Rupee hits record low, Gold price soars to Rs 1,30,300 per 10 g to storm past in Delhi

Commissioner News Service NEW DELHI prices skyrocketed by Rs 9,700 to scale a fresh peak of Rs 1,30,300 per 10 grams in the national capital on Monday, lifted by safe-haven buying in the overseas markets and depreciation in the rupee.

According to the All Sarafa Association. yellow metal of 99.9 per cent purity had closed at Rs 1,20,600 per 10 grams on Friday.



In the local bullion market, gold of 99.5 cent purity jumped by Rs 2,700 to hit a record high of Rs 1,22,700 per 10 grams (inclusive of all taxes) on Monday. It had settled at Rs 1,20,000 per 10 grams in the previous \$48.75 per ounce. market session.

Silver prices also witnessed robust gains. The white metal bounced by Rs 7,400 to hit a new peak of Rs 1,57,400 kilogram (inclusive of all taxes). It had ended at Rs 1,50,000 per kg on Friday.

In the international markets, spot gold rose nearly 2 per cent to touch an all-time high of \$3,949.58 per ounce, while silver went up over 1 per cent to hit a high of

Gurugram holistically aims zero emission by 2050

Gurugram among the top polluted cities in the country, the Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority (GMDA) has drawn a holistic plan to reduce emissions in the city.

The authority has drafted a 'net zero 2050' document, contouring the goals for urban policymaking to make Gurugram a zero emission city. Net-zero refers to the point at which a specific area or city is able to remove from the atmosphere all green house gases (GHGs) it is emitting. Effectively, it ensures that no additional carbon or other GHGs are being

The document elaborates on the way forward to implement sustainable development strategies like construction of green buildings, setting up of centralised cooling plants in housing societies, adoption of cleaner technologies and increasing the share of electric vehicles over the next 25 years. The plan deals in four major arenas energy, transport and greenery.

Tejas fighter to be rolled out in Oct 25

Commissioner News Service Nasik: Tejas fighter to be rolled out in Oct25 Nasik. On April7, 2023, the HAL Nasik division inaugurated the third production line for manufacturing Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) MK1A. It was inaugurated by the then defence secretary

Giridhar Aramane. The new target date for the rollout is Oct17 and defence minister Rajnath Singh is likely to attend, although his confirmation is still pending.

This new facility in Nasik is the third production line for the Tejas LCA MK1A. HAL currently has two production lines in



Bengaluru, producing 16 annually.

With an investment of over Rs 150 crore, the Nashik facility will add an additional eight per units year, increasing HAL's total production capacity to 24 jets per annum.

The availability of GE-404 engines was the issue that delayed the rollout of its first LCA MKIA jet. "But we are managing with the

available and expected engines. Supply is likely to be regular next year," the sources said. HAL recently received the third GE-404 engine for the LCA-MK1A (Tejas MK1A) and another engine is expected to delivered shortly. The MK1A variant of the LCA includes improvements combat avionics and

air-to-air refueling capabilities. The Nashik division of HAL has a total of employees, including 1,188 technical experts, 624 experts for technical support and 395


