Aspen, Colorado and Bariloche, Argentina:

Annual Artist Exchange/Competition: This exchange promotes cultural diversity and artistic expression, allowing artists from both cities to showcase their talents and inspire each other.

Tempe, Arizona and Regensburg, Germany:

Student Summer Exchange Programs: These programs offer students the chance to experience different cultures,

broaden their horizons, and develop global perspectives.

Omaha, Nebraska and Xalapa, Mexico:

Humanitarian Cooperation: A strong community relationship led to Omaha donating fire trucks to serve the rural areas of Xalapa, improving their emergency services and safety.
