 - **Member Representation:**

- **Membership Support:**

 - Help identify opportunities to connect with potential and current members.
 - Promote the value of ENA membership through direct engagement and outreach.
- **Communications & Social Media:**
 - Monitor and respond to emails in a timely manner to stay informed and responsive to board and member needs.
 - Collaborate with the Media Committee to contribute ideas and content for social media posts that inform and engage members on current events, initiatives, and opportunities.
- **Board Participation:**
 - Attend all board meetings and actively contribute to decision-making processes.
 - Provide a grassroots perspective on issues that affect clinical nurses and local leaders.
