

Sunrise Resurfacing Care & Maintenance

WHAT TO EXPECT OF YOUR RESURFACED AREA

Countertop resurfacing is a sprayed-on liquid product that cures to a solid conforming to your existing surface. Because each countertop is individually hand crafted, variations in color and texture are an inherent part of the resurfacing process. If you have chosen one of our samples please keep in mind that it is only a sample. Our warranty does not cover pre-existing or future structural damage.

Now that your new surface has cured, you'll want to keep it clean. Please follow our guidelines for cleaning and maintaining your new surfaces to ensure the best results.

DO NOT TOUCH

Although product may appear dry, it takes a full 24 hours to cure. Keep liquids away from the new resurfaced area.

Until Fully Cured

During this period, care must be taken to insure that dust and dirt do not fall onto the *new* resurfaced area. This will cause sharp points to form.

Use a soft sponge or cloth with the following recommended cleaners:

(Do follow manufacturer instructions)

A soft nylon brush may be used once a month to clean:

DO NOT use abrasive sponge pads, steel wool, wire brushes, or metal scrapers.

DO NOT use high alkaline or strong acid cleaners.

DO NOT use abrasive cleaners such as Clorox® or Comet®. Prolonged exposure to bleach will cause discoloration.

DO NOT use products that contain the following chemical ingredients: hydrochloric acid, sulfuric acid, hydrofluoric acid, phosphoric acid, sodium hydroxide, pumice (abrasive).

Stains • Rust • Sharp Objects

Destruction of the finish may occur through improper use of acid-bearing compounds like drain openers and tile grout cleaners. All chemicals must be kept away from the finish. Products containing bleach, oils, hair dyes, etc., may stain or mar the finish. Never hang garments that could bleed stains on the bathtub. Do not wash animals in the resurfaced tub or sink. Avoid storing objects directly on the surface, especially metal cans, which may form rust stains.

Leaky Faucets

Protect the finish against the eroding action of dripping water, which may cause the finish to crack or mar prematurely.

NO Rubber Bath Mats!

Bathmats containing suction cups will produce a reaction with the finish when subjected to hot water. Sunrise Resurfacing is not responsible for any slip and fall injury.

We DO NOT guarantee structural problems determined by technicians, i.e., cracking seams, soft bottoms, rust and/or general wear and tear.
