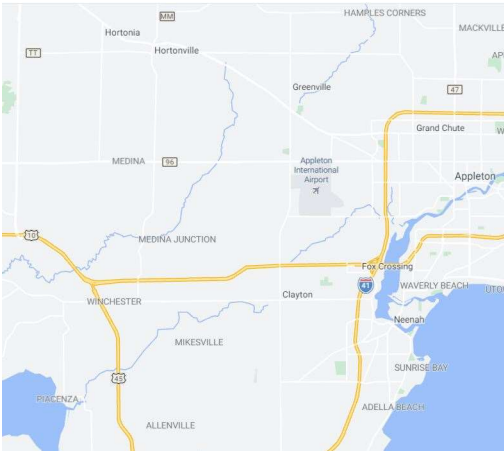

Directions to Fox River Beagle Club, Hortonville, Wisconsin

From I-39 /I-90, Take the exit for US-151 N toward Sun Prairie. Then take exit 148 for WI-26 N toward Rosendale/Oshkosh. Turn onto the US-41N ramp and then take exit 120 for US-45N toward US-10W/New London. Merge onto US-10W/US-45N. Take exit 273 for US-45N toward New London. Turn onto WI-96 E/Wisconsin Ave. Turn left onto County Rd T. Turn L onto Baler Rd and the FRBC is 0.6 miles down the road on the right.

CHICAGO BYPASS: From the East, take I-80 along the south side of Chicago until you are well past Chicago, then head north on I-355. YOU MUST EXIT I-355 at I-88 West or you will end up back on I-90. Take I-88 West to I-39, just a bit south of Rockford. When you get to Rockford you can follow the directions above.

RULES AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ABSOLUTE. There will be Absolute runs for these trials as listed on the page with the judging panel.

ALCOHOL. Badger Dachshund Club prohibits the consumption of alcohol on the trial grounds during the running of their respective trials. Trials are not considered to be over until the completion of the daily awards ceremony.

APPRENTICE JUDGES. Anyone interested in apprentice judging during this event should contact the Event Chair or Secretary for the day to discuss availability and options.

CAMPING. Overnight camping is available at the grounds in a limited capacity. There is no water or sewer connection available, but there is a hose that can be used to fill tanks with potable water. There is no sewer dump station on site. Judges have first priority for reservations. All campers are liable for any damages they may cause to the grounds to include holes dug in the grass by dogs or vehicles. For damages not repaired, the responsible party will pay a fee to the Fox River Beagle Club commensurate with the repairs required to leave the site as good as or better than it was prior to arrival and fees will start at \$50.00. Failure to pay for damages may result in revocation of camping privileges. Campers may arrive after 2pm on Thursday.

Please note that clubhouse “camping” is not available for these trials.

Showers are available in the clubhouse and will be available from 30 minutes after the conclusion of awards until 6:30 a.m. each day. Bring your own towel and shower supplies. Please take them with you when you are done showering.

CLUBHOUSE. No dogs allowed in the clubhouse except for awards.

ENTRIES. Pre-entry will not be accepted for these trials. Entry forms must be complete, legible and submitted on a regulation 5 ½” x 8 ½” form. A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog for each trial entered.

FIELD MARSHALS. If you are willing to marshal, please let the FT Chair or Secretary know what stake(s) will work for you. Marshals will be confirmed day-of-trial.

FOOD. Members of the Fox River Beagle Club will be preparing breakfast and lunch at these trials. . If you have special needs/diet requirements, please plan accordingly. Payment for all meals will be made to FRBC. Please bring cash to pay for your meals to decrease the administrative burden on the Beagle Club.

HARNESSES. AKC rules are silent regarding the use of body harnesses. As a result, body harnesses will only be allowed if the handler receives advance permission of both judges for the class. Harness must be well fitting with nothing hanging from it and with no attachments other than tags for identification purposes. The harness must remain on the dog the entire time the dog is under judgment.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES. Golf carts and utility vehicles may be utilized during the trial with limited drive areas.

NOISE. Please be respectful to other exhibitors. Dogs may not be left unsupervised in x-pens. If a large generator is used, you will be required to move it far enough away from the campsites that the noise will not disturb other campers. Quiet hours are from 10pm-5am.

NO SMOKING. Smoking and vaping are prohibited in the clubhouse and the running grounds at all times.

PRACTICE. Practice will be allowed on the day before these trials and if time and weather permit, practice may be allowed after the conclusion of each day’s events. Practice is limited to one dog at a time per person. Do not arrive before 2pm for practice on Thursday.

RETURNED CHECK FEE. Any check issued to Badger Dachshund Club that is returned for insufficient funds will be subject to a \$35.00 penalty payment in addition to the actual amount of the check. Failure to redeem returned checks will result in being placed on a “cash only” basis, and may be reported to AKC as an unpaid entry.

TRACKING COLLARS. GPS or other tracking collars are not permitted during these trials. Additional information may be posted in the clubhouse.
