
Thank you for all your kind expressions to us this past month! Pastor Matt and Pastor MP

Children's Ministry

This fall is bringing many changes to the children's ministry! First off, I would like to introduce myself. My name is Jaime Barth, I have recently been hired as the Childrens Ministry Coordinator and I am so grateful and blessed to be in this position! A little about me! I was raised up in this church and, also the church school from ages 5 on through 12th grade! I accepted Christ into my life at the age of five. God led me to many mission fields during my high school years. After high school I spent a year in China teaching English in a Christian School. Upon returning I went to UW- Stevens point for Communications Disorders and eventually transferred to UW-Eau Claire and graduated with a focus in Psychology Behavior, Research and Communication Science and Disorders. I also spent a few years teaching in a couple daycares from Birth through school age. I have a wealth of classes and experience in childcare. I am a bible believing, prayer focused, single mom and breast cancer survivor and I am so thankful and excited to be back in the area and to have my little one Charlie Grace who just turned 5 here growing up in this church family as well.

The mission statement of the church states "Faith Evangelical Free Church is made up of a community of believers dedicated to helping connect everyone, everywhere, every day with the love and message of Jesus Christ. "My goal is to bring focus to connect everyone to the precious children in this church and local communities. I want to serve those parents that just need a break to followship and worship Jesus! I want to serve the parents that want someone to come along and help disciple their children with bible beliefs. I want to serve those parents that want their children to have Godly men and women to help equip them for standing firm in their faith as they grow. To do this I will be asking many high schoolers, men, and women of the church to join me in this goal by helping in the nursery and kid's church. Nursery is up and running again on a regular basis for birth thru 3 years. Kids Church will also begin again starting November 5th on the 1st, 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of the month. Kids connection group will be the 2nd Sunday of the month. We want to see your kids and grandchildren here!

Kids Club is up and running! We have had up to 22 kids on our Wednesday nights this fall! So fun to see so many young ones running around playing games, coloring, making crafts, memorizing bible verses, worshiping Jesus through songs and reading their bibles. We are currently sharing the stories of Daniel with a focus on we are not alone- God is with us just like he was with Shadrach, Meshach and Abednago in the fiery furnace! In addition, the 3rd through 5th graders have been memorizing the books of the Bible! Don't forget to help and encourage them at home or when you see them around church to remember those verses.
