

Faith Free on a Mission

1 In my former book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and to teach ² until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen. ³ After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God. ⁴On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. ⁵ For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." ⁶ Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" ⁷ He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 1:1-8

As the risen Lord stood before His disciples they seemed very concerned about the future. Wouldn't you? They had walked three years with Jesus – the Savior. They witnessed many miracles, their hearts had been pierced by His Words, seen Him journey to the cross. They then watched from distance as Jesus was crucified. At this their hopes were dashed. I am sure they wondered what now? What does our future hold now?

I am sure they didn't anticipate things would turn out the way they did. Although, several times Jesus told them He had to go to Jerusalem and die and three days later He would rise from the dead. One such instance we find in Gospel of Matthew.

²² When they came together in Galilee, he said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men. ²³ They will kill him, and on the third day he will be raised to life." And the disciples were filled with grief.

Matthew 17:22-23

Yet it sure seems they forgot. In Acts 1 they are concerned about what future holds and if Jesus was ushering in at that time the consummation of His Kingdom. Jesus answers their question by stating, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by His own authority."

Jesus is clear that their mind was going in the wrong direction. While they were looking for final restoration of Israel Jesus turned their thoughts to the transformation of both Jew and Gentile. God had a bigger plan and a clear call. Jesus didn't want them to be caught up in the future so as to forget the urgency of the moment.

Jesus states instead of getting occupied with the future be engaged in the mission He calls them to. He states this succinctly in Acts 1:8." You shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Instead of future questions and concerns they were to focus on being a witness to the love and message of Jesus Christ. His love is seen in His life, death and resurrection. His message is that to all who believe He gives the right to become Children of God. They were to be witnesses to this reality.

This is a word and challenge to us as Faith Free. There is much fear and concern about the future. Questions abound. What about the economy? Is my job secure? Does government offer any help? How can I afford to retire? Will my health hold out? Just what does the future hold? Legitimate questions and concerns and while needing to address these in some measure it is not our call to pave out the future and answer all the questions. What is our call as believers is to engage in Christ's mission. If you are not sharing Christ and building up His body frankly you're not fulfilling His call to you as a Christian. No other pursuit should replace this call. It is a divine mandate.

Jesus says before you let these concerns wrap themselves around your mind, go and be my witness!! Faith Free that is what God is saying to us. "Faith Free go be my witness. Witness to my love and grace. Don't hold back. Get moving. Go to all in your sphere of influence. Do it NOW." Born out of these convictions has been birthed our mission statement.

Yes, we all face questions about the future with many challenges. But let's be about His mission. Together Faith Free let us reach out together and share the love of Christ seen in His saving work and His message that He will by is grace save those who come to Him in faith. Let's Go!


Pastor Matt's New Book Editorial Review of "Leading Those You Love"
