Who would halt dumping of garbage, untreated sewage into Sukhna Choe

ZIRAKPUR : Day by day for the past over 24 years at least by Civic body remains unseen , uncured the plight of " Sukhna Choe" where from alarming level of pollution being stemmed ,affecting the enviorns at this local town. The garbage is conveniently thrown into the culvert of the Sukhna Choe Zirakpur and no fencing has scrupulously been raised to check this discernible lapse. The much sought after requisite fencing (mesh) will help lessen aggravating pile up of the pollutants, comment passers-



by, and several military personnels of the nearby army brigade. The committee constituted by the National Green Tribunal carried out a survey and remarked serious environmental violation as untreated sewage and garbage waste were being thrown into the Sukhna Choe. The committee was head-

ed by the Chandigarh Deputy Commissioner Viney Partap Singh comprising Dera Bassi SDM Amit Gupta , Representative of DC Mohali, Dharmendra Gupta , Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee Jagdish Prasad Meena Scientist " D ",and Ashok Pathria who recommended to the



ZIRAKPUR civic body to carry out further survey and build iron made fencing (mesh) to stop further dumping of solid waste and garbage. The committee recommended regular operations and maintenance of the existing 17.3 MLD Capacity Sewerage Treatment Plant by Civic Body Zirakpur.

The tasked committee on survey also found stench near government school on the bank of the Sukhna Choe Zirakpur. Near the school horizons, unpleasant odour too was propagating due to dumping of cattle dung and solid sewage . Through a underground pipeline sewage was directly discharged into



the Ghaggar river.The committee traced that SBI (Sequential Batch Reactor) tank meant for treating waste water and chlorination tank of 'Sewerage Treatment Plant' were found anaerobic conditions to indicate the unserviceability of the S T P . The committee documented extensive solid

waste littering along the bank of Sukhna Choe near Baltana area further deteriorating pollution c r i s i s . Ghaggar river was additionally carrying muddy, soiled water from catchment area.The uncontrolled dump of the garbage is choking the natural flow of Sukhna Choe and Ghaggar river.

At this juncture, proper care would be required to ensure no more garbage could be dumped which was possible only protective blind strong sheet in f e n c i n g . Despite many efforts to contact Ashok Patheria, Executive Officer there was no reply from his end, however, Asstt Municipal Engg. Sukhwinder Singh said that clearing garbage was not coming under his domain. He would check and find solution of raising fencing around the bridge over culvert of Sukhna Choe.

Delhi blast result of poor law and order -- Atishi

New Delhi : No more will be 120 days for advance reservation period for rly tickets. The period has been cut away to only 60 days. The move will benefit passengers to bring minimum blocking of tickets and bring down cancellation of ordered tickets . The normal would be enforceable from Nov .1 , as per the circular of Railway Board. The record of railway ministry reveals that 21 % of the reservations are can-



celled and 4% - 5% passengers neither cancel their tickets nor turn up for their journey. All this practice had been leading to frauds such as impersonation and charging of fraud money.

Canada ignores all together 26 extradition requests pending about Bishnoi Gang : MEA

New Delhi : Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau says he believes in a 'One India' policy, but there is a gap between his government's actions and words because Ottawa has not taken the actions. The capital has requested against anti-India elements so far, India's Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) said on Thursday. "We have seen comments of PM Trudeau that he believes in 'One India' policy, but so far, the actions we have requested against anti-India elements... no action has been taken. There is a gap between actions and words here," MEA Spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal was reported as saying in a press briefing. He pointed out that at least 26 extradition requests from the Indian side, sent over the last decade or more, were still pending with Canadian



authorities. "There are 26 extradition requests pending with the Canadian side, these are over the last decade or more, along with that, there are several provisional arrest requests, which are also pending with the Canadian side, of certain criminals," said Jaiswal, adding, "We had shared security related information with the Canadian government regarding gang members, including those of the Lawrence Bishnoi gang, and requested them to arrest them (criminals)... So far, no action has been taken by the Canadian side on our request."

The quantum of cow milk is put on mild flame for specific span of time until it got melted for pure ghee. It is widely claimed that cow milk is sacred substance, often used in religious rituals besides Ayurvedic treatments. Cow ghee must be used before 9 months from manufacturing date.



Milk fat is inherently expensive.Its current ex dairy price of Rs 460,-- 470 / is way above Rs 125 -- 130 , wholesale range for refined palmolein ,soyabean or sunflower oil. Yet,it is not incredible that if the ghee or melted milk fat is prone to adulteration by foreign. fats ,both of vegetable and animal fats.

Sukhna choe continues
polluting Zirakpur
environment

The authorities cannot ignore the horrendous effects of pollution on public health, their economical and psychological suffering or, rather, the slow termination of people. The environment is also degraded by persistent pollution. The time has come for the Punjab Chief Minister to fulfil his promise of cleaning the environment degradation. Deployment of manpower is needed to stop solid waste ingress into the dariya. At present, there is no solid waste enforcement force for issuing challans to the offenders. Two or three floating garbage barriers-cum-conveyors are also needed for taking out the solid waste which enters Ghaggar river. The sewage including domestic waste, plastics, slaughterhouse waste and animal carcasses — from the areas around the Sukhna choe. The authorities need to rebuild the fence around the Sukhna choe. Unfortunately, existing problem has persisted due to lack of political will by successive governments as well as most political parties, due to the fear of losing industry funding for elections, even though the polluted water affects over two crore people. Every day, millions of litres of untreated raw sewage is flowing into the Sukhna directly. The municipal council needs to find another plot to set up the pumping station and complete its construction on a war footing so that raw sewage can be stopped from being discharged into the Ghaggar Dariya at the earliest.

Along Sukhna Choe and Ghaggar river heavy quantum of sewage is being dumped round the clock. The consequential pollution there from is being disseminated uncontrolled and unregulated, destroying the human and enviromental life. Polluted water is the resultant consequence of the violation of Water (Pollution), Section 25, 26, Act 1974, air pollution sec 21, 22 act 1981 and environmental pollution Act 1986. The unchecked free flow of pollution, though diseased was invisible, still was caught and cognizance taken up on higher pedestal by the Justice (Retd) Sant Parkash, Chairman Punjab State Human Right Commission. The dismal, sluggish outcome is being watched with serious concern by the spate of poor patients in the hospitals where impatient long queues are seen waiting for their turn. It is now high time, if the 24 hours long continuity of sewage dump is not checked and hammered by the Regional Pollution Control authorities Mohali who has been a mute spectator for the past considerable time, who would cleanse the horizons and enviromental space ofZirakpur. The Sewerage Treatment Plant here had been lying flatly nose dived for the past over 3 years but shown under maintenance which is rubbishly false. On the contrary, facts reveal no maintenance can be allowed for ears together. The plant 17.3 MLD must be serviced and it's functionality

must be brought alive, but is being subjected to scourge. And other side, no construction afresh for another treatment plant is going on, since there is no availability of land, with the sewerage board. The smaller plant fails to shoulder the elephantine sewage load and repeatedly collapses. A large number of government, private hospitals are becoming testimony to these harsh proceedings and are seen flooded with the arrival of overwhelming strength of patients. Pollutants nevertheless invisible often implicate our eyes into slow burn, trigger inflammation and inconvenience breathing diffiicul and induce lung cancer too. Pollution destroys human and environmental health in mammoth number. The threat of pollution turns into major cause of premature deaths and diseases, in ultimate known cause of particular lung cancer. It may be underlined that uncontrolled pollution always germinates inflammatio, asthma,obesity, breast cancer, joint pains and lung cancer. On contacting Regional Pollution Control I/C, Chief Environmental Engineer, Rantez Sharma said Zirakpur had had 17.3 MLD STP and biger was being constructed at Sanouli village. The XEN perhaps didn't have requisite knowledge that no STP was working for the past 3 years as its functionality had collapsed due to heavy load on sewage pipes.The construction of new STP would start only after the land is procured.

CHB cancels allotment
of 20 small flats over
pending dues

CHANDIGARH : Action would be taken against the allottees of the remaining small flats scheme who had not paid licence fee and other dues. Chandigarh Housing Board (CHB) has cancelled the allotment of more 20 small flats over non-payment of licence fee. Earlier, the allotment of 20 such flats located in Sectors 49 and 56 was cancelled. Another cancellation has been incurred on the allotment of six small flats in Sector 49, three in the Industrial Area, seven in Ram Darbar and four such flats in Sector 38 (West) over dues to the tune of more than Rs 42

lakh. The allottees have been asked to hand over the possession of their respective flats in 30 days failing which the board would start the process of vacating the houses. The allotment was cancelled as neither the allottees cleared the fee dues nor did they respond to repeated show-cause notices. The flats were allotted under the Small Flats Scheme, for which the necessary licence fee has to be paid every month. Recently, the audit report had highlighted that the CHB had failed to recover licence fee/rent of Rs 44.26 crore from 13,464 defaulters.

45 acres land orchestrated
by Punjab for Metro depot
in New Chandigarh

MOHALI : Forest Department, the Punjab Government has now confirmed that the land was ready to be released, pending final approval of the Chief Minister. In a boost to the long-awaited Tricity Metro project, the Punjab Government has finally agreed to allocate 45 acres (18 hectares) in New Chandigarh for the construction of a Metro depot. The depot will be crucial for inspection and maintenance works related to the upcoming Metro lines. The issue of land allotment for the depot had been a persistent hurdle in the project's progress. The UT Administration had sent multiple reminders to the Punjab Government, urging them to clarify their stance on the matter. A senior official said it had been decided to release 45 acres in New Chandigarh for the construction of the depot. The file has been sent to the Chief Minister for final approval, which is expected within a week. Once approved, the land will be handed over to the UT Administration, he



added. The matter was a key agenda item during the Unified Metro Transportation Authority (UMTA) meeting held on September 2. While this marks a positive step for the New Chandigarh depot, the Punjab Government has declined to provide land for another proposed depot in Zirakpur. In its place, an alternative depot will now be constructed in Sector 27, Panchkula, with approval already secured from the Haryana Government. The depot allotments are part of the larger Metro development plan for the Tricity, which will see construction beginning in 2027 as part of the first phase, with completion expected by 2034. Phase 2 of the project will commence post-2037, further expanding the city's metro connectivity.

New DC office building
in Sector 17 to cost
Chandigarh Rs 125 cr

CHANDIGARH : “The construction of the building housing Deputy Commissioner will begin in the next financial year once the budget Rs 125 crore is approved by the centre. The interior layouts have also been finalised,” disclosed the authorities. The UT Engineering Department has prepared a detailed estimate of Rs 125 crore for the construction of a new building of the Deputy Commissioner (DC) office next to Hotel Shivalikview in Sector 17 here. The construction was initially scheduled to begin in April this year, but got postponed as budget was not allocated for the project. However, sources said the estimate was now prepared and sent to the Government of India for approval. In addition, the complex will incorporate environmental sustainability measures with a sewage treatment plant and a rooftop solar power plant to generate tertiary treated water and electricity.

The existing DC Office building in Sector 17 will be repurposed into a modern art gallery. An amphitheatre is also proposed to be constructed in front of it, adding cultural value to the area. The idea of relocating the DC office within Sector 17 has been under consideration since 2018. The officials said the soil testing report had cleared the proposed site, ensuring it could withstand the structural load. It was conducted to assess the chemical and physical composition of the soil, factoring in weather conditions, climate changes, and historical land usage. The project is expected to be completed within two years. The seven-storey building will conform to a 5-star

GRIHA (Green Rating for Integrated Habitat Assessment) rating, with a focus on reducing carbon emissions. The structure will have a basement parking facility for nearly 600 cars. The building will house several key departments, including Registering and Licensing Authority, Registrar Co-operative Societies, Excise and Taxation Department, Census Department, Election Department, Revenue Department, Tehsildar's Office, Food and Supplies Department, Labour Department, Industries Department, Colony Rehabilitation Wing, Building Branch, and Red Cross Society.

Chandigarh Club schedules for
elections on 16 Nov after 8 years

CHANDIGARH : The nominations for the election of Chandigarh Club will be filed on October 28 and 29. The voting day would be November 16 and the results will be announced on November 17. The Chandigarh Club having 7000 members is all set to hold its much-anticipated elections marking the end of an eight-year long wait. Members would cast their votes to elect the new executive body, including the president, vice-president and eight executive members. The results will be announced on November 17. nominations will be filed on October 28 and 29. Sitting vice-president Naresh Chaudhary's candidature has been endorsed by the family of late Mukesh Bassi, a former president of the club. He also enjoys the support of former Chandigarh Mayor Ravinder Pali, income tax lawyer Ravinder Krishan and CA Sunil Gupta, vice-chairperson of the Punjab State Economic Policy and Planning Board, RS

Sachdeva, Chairman, Punjab State Chapter, PHD Chamber of Commerce and Industry, along with other industrialists. Former president Sunil Khanna is another contender for the post of president. He is backed by the sitting president Sandeep Sahni and several business people and industrialists. Businessman Raju Mittal has re-entered the race, making the contest triangular. Mittal had contested the presidential elections in 2016, but lost to Sahni. The 2016 elections marked the last time the members voted, electing Sandeep Sahni as president. Before that, the elections were held in 2004, when Bassi was elected president. Bassi stepped down in 2011 after being elected as a councillor and Sahni took over as president.

Mohali to herald online
challan system soon

MOHALI : The online project is aimed at curbing traffic violations, hooliganism and illegal activities by monitoring 18 busy junctions in the city with CCTV surveillance. The Rs 17.70 crore project is set to cover 18 locations on the city roads with more than 400 cameras, besides two speed detectors on the Airport Road. A Central Command And Control Room set up on the top floor of the Sohana police station would monitor the feed of the four types of cameras – 63 installed for red light violation detection, 216 for

number plate recognition, 22 giving pan, tilt and zoom view, 104 bullet cameras along and two speed detectors. After the completion of installation work, online challans will be issued in Mohali. The installation of a city surveillance and traffic management system here is

in its final stages with cameras being installed at important junctions. By September 30, all cameras would be in place, said the police. This system would also have an e-challan and a virtual court. “It is a good thing that hi-tech cameras are being mounted for city surveillance but this has been done earlier also. It is the maintenance of the infrastructure that will be the key. Otherwise, everything will be junk in just one year,” said a road safety and traffic management expert.

Worth Rs 20 crore fuel saved by
e-buses within 2 years

CHANDIGARH : About 25.28 lakh litres of diesel worth Rs 20.80 crore has been saved within two and a half years by plying electric buses on local routes. Procured in November 2021, 80 electric buses are in service in the tricity at present, said a spokesman of the UT Transport Department. The electric buses had covered 1.26 crore km till August 16 on intra-city routes, thus saving over 25.28 lakh litres of diesel besides preserving environment. These buses have helped prevent 6674.91 tonne of CO2 emission. The e-bus fleet of the department included vehicles of Ashok Leyland and Eicher. In order to provide eco-friendly transportation in the city, the department plans to procure 100 more e-buses this year. The administration has plans to replace the entire fleet of 350



diesel buses of the Chandigarh Transport Undertaking (CTU), running both on local as well as suburban routes, with electric ones by 2027-28. Each bus covers a distance of nearly 130 km on a single charge. It takes nearly two hours to fully charge a vehicle. With a seating capacity of 36, a bus can carry a maximum of 54 people at a time. On an average, each bus covers 200-300 km a day. The State-Level Steering Committee (SLSC) has decided to replace 100 diesel buses with e-vehicles sanctioned by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to Chandigarh under the Centre-sponsored PM

e-Bus Sewa Scheme. The ministry will be requested to allocate 80 more buses to the city under this scheme. Apart from public transport, the share of private electric vehicles (EVs) is also increasing. Since the implementation of the EV Policy in September 2022, as many as 3,281 electric two-wheelers and 1,785 four-wheelers have been registered in the city till July 15. According to the data provided by the Registration and Licensing Authority (RLA), 352 electric two-wheelers and 114 four-wheelers were registered from September to December in 2022. The highest number of 2,103 electric two-wheelers and 1,013 four-wheelers had been registered in 2023 and 826 two-wheelers and 658 four-wheelers till July 15 this year in the city.

Superintendent at Ambala
Cantonment bus stand suspended

AMBALA/KARNAL : While inspecting the bus stand at Ambala Cantt, Anil Vij, Haryana transport minister on Monday found shabby and inhygienic condition bus stand and pulled up the officials for encroachments by shop keepers. The minister also issued directions to General Manager to suspend the bus stand superintendent for poor conditions and sought a complete record of the people running various shops at the bus stand. Vij, who reached here in a Haryana Roadways bus, inquired about the facilities. He also visited various shops being run at the bus stand. The minister pulled up the roadways officials after



seeing the encroachment by the shopkeepers. "This is public money, and the public demands accountability. Irregularities will not be tolerated. "The government has given transport department to me so I came here to see the situation so that before doing anything I know what was happening. There is lack of space for passengers because the shopkeepers have encroached the area in convenience with the officials. Appropriate

action will be taken. I will also get the quality of food checked. The toilet was in poor situation. I have been told that the sewerage was not working. I have suspended the bus stand superintendent," Vij said. Kuldeep Singh, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Karnal Depot, said that the minister has directed to register a case against a vendor for food supply. "Violation has been found at the canteen and action would be taken against the concerned," he said.

Ajay Kumar Singh appointed
new DGP of Jharkhand by
Election Commission

NEW DELHI/RANCHI : On September 3, 2021, the apex court pulled up the state government and the UPSC for their role in the appointment of an interim DGP in alleged violation of its judgement of a two-year fixed tenure for a state police chief who has to be selected from a list to be prepared by the UPSC. The Election Commission on Monday appointed Jharkhand cadre senior-most IPS officer Ajay Kumar Singh as the state DGP, days after the poll panel removed Anurag Gupta as the acting police chief revealed the sources. An officer of the 1989-batch of the Indian Police Service, Singh was selected from a panel of three IPS officers whose names were sent by the state government. The names were sent after the poll authority on Saturday

ordered the removal of acting DGP Anurag Gupta due to his "history" of election-related misconduct in previous polls. The state goes to polls in two phases on November 13 and 20. Singh was made the state's DGP in February 2023 after the retirement of his predecessor Neeraj Sinha. Singh's appointment last year ended the row over the appointment of the state's DGP as the Supreme Court had in January 2023 disposed of a contempt petition against the Jharkhand government and former police chief Neeraj Sinha. A petition had alleged that Sinha had been occupying the post of DGP even after his superannuation on January 31, 2022. A bench, led by Chief Justice DY Chandrachud, had then directed the state to attend to

the requisitions furnished by UPSC. On July 14, 2021, the court issued notices on the contempt plea against the state government, its top officials, and the UPSC for alleged violation of its verdict. Later in July, soon after Gupta's appointment notification, a rift surfaced in the JMM-led ruling alliance over the DGP's appointment. Then state Congress president Rajesh Thakur had said the alliance partners were not taken in confidence while making "such a major decision". Earlier this month, the EC had asked the state government to submit a panel of names of senior Indian Police Service (IPS) officers by October 21 morning to enable it to pick an officer to be named the next DGP.

Gurugram holistically aims
zero emission by 2050

GURUGRAM : As Gurugram features among the top polluted cities in the country, the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) has drawn a holistic plan to reduce emissions in the city. The authority has drafted a "net zero 2050" document, contouring the goals for urban policy-making to make Gurugram a zero emission city. Net-zero refers to the point at which a specific area or city is able to remove from the atmosphere all green house gases (GHGs) it is emitting. Effectively, it ensures that no additional carbon or other GHGs are being added into the atmosphere.



The document elaborates on the way forward to implement sustainable development strategies like construction of green buildings, setting up of centralised cooling plants in housing societies, adoption of cleaner technologies and increasing the share of electric vehicles over the next 25 years. The plan deals in four major arenas — energy, waste, transport and greenery.

Telecom billionaire czar
Sunil Mittal's voice cloned
while scammers did conning

NEW DELHI : In order to cautioned people about the risks posed by misuse of emerging technologies like AI. Scammers often use AI voice clones to con commoners to transfer money or disclose financial information, but it's rare when they try to impersonate a billionaire. This is exactly what scammers tried to do by cloning telecom czar Sunil Bharti Mittal's voice to scam his executive in Dubai to transfer money. Fortunately, the executive was smart enough to realise Mittal won't ask for such a huge money transfer and the scam was stopped in its tracks. Mittal recounted how the said executive stationed in Dubai received a fraudulent call that seemed to mimic his voice and tone and directed that a large fund transfer be done. The official who was vigilant and "sensible" immediately realised it was a scam, Mittal said admitting that when he heard the voice recording himself he was completely "stunned" as "it was perfectly articulated just as I would speak".



"And anyone who would not have been vigilant may have done something about it," Mittal said and warned that in future misuse of technology would enable fraudsters to go a step ahead and misuse digital signatures, even replicate faces on zoom calls to perpetrate such acts. "We'll have to protect our societies from the evils of AI, and yet we have to use the goodness of AI, because those companies, and nations that will not adopt AI will be left behind. So, this is a conundrum for every time you get a new technology into place, there are pluses and minuses. I remain very optimistic about the benefit of AI that the human race will achieve and be able to do jobs which are otherwise very difficult to perform," Mittal

said. It is pertinent to mention here that advent of tech era, powered by AI and digital tools, has armed economies and businesses with transformative powers. That said, it is also being misused blatantly by online scammers and fraudsters to dupe unsuspecting public. There are umpteen instances of fraudsters nudging victims to click on malicious links, or using deepfakes and voice cloning for scams. The sophisticated web of AI-powered deceit makes it harder to spot online scams, and fraudsters have been known to clone and mimic a person's voice from even short audio clips nicked from video a person may have uploaded online. Scammers then leverage the AI-cloned voice to pose as the person and demand money from friends and family. At the same time, scammers are also using 'digital arrest' modus operandi, where they place audio or video calls, falsely pose as law enforcement officers, and use online intimidation to confine victims to their homes for extortion.
