no lessons are learnt and requisite structural reforms remain an elusive goal. While low-level bootleggers are apprehended, the masterminds often shielded by political connections escape scrutiny. FIRs are subjected to delays or diluted. Compensation for victims' families tends to serve as a mechanism to silence dissent rather than deliver genuine justice. Public memory fades swiftly, but the system's memory is sharp — it knows how to protect itself, yet cannot correct its failures. One of the most formidable barriers to reform is the monopolisation of Punjab's liquor trade. Over the past decade, a handful of persons — many linked to both ruling and opposition parties — have cornered the rights to liquor manufacturing and distribution. These monopolies, solidified

through opaque auctions and manipulated licensing processes, stifle competition and accountability. In many districts, the police serve less as enforcers of the law and more as protectors of the liquor empire. Excise inspectors, often silenced by fear or complicity, remain ineffectual. Even honest officials find themselves powerless within a system fortified by money, muscle and political influence. Hooch tragedies are far from a new phenomenon in Punjab. Since 2010, numerous incidents have rocked regions such as Tarn Taran, Amritsar, Gurdaspur, Sangrur and Mansa. During the catastrophic events of 2020 alone, over 120 lives were lost. These recurring tragedies consistently target the same demographic: the impoverished, the landless, the addicted-individuals the state is sworn to protect but continuously neglects. At the core of this crisis lies a vast, well-coordinated empire of illicit liquor. This black market stretches from production to wholesale to street-level sale, frequently operating under the watchful gaze of the authorities. Punjab's liquor economy is predominantly controlled by a select few powerful syndicates, shielded — either tacitly or actively — by politicians and local

officials. This unholy alliance facilitates the proliferation of lethal alcohol, particularly in rural and economically distressed regions. The tragedy is exacerbated by warped economic incentives. Punjab rakes in over Rs 10,000 crore annually through liquor excise, making it the state's second largest source of non-debt revenue. This fiscal dependency breeds a wilful blindness. When both legal and illegal profits flow upward through the same shadowy networks, the state becomes a silent accomplice in the slow poisoning of its people. For many rural households, licensed liquor remains prohibitively expensive. A 750-ml bottle can cost Rs 300-Rs 400, far beyond the reach of daily wage workers. Illicit hooch, available at a mere fraction of that price, becomes the default choice. Yet, affordability is only a part of the issue at hand. Punjab is grappling with a widespread substance abuse crisis. What was once a component of cultural celebration has decayed into rampant alcoholism, especially among the youth. Over the years, illicit distillation has increased and drug-related crimes have surged by over 30 per cent.

2-kanal house goes for Rs 32 cr, prices hit the roof

CHANDIGARH : Not known if the deal prices include "under the table settlement". The property prices in Chandigarh are going through the roof. A two-kanal house in the city was recently sold for a whopping Rs 32 crore while an SCO fetched a record Rs 30 crore. The component widely ranging from 40 to 50 per cent of the aggregate value, but the official consideration amount at which these properties have been registered in the UT. Given the reality that property is registered at a value much less than the total deal value to cut down on the registration fee and the stamp duty, one can safely assume that these properties must have been priced at roughly 40 to 50 per cent more than the value at which these were registered. The official data, exclusively accessed by revealed that a 1,000.3 sq yard house in Sector 18-A was sold for Rs 32 crore on

November 26, 2024, which was the highest-ever registration price for a two-kanal (kanal is equal to 500 sq yards in residential areas) house in Chandigarh. Similarly, an SCO on Madhya Marg in Sector 7, measuring 762.93 sq yards, fetched a record price of Rs 30 crore as per the sale deed registered on March 30, 2025. Among the other properties that have fetched record prices so far include a six-kanal house in Sector 9-C which was sold for Rs 70 crore, a four-kanal house in Sector 27-B for Rs 33.5 crore, a 7.5-kanal house in Sector 4-A for Rs 41.8 crore, a 10.5-kanal house in Sector 4-A for Rs 45 crore, a 3.5-kanal house in Sector 9-B for Rs 35 crore, a six-kanal house in Sector 9-C for Rs 43 crore, a little less than three-kanal house in Sector 9-B for Rs 31 crore and a six-kanal house in Sector 9-C, which was registered at the consideration amount of Rs 65 crore.

Kharar JE transferred, chargesheeted over discrepancies

MOHALI : On the complaint received from power consumers a surprise raid was made by Harbhajan Singh, Punjab Power Minister ETO conducted a surprise inspection of the Kharar Electricity Office where he obtained feedback from consumers who had come for various services regarding the office's functioning. He urged the people to register complaints related to corruption in the Power department on WhatsApp no. 9501200200, assuring that if any state resident sends him a complaint regarding corruption in the Power department, he would ensure action within 24 hours.

PM Sewa Scheme facilitates 100 E-Buses for Mohali

Mohali district has become eligible for the PM E-Bus Sewa Scheme, Deputy Commissioner (DC) Komal Mittal announced during a meeting with stakeholders to discuss the proposed route plan. Around 100 electric buses (EVs) will operate on eight routes covering distances between 17 km and 32 km, with a frequency of one bus every 15 minutes.

Tertiary treated water connection for 500 sqyd. house or more

CHANDIGARH : The Municipal Corporation has decided to provide tertiary treated water connections at residents' doorsteps. Tenders have been issued for laying pipelines for the purpose. Under the project, the water pipeline will be laid till the doorsteps of houses and other institutions like schools, colleges. MC sources said with the completion of the project, the residents will be able to get tertiary water connections without any hassle of taking permission to dig roads in the vicinity or purchasing material. The MC will charge the required fee as fixed under bylaws. To be completed at an estimated cost of Rs 72



crore, the project will help the MC save precious drinking water. Under the water bylaws, the civic body has made tertiary water connections mandatory for houses measuring 500 sq yards and above. While around 8,000 houses are eligible for tertiary water connections, half of the houses are yet to receive it. Likewise, all schools, colleges and other institutions have also not

been connected with the tertiary treated water line. The tertiary treated water is supplied from six sewage treatment plants of the MC situated at 3BRD, Dhanas, Raipur Khurd, Raipur Kalan, Maloya and Diggian. These STPs have been upgraded under the Smart City Mission. Providing uninterrupted water supply to the residents is a big challenge for the MC. The city witnesses a shortfall of 13 MGD of water against the demand of 100 MGD during the summer. Presently, the city is receiving 87 MGD of water. In such a situation, increasing tertiary treated water connections will help the MC save drinking water.

Panchayat Secretaries exhorted to update records of Shamlat land

"Promote Equality: A uniform dress code minimizes socio-economic disparities among staff, fostering a more inclusive atmosphere. And, Boost Morale: A cohesive appearance can improve team spirit and morale among educators. The department looks forward to the positive impact these uniforms will have on both teachers and the broader school community," the statement adds. Piyush Goyal hammers trade talks with US commerce Secretary Lutnick

**NEW DELHI :** The Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA) with the US was moving progressively in the right direction, said Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal. Earlier in May, the Union Commerce and Industry Minister. The minister held productive discussions with US Commerce Secretary Howard Lutnick, focusing on expediting the first tranche of the India-US Bilateral Trade Agreement. "Conversation with the US is going very well. We were the first country to start the conversation. Conversion is going extremely well. We are moving progressively in the right direction," said Union Minister Piyush Goyal, speaking at the Columbia India Energy Dialogue in New Delhi. "I think the US and India are



totally complementary to each other. We are a perfect fit, where there is hardly anything, except one or two products, where we compete; otherwise, we are totally too complementary. At USD 83,000 per capita income, what the US can produce can never compete with Indian goods made in India. And there are so many technologies and so many innovations and products which are not available in India, which I would buy from the United States rather than buying from many other non-market economies," the Union Minister said. "Frankly, this is a partnership that's truly contemporary, a win-win for both and will be the defining partnership in the coming months and years, given the very sheer scale of the American economy and

the delta of opportunity that India offers as it grows from a 4 trillion-dollar economy to a USD 35 trillion economy by 2047," Goyal added. India and the US aim to ink the deal by the fall of 2025. India's exports reportedly rose 11.6 per cent to USD 86.5 billion, while imports rose 7.4 per cent to USD 45.3 billion in 2024-25, resulting in a higher trade surplus of USD 41 billion. The US administration imposes reciprocal tariffs on countries with a sizable trade deficit. During their meeting in mid-February 2025, President Trump and Prime Minister Narendra Modi resolved to expand trade and investment to make their citizens more prosperous, nations stronger, economies more innovative, and supply chains more resilient. They resolved to deepen the US-India trade relationship to promote growth that ensures fairness, national security, and job creation. To this end, the leaders set a bold new goal for bilateral trade - "Mission 500" - to more than double total bilateral trade to USD 500 billion by 2030.

All party delegations to 33 global nations : Foreign Secretary Misri

**NEW DELHI :** There was no nuclear signalling by the neighbouring country, disclosed Vikram Misri Foreign Secretary. He added a parliamentary committee on Monday that the conflict between India and Pakistan was always in the conventional domain, sources said. The meeting of Parliament's Standing Committee on External Affairs, chaired by Congress MP Shashi Tharoor, was attended by a number of lawmakers, including the

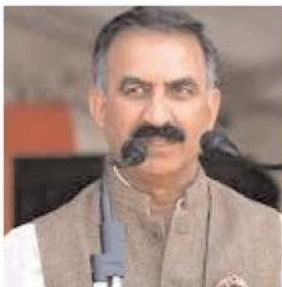


TMC's Abhishek Banerjee, the Congress' Rajeev Shukla and Deepender Hooda, AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi, and the BJP's Aparajita Sarangi and Arun Govil. The meeting comes against the backdrop of the Indian Armed Forces carrying out Operation Sindoor to avenge the Pahalgam terror attack and the subsequent military actions between the two countries. India and Pakistan reached an understanding on halting all military actions on May 10. Meanwhile, the government has decided to send all-party delegations to 33 global capitals to brief leaders on India's resolve to firmly deal with terrorism against the backdrop of Operation Sindoor.

Double tariff on apple import to be sought by CM Sukhu

**SHIMLA :** "He will raise the issue concerning the apple growers of Himachal with the PM during the scheduled meeting of chief ministers with Modi at Delhi on May 24, said Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu. Amidst growing demand for ban on import of apples from Turkey, Sukhu said he will demand double tariff on import of apples from Turkey and other countries in his meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi. "I will also write to the PM to take steps to impose double tariffs on apple import as the growers of Himachal, Jammu and Kashmir



suffer losses due to import of cheap apples from abroad," said Sukhu. The CM said he will urge the PM to impose double tariff on import of apples from Turkey as it is the domain and authority of the Centre to act against any country with whom a trade agreement has been signed. "The import of apples from Turkey and US results in a steep fall in the prices of apples grown by Himachal

orchardists. Himachal is known as the fruit bowl of India and growers work hard to cultivate quality fruit but are hit hard by apple import," he said. The demand for banning apple imports from Turkey — following Turkey siding with Pakistan in the recent Indo-Pakistan conflict — is gaining momentum in the state. Both Congress and BJP leaders have raised this demand. Pillar of Constitution must work unitedly to ensure its sovereignty : Chief Justice of India B R Gavai

**MUMBAI :** Chief Justice of India B R Gavai who took oath as the 52nd CJI earlier this week, spoke at his felicitation ceremony and state lawyers' conference organised by the Bar Council Maharashtra and Goa here. he was glad that the country has not just strengthened but has also developed on the social and economic fronts and continues to do so. "Neither the Judiciary nor the Executive and the Parliament is supreme, but it is the Constitution of India

which is supreme, and all the three wings have to work as per the Constitution," he said. He underlined that the country's basic structure was strong, and all three pillars of the Constitution were equal. "And all the organs of the Constitution must reciprocate and give due respect to each other," he said. A book chronicling 50 remarkable judgments pronounced by Justice Gavai was released during the event.

Probe into the visit of Jyoti Malhotra 'Pakistani spy' in progress

**Bhubaneswar :** Jyoti Malhotra, who runs a YouTube channel, Travel with JO, and hails from Hisar in Haryana, had visited Puri in September 2024 and came in contact with a woman in the coastal town, who is also a YouTuber, Puri said SP Vinit Agrawal. Police have started an investigation into the alleged links between a Puri-based YouTuber and Jyoti Malhotra, who was arrested on the charge of passing on sensitive information to Pakistani intelligence operatives, an officer said on Sunday. Jyoti, whose YouTube channel and Instagram account have 3.77 lakh subscribers and 1.33 lakh followers respectively, allegedly was in contact with a Pakistani staffer working at the Pakistan High



Commission in Delhi. On May 13, India had expelled that Pakistani official for allegedly indulging in espionage. The woman in Puri had also travelled to Kartarpur Sahib Gurdwara in Pakistan recently, the SP said. "We found that Jyoti Malhotra had visited Puri last year, and we are verifying the fact. Anything more can be shared after the verification," Agrawal said. Asked whether the woman from Puri had shared intelligence inputs with Malhotra, Agrawal said, "The Haryana Police are

investigating the matter and we are providing them the required assistance." The police are also "examining the objective" of Malhotra's visit to Puri, and trying to find out "where she stayed, whom she contacted and any possible suspicious activities", the Puri SP said. "We are in touch with various central agencies and the Haryana Police. We will share details with the media after field verification," he said while responding to queries from reporters. The Odisha Police did not disclose the identity of the Puri YouTuber for its investigation into the matter. Puri YouTuber's father said the police had quizzed her daughter on Saturday and sought some information. A team of police personnel visited the woman's residence in Puri for an investigation into the matter.

India is not a dharamshala (free shelter) that can entertain refugees from all over the world, the Supreme Court said today, refusing a Sri Lankan national's plea for refuge. The bench of Justice Dipankar

Datta and Justice K Vinod Chandran was hearing a petition by a Sri Lankan national, who was arrested in 2015 on suspicion of being linked to the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE), a terrorist organisation once active in Sri Lanka. In 2018, a trial court convicted him under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act and sentenced him to 10 years in jail.

## Hair Oil affects deleteriously human mental health

Chandigarh : Amandeep Singh had advertised his oil on social media, claiming it could cure baldness . He organised a free application camp on March 16 at Kali Mata Temple , Sangrur . Several attendees , after applying the oil , reported severe reactions , including facial swelling and eye irritation . On visiting the civil hospitals in Sangrur , he discovered that 60 to 70 others have arrived with similar complaints . Answering specific queries put to him , the SMO opined that the cause of the reaction was served con-



tact dermatitis -a kind of conjunctivitis caused by contact with an irritant . The SMO added while the injuries were simple in nature , vision loss could have occurred if the cornea got involved . Refusing to grant bail to a hair growth influencer whose oil allegedly led to hospitalisation of 70 people at a camp in Sangrur , the Punjab and Harayana high court observed that

advertising a product making tall, misleading claims , without any scientific evidence or clinical testing to back it up , must be strictly condemned . At times vulnerable people go to extreme lengths and even undergo risky procedures .
