GCRC MEMBER TYPES

****** GCRC Full Voting Members ******

Elected State / County Committee Members who must be registered Republicans and live in Grafton County.

Vacancies are filled by election of nominated registered Republicans who live in Grafton County and elected by majority vote from GCRC full voting members.

Those elected become GCRC Full-Voting-Members.

****** GCRC Associate Members ******

Must be Registered Republicans who live in Grafton County.

Associate members may vote on event related issues.

Associate members may not vote on GCRC policies, bylaws, or in the election of GCRC executive board members.

Both GCRC Full Voting Members and GCRC Associate Members be current on dues.

****** GCRC Guests******

Undeclared and non Grafton County residents may attend with advance notice.

Guests should be escorted by one of the two member types:

**A. BE OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED BY THE
GCRC & NH SOS**

**B. HAVE TWO MEMBER TYPES:
FULL VOTING AND ASSOCIATE**

**FULL VOTING MEMBERS
MAY VOTE IN OFFICIAL MEETINGS ON
ANY AND ALL ISSUES**

MUST BE:

- 1. REGISTERED REPUBLICANS**
- 2. RESIDENT OF GRAFTON COUNTY**
- 3. UP TO DATE WITH MEMBERSHIP DUES IN THE
REGIONAL SUB COMMITTEE**

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

**MAY VOTE IN OFFICIAL MEETINGS ON EVENT
RELATED ISSUES
(NOT POLICY, BYLAWS, OR BOARD POSITIONS)**

MUST BE:

- 1. REGISTERED REPUBLICAN WHO MAY LIVE IN
OR OUTSIDE COUNTY**
- 2. UP TO DATE WITH REGIONAL SUBCOMMITTEE
MEMBERSHIP DUES**

GUESTS

**Undeclared and non Grafton County residents may
attend General meetings with advance notice.**

**Guests should be escorted in our General
Meetings by one of the two official member types:**

- Full-Voting-Members**
- Associate Members**
