



Become a CO ENA Liaison!

The Colorado State Council and Board of Directors recognize that there are many Emergency Nurses throughout the State of Colorado. Many of these nurses work in various settings which may include hospitals, emergency departments, freestanding emergency departments, and urgent care centers in urban, suburban, and rural settings.

The goal of the Colorado ENA Liaison program is to have at least one Colorado ENA Member assigned to each healthcare facility (e.g., Hospital ED, FSED, UC) and be a key contact to the facility where they practice and to the Colorado ENA State Council.

You will be vital to providing communication and updates to your department and provide a professional perspective and key insights through active participation in state council meetings. You will represent CO ENA and share with your department the following: meeting reminders, forward newsletter, or post information in your department. You are committing to read emails from Colorado ENA, attend CO ENA meetings (at least 1 meeting via Teams or in person) and encourage your department to attend meetings (examples: send the meeting links, schedule a watch party or organize a carpool to a meeting). You must be an ENA member to be a CO ENA liaison.

- Delegate points to represent CO ENA at General Assembly.
