

Trauma / Pediatric: Instructor Candidate and Evaluator Resource

(TP-ICER) V 8: 2024

In order to complete the process of becoming a TNCC/ENPC Instructor, a TNCC or ENPC Committee Member or qualified designee must evaluate the instructor candidate's ability while lecturing, teaching & testing. Based upon our increase in individuals taking instructor courses, at times we have difficulty monitoring all of our Instructor candidates. As we are challenged to develop a list of qualified Course Directors to assist with the monitoring of instructor candidates, our Colorado ENA TNCC and ENPC committee has developed a process for meeting this need. The first choice for monitoring Instructor Candidates will always be state faculty. However, when unavailable, an approved TP-ICER may perform that duty.

TP-ICER criteria that will be used in the selection process of the applicants is listed below.

The Course Director must:

- 1. Be an experienced course director who regularly course directs (at least two courses per year)
- 2. Have directed at least 4 provider courses prior to acting as a TP-ICER
- 3. Have Quality Assurance evaluation scores of 3.5 or better at the time of the application review
- 4. If approved, TP-ICER permission will be for one time permission only.
- 5. If approved, I understand that the TP-ICER / Candidate ratio is 1:1
- 6. TP-ICERs who have monitored candidates on two separate occasions will be granted full permission and no longer need to complete this form. It is recommended to save a copy prior to submission.
