Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Country Home (147678)
- Card Stock Whisper White (100730)
- Stamp Pads Shaded Spruce (147088)
- **Misc**. Garden Lane Designer Series Paper (149488); Pretty Peacock Scalloped Linen Ribbon (149751); Braided Linen Ribbon (147808); Snail Adhesive (104332); Leaves Trinkets (146343); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Card Stock 1: 8 ¹/₂" x 11"
- DSP: 5 ¹/₂ x 4 ¹/₄ Base pie

5 ¹/₂' x 4 ¹/₄' Base piece 5 ¹/₂" x 2" Coordinating Strip

Instructions:

- 1. Score and Fold your white card stock along the 11 inch side at the 5 ½" mark. This will make a tent card with the fold at the top of the card.
- **2.** Adhere your 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ to the front of your card using the snail adhesive.
- **3.** Adhere the 2" strip along the left side of the front of the card. I set mine in about 1/4" to give an interesting effect.
- **4.** Stamp your image.
- **5.** Cut the two pieces of ribbon 24" each. This seems excessive, but you will be glad you did when you start working with it.
- 6. Hold both pieces of ribbon together, one on top of the other, and wrap them around the front panel of the card. Tie it in a knot as if you were tying a shoe string in a knot. Take the small linen thread and tie it in a bow right on top of the knot. Trim ends.
- 7. Using the glue Dots, place a Leaf Trinket under the bow.
