Mr. Trump said the hearing had been a "despicable charade" and that he planned to appeal his conviction.New York State Judge Juan Merchan sentences President-elect Donald Trump as he appears remotely for a sentencing hearing at New

Donald Trump was sentenced on Friday (January 10, 2025) in his hush money case, but the judge declined to impose any punishment, an outcome that cements his conviction while freeing him to return to the White House unencumbered by the threat of a jail term or a fine. The punishment-free judgment marks a quiet end to an extraordinary case that for the first time put a former President and major presidential candidate in a court-room as a criminal defendant.

#### Los Angeles faces pile of ashes, rubbles

Commissioner News Service Los Angeles: Firefighters continue to battle a series of major wildfires that have killed at least five people in the Los Angeles area of United States' California. Officials are hoping the firefighters would make progress in controlling the blazes as ferocious winds that drove the flames were not expected to be "as powerful" during the day. A new fire began near the West Hills neighbourhood of Los Angeles on Thursday afternoon, leading to more evacuations. The fire department has issued orders for the "Kenneth Fire." According



to Sheriff Robert Luna of the Los Angeles County, officials plan to a curfew around the two major fires that would be in place from 6 pm on Thursday until 6 am the next day. The curfews will only affect the "heavily impacted" areas, Luna said, adding that authorities were

looking primarily at the zones.Los Angeles County fire chief Anthony Marrone said the Eaton area fire has destroyed over 4,000 structures, including homes, apartment buildings, commercial buildings or even vehicles.President Joe Biden called these "the worst fires ever to hit Los Angeles" and declared having approved additional funding for National California. 





You should've been prompt in sending the reports to the Speaker and having a discussion at the floor of the assembly," the court pulled the Delhi government."Such delay in sending the reports to the Lieutenant Governor and your handling of the matter raises doubts about your bona fides." bemoaned Justice Sachin Dutta of the Hon'able High Court .The court also posted the plea by BJP MLAs, including Vijender Gupta, seeking a special session of the Delhi Assembly for later today, but also said, "We are at a stage that the elections are around the corner.
