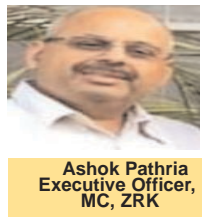

Lalru : More and more illegal constructions have been taking place as no fear of legal action has been seen in the mind of municipal official. The town has been evolving as slum entity as there are plenty of arbitrarily encroached syndromes. The civic body has been advised to take police help to get the encroachments vacated with out any further delay. Reviewing the encroachments issue with Additional Deputy Commissioner (UD) Anmol Singh Dhaliwal, Executive Officer Gurbakshish Singh and Assistant Municipal Engineer Hardeep Singh, at District Administration the Deputy Commissioner Ms Aashika Jain sensitized the audience that all the urban local bodies should take the illegal encroachment and constructions, by-passing building by-



laws, seriously. In defiance of existing Municipal norms, the respective head will be held responsible for dereliction in duty for turning blind eye to the encroachment/illegal

construction. Aashika Jain made it clear that the encroachments and illegal constructions may cause a serious problem to the general public in future besides a setback to state revenue by illegal occupation of government land or not paying the notified fee for drawings. She directed the Municipal body to get the police help besides appointing a district magistrate from Sub Divisional Magistrate to get the encroachment vacated and take action against the illegal constructions. She said that some of the land of the pond that has been encouraged upon, should be converted to park or play ground after getting vacated, in Lalru. The Deputy Commissioner said that the rest of the Municipal Councils should also take care of their areas to get rid of illegal encroachments.

Washington : Latest salvo from President Donald Trump's of a 25% blanket tariff on all imports of steel and aluminium into the U.S. are apparent blows in a series of announcements and executive orders, just days before Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Washington, that have affected India. The government has demurred from commenting on these moves or stuck to muted responses. Announcing the move, Mr. Trump said there would be "no exemptions" to



the tariffs, that are expected to come into force on March 4. "It's time for our great industries to come back to America... this is the first of many," remarked the U.S. President suggesting other tar-

iff announcements will follow. On Monday, Union Steel Secretary Sandeep Poudrik maintained a stoic stance on the new tariffs, stating India's steel exports to the U.S. are miniscule, with just 95,000 tonnes exported to the U.S. last year from India's total output of 145 million tonnes. "So, how does it matter if you are not able to export 95,000 tonnes?" he remarked at an event organised by Bengal Chamber of Commerce and industry.

Non bailable warrant issued against Baba Ram Dev

Commissioner News Service Palakkad :Non-bailable warrant has been issued by 1st class magistrate of court II against Baba Ram Dev non-bailable arrest warrant against Yoga guru Baba Ramdev, his aide Acharya Balkrishna, and Divya Pharmacy, the marketing arm of Patanjali Ayurved, in connection with a misleading advertisements case based on a petition filed by the Drugs Inspector Palakkad in October 2024. The court took this action after they failed to appear despite previous summons and a bailable warrant. The case was filed by the Drugs Inspector, Palakkad, in October 2024 under the Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act, 1954. The case focussed on allegations that Patanjali Ayurved falsely



claimed in news media advertisements that its products could cure high blood pressure and diabetes. The accused failed to do so, a bailable warrant was issued, directing them to appear on February 1. Patanjali Ayurved has been accused of making unverified medical claims about its products, leading to legal actions in multiple locations. However, their continued absence led the court to escalate the matter by issuing a non-bailable warrant. The next hearing in the case is scheduled for February 15

EDITORIAL –

Greenhouse gas emission must get obliterated

The green transition is driven by several factors, such as energy intensity, investment flows, consumption patterns and distribution systems. But its success hinges on humanity's ability to move away from "dirty" fossil fuels toward clean, There is urgent need to reduce dependence on fossil fuels and shift to renewable energy, and in recent years, many governments have pledged to reach net-zero greenhouse-gas emissions, albeit over extremely long timeframes. But they will never get there so long as they treat electricity, which is central to the clean-energy transition, like any other market good. Renewable energy sources, particularly solar and wind. And that requires a profound transformation in how electricity is generated, distributed and consumed. Economists and policymakers have long framed the energy transition as a question of relative prices. In recent decades, wind and solar costs have plummeted, driven by technological advances - especially in China, where government interventions have helped scale up green industries and drive down the so-called levelised cost of energy (LCOE). According to this widely used metric for comparing power sources, renewables have consistently outperformed fossil fuels, even before external shocks like the Ukraine war sent oil and gas prices soaring. In theory, these developments should have expedited the global transition away from fossil fuels. In practice, however, renewable-energy sources merely supplement the total power supply. Meanwhile, both developed and developing countries continue to increase fossil-fuel production and invest heavily in exploring new reserves. The discrepancy cannot be fully explained by market forces or relative prices. Over the years, many have blamed political leaders for the lack of climate progress, especially after climate-change denialists rose to power in countries like the US and Argentina. But this explanation, too, is incomplete. Renewable energy has become cheaper than fossil fuels, the profits it generates are low and unreliable. Christophers vividly describes this self-cannibalising dynamic, highlighting how it has played out across different economies, from the US and Norway to India. Solution is not to subsidise green capitalism by derisking investments, although such measures are unavoidable if renewable energy is to remain viable. Instead, the key is recognising that electricity is not a commodity. Consequently, we must restructure all aspects of energy production and distribution, encompassing renewables and fossil fuels alike. Most importantly, achieving true decarbonisation requires governments to adopt a more proactive approach. Instead of acting as behind-the-scene market facilitators, policymakers must take direct responsibility for producing and distributing renewable energy. Such an approach is far from radical. Before the rise of neoliberalism, governments played a pivotal role in building and managing critical infrastructure, including energy systems. To facilitate the green transition, they must reclaim that responsibility.

Rs 271 crore Jan GST collection, goes up by 8%

After witnessing a decline in December last year, the Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection in the city in January increased by 8% compared to the gross levy collected during the corresponding period in 2024. In December last year, the GST collection saw a decline of 20%. The collection for December last year stood at Rs 224 crore, which was Rs 57 crore less than Rs 281 crore generated in the same month in 2023.

No optional procurement of service charge from consumers : UT

Commissioner News Service CHANDIGARH : "It had been noticed that some restaurants and hotels were levying service charge in the bill by default, without informing consumers that paying such charge was voluntary and optional", said an official of the Food and Supplies department. Now, the UT Department of Food and Supplies and Consumer Affairs and Legal Metrology has issued an advisory in public interest to hotels and restaurants that no hotel or restaurant shall add service charge automatically or by default to the bill. Service charge is being levied in addition to the total price of the food items mentioned in the menu and applicable taxes, often in the guise of some other fee or charge. Further, It has also been noticed that some customers have been paying tips to waiters in addition to service charges under the mistaken impression that service charge is a part of taxes. As per the guidelines issued by the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA), service charge cannot be added to the bill involuntarily, without allowing consumers the choice or discretion to decide whether they want to pay such charge or not. The department stated that, "Service charge shall not be collected from consumers by any other name. No hotel or restaurant shall force a consumer to pay service charge and shall clearly inform the

consumer that service charge is voluntary, optional and at consumer’s discretion.” No restriction on entry or provision of services based on collection of service charge shall be imposed on consumers. Service charge shall not be collected by adding it along with the food bill and levying GST on the total amount, adds the department. The department informed the public that if any consumer finds a hotel or restaurant that is levying service charge in violation to the mentioned guidelines, a consumer may make a request to the hotel or restaurant concerned to remove service charge from the bill amount. Lodge a complaint on the Consumer Helpline, which works as an alternative dispute redressal mechanism at the pre-litigation level by calling 1915 or through WhatsApp number 8800001915 or through the NCH mobile app. Consumers can file a complaint against unfair trade practice with the Consumer Commission. The Complaint can also be filed electronically through portal www.e-jagriti.gov.in for its speedy and effective redressal and submit a complaint to the CCPA by e-mail at com-ccpa@nic.in. A consumer can also send a complaint to the Department of Food & Supplies and Consumer Affairs and Legal Metrology by helpline number at 0172-2703956 or email at fcschd@nic.in for subsequent proceeding by the CCPA.

Dallewal adhering to medical aid, Centre-farmer talks to be held Feb 14

Soon after, medical teams on standby started the treatment, said Kotra. Dallewal, however, maintained that he would not take food till the government agreed to a legal guarantee on the MSP. Kotra said Dallewal had expressed the desire that the first meeting should be held in Chandigarh and the second in Delhi. Hectic activity was witnessed at Khanauri after the farm bodies protesting on the Punjab border with Haryana

said they had got a “decent proposal” from the Centre regarding their demands even as farmer groups could not draw a unity plan during their second round of talks. Sources said the Centre had put a condition that Dallewal would have to accept treatment if they wanted the proposal to materialise. Earlier, Priya Ranjan visited Khanauri and met Dallewal. After meeting the fasting leader, representatives of the Centre, led by Ranjan, held nearly two-hour talks with the protesting farmers, following which they made the offer. Without revealing the details of the proposal, farmer leader Kotra said, “We have received a decent proposal and are discussing its modalities.” The sources said former Punjab DIG Narinder Bhargav and former ADGP Jaskaran Singh played a crucial role in arranging the meeting. This was the first time since February 18 last year when representatives of the Centre held formal talks with the protesting farmer leaders over their demands. The protesting farmers, led by the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (Non-Political) and the Kisan Mazdoor Morcha, have been protesting at the Shambhu and Khanauri borders since February 13 when their march to Delhi was halted by the security forces.

over how to deal with the U.S. tariffs.Hong Kong has long been known as a free and open trading hub, but China's imposition on Hong Kong of a sweeping national security law in 2020 drew criticism from the U.S. and led it to end the former British colony's special status under US law, escalating tensions between China and the U.S.The US subsequently stipulated that goods made in Hong Kong for export to the U.S. needed to be labelled as made in China, ending one of Hong Kong's long standing competitive advantages as a trading hub.

US President Trump Says Will Impose 25% Tariffs On All Steel, Aluminium Imports

Commissioner News Services Washington DC: In yet another major escalation of his trade policy overhaul, US President Donald Trump announced that on Monday the United States will impose 25 per cent tariffs on all steel and aluminium imports, which would come on top of additional metal duties--expected to be disclosed later in the week. Speaking to reporters aboard Air Force One on Sunday while he was on his way to the NFL Super Bowl in New Orleans, Trump also said he would announce reciprocal tariffs as early as Tuesday, which would take effect almost immediately. The Republican, however, did not clarify who would be targeted with the reciprocal tariffs,



but he stressed the US would match tariff rates levied by other countries and that this would apply to all countries. "And very simply, it's, if they charge us, we charge them," he said on his reciprocal tariff plan. During his first White House term from 2016-2020, Trump imposed a 25 per cent tariff on steel and 10 per cent

on aluminium but later granted several trading partners duty-free quotas, including Canada, Mexico and Brazil. Former President Joe Biden extended these quotas to Britain, Japan and the European Union, and US steel mill capacity utilization has dropped in recent years.

Swati Maliwal MP posts a painting of 'Draupadi's cheer haran'

New Delhi : With the BJP poised to form a government in Delhi after more than 26 years, Rajya Sabha MP Swati Maliwal on Saturday took a veiled swipe at the Arvind Kejriwal-led Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) in Delhi. On January 30, Maliwal was detained by the police after she dumped three mini-truckloads of garbage outside the residence of former Arvind Kejriwal in protest.

Stop conflating Sheikh Hasina with India, Bangladesh envoy cautioned

The Indian Foreign Secretary met with Yunus and Foreign Advisor Md. Touhid Hossain during the visit
