 - Update on SB25-166 on workplace violence act for CO legislation

 - Cold water drowning- working with Parks and Wildlife to get signage and information out to Colorado bodies of water
 - Encouraging people to wear lifejacket in these bodies of water

 - Ten (10) academic scholarship recipients were awarded for 2025- first year we had more applicants than scholarships to give out

 - Call for speakers just went out
- Trauma and Pediatrics- Kati Stolz-Grindinger

 - Committee is charged with reviewing instructor scores and keeping the integrity and quality of ENA courses
 - Instructor Round up 6/6- 32 attendees
 - Stop the bleed course and CE opportunity given during round up
 - Teddy Bear Triage- 6/25, 7/30 and 8/13 at a volunteer library in Colorado Springs to read a book to kids and allow them to treat a teddy bear
 - Trauma Nurse Advanced Course (TNAC)- 3 instructors from Colorado- precourse modules, classroom sessions and simulation; labor intensive, but a great course
 - COENA wants to bring this course to CO to allow ED RNs to take this course that counts for the requirements for hospitals training and education
 - 25 hours of CE available for completing this course

 - ENStrong- CO made top 10 for fundraising
 - Social media leaders- tied for 4th place in the US
 - Team points- CO was 6th in US- got points for amount of money and engagement the team has for being active on social media or creating a page
