Colonel (Ret'd) James Charles Forsyth, CStJ, CD, CA, on 11 January 2024, at the age of 85.

James was a tireless campaigner for the RHLI, both in Canada and overseas on numerous regimental trips to France, Holland and Belgium for World War II memorial functions. He was also a member of the Dieppe Veterans' Memorial Park committee, leading to the construction and dedication of a long-overdue monument that pays tribute to veterans of The Royal Hamilton Light Infantry and other Hamilton area veterans who participated in the raid on Dieppe, France in August 1942.

He also kept active with volunteer and community service work with St. John Ambulance (Burlington Branch), the Canadian Corps of Commissionaires (Hamilton Division), the Army Cadet League of Canada (Ontario), <u>the Hospitaller Order of St. John (Hamilton Commandery)</u> <u>serving as Treasurer</u>, the XIIIth Regiment Foundation and Reserves 2000.
