HURRICANE IRMA

Reunion 2017 in Charleston was memorialized by Hurricane Irma that formed August 30th, destroying most of Puerto Rico before setting its sites on Florida and beyond. Winds were recorded to be in excess of 180 mph. With reunion plans set for September 7-10 at the Crowne Plaza Charleston Airport, we all were keeping a watchful eye on Hurricane Irma.

"Do we go to the reunion? ... and will we be able to get home?" A question that we had to ask ourselves. Of course all that changed as it continued to move north and forecasts that indicated Charleston could be in its path. The uncertainty caused many shipmates to cancel plans to attend but despite the threat, 70 shipmates and guests were on hand to party.

With the threat of a hurricane, it became necessary to modify our reunion plans to condense activities to 3 days to a welcome dinner, a tour of Patriots Point and then a farewell banquet. However, this change meant that our planned entertainment of the Dave and Daphne Show would not take place because they had a conflict that they could not resolve.

When the city began implementing its contingency plan, many of the Charleston attractions began closing their doors which included Patriots Point and Fort Sumner, our planned tours. The Crowne Plaza was designated as the First Responders hotel and was pleased that our event was short-lived but as the storm progressed, it moved further west into Florida.





SS Warrimoo

A FASCINATING SHORT SEA STORY

The passenger steamer SS Warrimoo was quietly knifing its way through the waters of the mid-Pacific on its way from Vancouver to Australia. The navigator had just finished working out a star fix and brought the master, Captain John Phillips, the result. The Warrimoo's position was LAT 0º 31' N and LON 179 30' W. The date was 31 December 1899.

"Know what this means?" First Mate Payton broke in, "We're only a few miles from the intersection of the Equator and the International Date Line".

Captain Phillips was prankish enough to take full advantage of the opportunity for achieving the navigational freak of a lifetime. He called his navigators to the bridge to check & double check the ships position. He changed course slightly so as to bear directly on his mark. Then he adjusted the engine speed The calm weather & clear night worked in his favor.

> At mid-night the SS Warrimoo lay on the Equator at exactly the point where it crossed the International Date Line! The consequences of this bizarre position were many:

The forward part (bow) of the ship was in the Southern Hemisphere & in the middle of summer. The rear (stern) was in the Northern Hemisphere & in the middle of winter. The date in the aft part of the ship was 31 December 1899 In the bow (forward) part it was 1 January 1900.

> This ship was therefore not only in: Two different days, Two different months, Two different years, Two different seasons But in two different centuries - all at the same time. ~ GO NAVY ~

Howdy Shipmates,

I have succeeded in negotiating a contract with the Four Points by Sheraton French Quarter in New Orleans for June 10-14, 2019. The rate is \$99 and includes breakfast for two and this rate is good for Sunday 9th if you choose to come in a day early. Parking is discounted to \$20/night Valet parking at the hotel. They will charge the fee to your room. You can examine the hotel by going to this link <u>Four</u> <u>Points Sheraton French Quarter</u>. For reservations, use this special Edisto link: <u>Edisto Room Reservation</u> or call 1-(888) 627-7596

The hotel insists we have a 45 day cutoff date of April 25, 2019 so to guarantee a room with the discounted rate, you must make reservations before that date. Friday 14th is the normal checkout day. Rates go up for weekend as shown below.

You may cancel 24 hours before arrival without penalty. Otherwise they will charge for one night. Traditional rooms are those without balconies. The latter are normally charged at a much higher rate but I was able to get discounted rates should anyone wish a room with a balcony. Here is the breakdown on room rates:

June 9-14

Traditional Room Single: \$99 + tax Traditional Room Double \$99 + tax

Discounted Weekend rate (Fri & Sat)

Traditional Room \$149 + tax Balcony Courtyard \$159 + tax Balcony Toulouse Street \$189 + tax Balcony Bourbon Street \$209 + tax

It is recommended that you make your reservations now. You can cancel by June 8th if necessary or at least 24 hours before planned arrival without being charged one night's penalty.

Taxi to/from the Louis Armstrong Airport (MSY) is approximately \$33-35 a couple for taxi and \$15 for 3rd person. UberX and Lyft as well as Veterans Cab (504-367-6767 and Yellow Cab (504) 207-7777 are available.

Negotiated parking fee is \$20/night Valet parking with the hotel which will charge the fee to your room.
