The Colorado State Council and Board of Directors recognize that there are many Emergency Nurses throughout the State of Colorado. Many of these nurses' work in various settings which may include hospitals, emergency department, free-standing emergency departments, and urgent care centers. Many of these facilities are in urban, suburban, and rural settings.

The goal of the Colorado ENA Liaison program is to have at least one Colorado ENA Member assigned to each healthcare facility (e.g., Hospital ED, FSED, UC) and be a key contact to the facility where they practice and to the Colorado ENA State Council.

The Colorado ENA Liaison will provide vital communication and updates to their department where they practice and provide professional perspective and key insights through active participation in state council meetings. They will represent CO ENA and share with your department (e.g., meeting reminders, forward newsletter, or post information in your department). They commit to reading email from Colorado ENA and attend CO ENA meeting (at least 1 meeting via Zoom or in person) and encourage their department to attending meetings (send meeting link, schedule a watch party or organize a carpool to a meeting).

What is the Benefit:

- Reimburse half of an annual ENA membership.
- Delegate points to represent CO ENA at General Assembly in San Diego, CA.
