I am a dancer from Cheshire Dance and will be visiting Canal Street and Lightfoot Lodge over the next year. I am visiting your centre because I am interested in finding out how we might dance together. I will invite you to dance with me for a short time each week for 10 weeks.

My name is **Ruth**.



I am a dancer who sometimes works in a university. I will be helping Jane gather information from this project to help us learn how you like to dance and share that with others. I will sometimes visit your dance sessions with Jane. I will watch and write down what I see.

What is the WannaDance project about?

This project is to find out how you might like to dance.

Why have I been chosen?

You use Vivo Care Choices services. You are very important and can help us learn how you might like to dance.

What will happen if I take part?

- 1. Jane will visit your centre on Mondays over the next year.
- 2. Jane will take the time to get to know you and how you communicate.
- 3. Jane will invite you to dance with her each week for up to 10 weeks. You will explore dancing together.
- 4. Jane will keep a written record of what you do in your dancing together moments.
- 5. We will video you dancing with Jane.

Can I stop if I don't want to do the WannaDance Project anymore?

Yes, you can stop at any point if you don't want to take part anymore.

We will respond to verbal and non-verbal signals to stop or change the dancing.

Will the things you write be kept secret?

No. We will share what we learn with others, but your name will be kept secret.

Will the things you video be kept secret?

No. We will share the videos of our dancing. We will only share them with you, Vivo Care Choices' staff and if requested, your family or carers. People may be able to recognise you in the video.



Understanding and responding to you is central to the project. We will get to know, notice and respond to what you show and tell us.
