Rooms are allocated by Water Sports and All Star Liveaboards, and we do our best to honour rooming requests when possible.

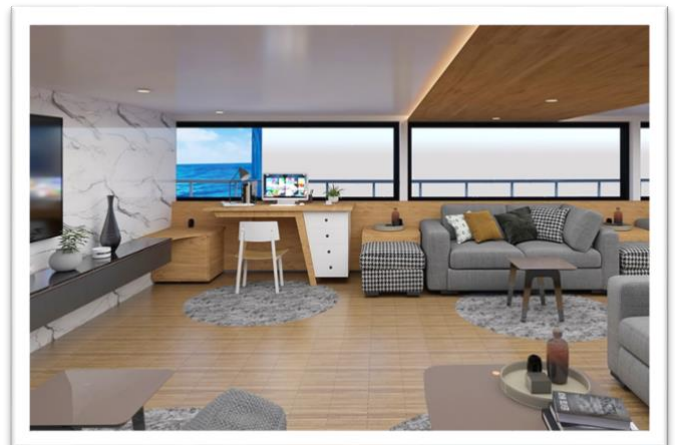
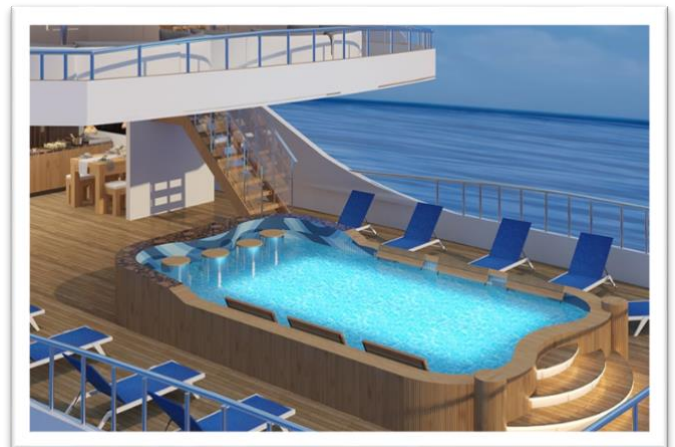
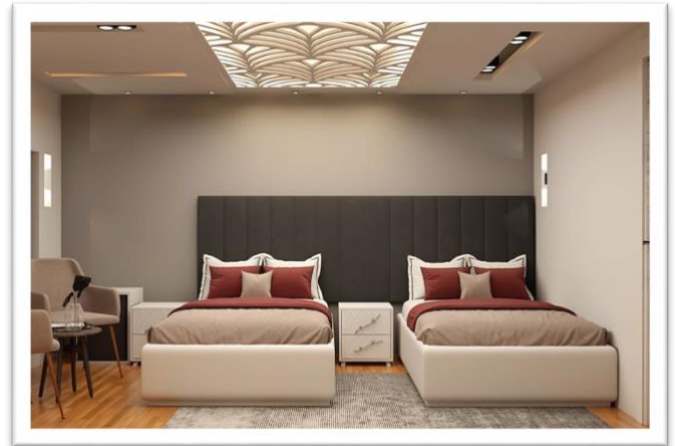
If you are a solo diver, we will do our best to pair you up with a diver of the same sex but cannot guarantee it.

# THE DIVING

## Daedalus and Fury Shoals

This pair of sites offer some of the best diving in the Red Sea. A mix of remote sites with pristine hard & soft corals, one of the biggest draws to this area are the migratory pelagics. Expect moderate-high currents to carry you past these amazing sites. Fury Shoals offers some shallower, more protected sites with labyrinths of healthy corals. Spinner dolphins frequent the area!

### Experience Required

Because many of the sites are deep dives with current, beginner-level divers may not be able to enjoy all sites.

**All divers must have 50 logged dives and Advanced Certification (or equivalent).**

### Big Life

Big schools of tunas, trevallies, barracuda, and jacks are seen regularly. Manta Rays & hammerheads are spotted here frequently from May-October, and sometimes even thresher sharks and whale sharks!

### Courses

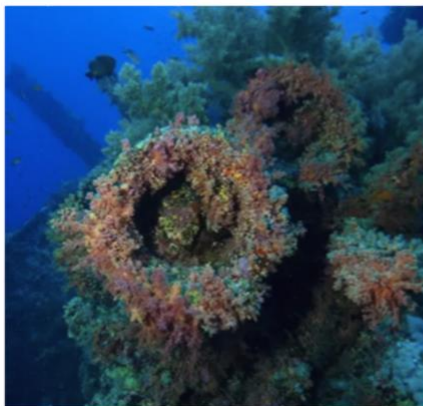
Want to build your skills? Ask Grace about the courses offered on this trip: AWARE Shark Conservation, Fish ID, Drift, and Deep.

### Wrecks

Wrecks like the Aida II and the Numidia sit steeply on a deep wall and feature many photo-worthy opportunities.

Many of the hard coral formations are massive creating dramatic scenes perfect for taking underwater photos or videos. Since the reef is situated in a marine park, it showcases some of the Red Sea's healthiest hard & soft corals.

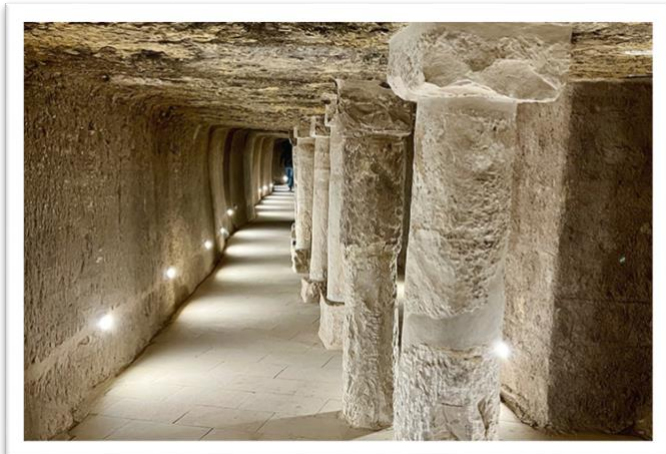


### Experience Egypt
