## Noank is No-Lead!



## NOANK WATER COMPANY NEEDS YOUR HELP

Noank Water Co. is conducting a mandated U.S. EPA water system inventory verifying and confirming that our system is totally lead-free. Noank's water supply was built in the early '60s and our engineering plans prove there was no lead used in its construction. Service lines from the curb to your building were installed by contractors and are owned by the homeowner. They're most likely copper, galvanized steel, or plastic but we need to confirm your service line is lead-free. Here's where you come in (you'll need a flashlight and a smart phone):

- 1. Your water service line, with a valve, comes into your home through your basement wall, up through the slab or out of the ground under your house (see photos above). Find that water supply line.
- 2. Dust it off and take a picture (up to three) of the pipe between the wall and the shut off valve, close enough for us to identify the material that was used in the incoming pipe. (If you know what the material is, you can tell us in the following email.)
- 3. Attach your photos to an email. IMPORTANT Write the street address of where the photos were taken in the title line of the email and send to: noleadnoank@gmail.com Check with your neighbors and offer to help them take a photo.
