Delightful Day Christmas Card Holder



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Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Delightful Day (149466)
- Card Stock Whisper White (100730); Scrap piece any color
- **Stamp Pads** Shaded Spruce (147088): Real Red (147084)
- Misc. Paper Trimmer; Scoring tool; pencil; red Fine Sharpie; Tear and Tape Adhesive (138995)

Measurements:

- Card Stock 1 4 inches x 9 inches
- Card Stock 2 Scrap of card stock any color at least 3 inches square.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut Whisper White Card Stock to 4 inches x 9 inches. You can get two cards out of an 8 ½ x 11 sheet.
- 2. Score along the long side of the card at 4 inches, and again at 8 inches...
- **3.** Stamp your images BEFORE you fold your card up. It decreases the chance of smears from your block, because your paper is flat.
- **4.** To make the wreath on the front. I punched (or you could die cut) a circle 2 ½ inches from a piece of scrap card stock. I used this circle as a pattern. I centered this circle on the front of the 4 x 4 inch front panel of the card, and traced light pencil around it. This gives you the shape of the wreath to stamp around.
- 5. Using Shaded Spruce ink, I started at the top of the wreath and stamped the flower stem. Then I moved over about ¼ inch and lined up the three dots on the left side of the Stamp image on the line I had traced and stamped again. I continued this around the circle
- **6.** IMPORTANT TIP: Keep cleaning your block and stamp. It is so disheartening to be almost done and your block to smear across the card.
- 7. Stamp your words in the center of the wreath with read red.
- **8.** I used a red Sharpie to add berries in the wreath.

9. Inside the card I folded up the 1 inch strip and using the tear and tape adhesive I made my gift card pocket. Stamp To: From: on the pocket if you haven't already done so. I also added some dots to add color on the inside.
