How to spend a daily quiet time with God

1. Preparation.

- A. Set a consistent time (see Psalm 5:3) Identify your best alert time. Try to avoid being rushed.
- B. Start small and let it grow.
- C. Set your schedule around this time.
- D. Choose a quiet place. (Mark 1:35 Jesus did)
- E. Have Bible and notebook.

2. Action

- A. Quiet your mind and heart before Him. (Psalm 46:10) You can do this by praying, singing, or playing worshipful songs.
- B. Ask God to speak to your heart and help you to hear.
- C. Intentionally commit to God distracting thoughts.

3. Read Scripture

- A. Have a plan. If you are just getting started read out of the New Testament. You don't have to read a lot but make sure you are thinking about what you read.

4. Meditate

- A. Think about what God's Word is saying. Ask yourself questions. Consider grid of questions. Examples below.

- Is there a command to obey?
Is there a promise to claim?
Is there an example for me to follow?
Is there a temptation or error to avoid?
Is there a sin to confess?
Is there a truth for me to believe?
- What do these verses tell me about God?
What do these verses tell me about myself and others?
Is there an action for me to take based on what I have read?

5. Journalize

- A. Briefly jot down what God is telling you through the Bible reading. Make it personal. Record struggles or questions to study further or ask for advice.

6. Pray

- A. Talk to God heart to heart – pray back to Him - What He has taught you?
- B. Commit your day to Him.
- C. Pray for others.

7. Share

- A. Colossians 3:16) one of most natural ways to encourage and witness is to share with others what you read and what God is doing in your personal life.

8. Seek accountability

- A. I will spend time with God at this time? _____
- B. I will spend time with God by reading _____
- C. I will ask _____ to hold me accountable by asking me how my quiet times are going.
I will ask this person next week.

JASMINE'S JOURNEY

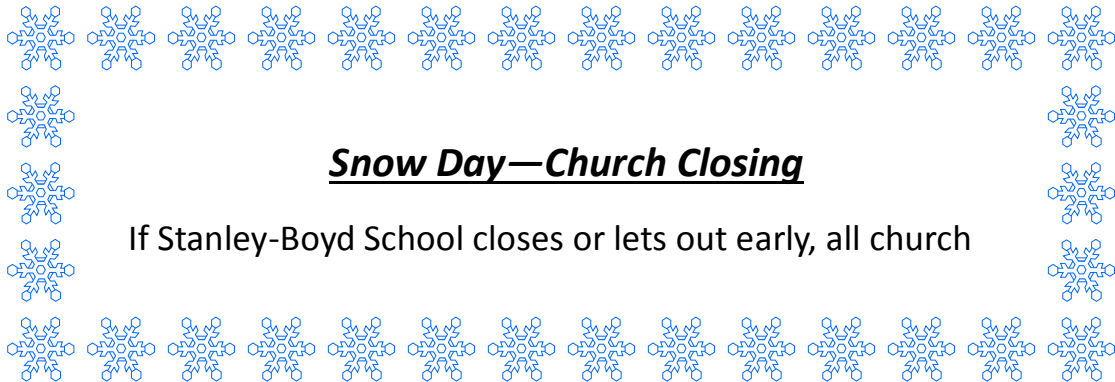
DECEMBER 31, 2021
