

BANGLADESH SETS \$50-BN RMG EXPORT TARGET IN 2020-21

Bangladesh has set a target of \$50 billion for its readymade garment (RMG) exports in 2020-21 in line with its commitment to enhance earnings from the sector in the election

manifesto of the ruling Awami League. Secretary of textiles and jute ministry Lokman Hossain Mia said this recently ahead of the 'National Textile Day 2020 and Multipurpose

Textile Fair'. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is expected to inaugurate the three-day event on January 9 at in Dhaka.

The government has prepared an

elaborate action plan to make the sector stronger and competent in the business market. Forty two vocational institutes, seven textile institutes and seven textile engineering

colleges have been established to develop highly skilled textile technicians for the sector, Mia said.

A total of nine organisations and business enterprises

will be awarded in different categories to enhance the RMG export and speed up the development, Bangla media reports quoted him as saying.

Cotton prices to fall as supply outstrips demand

Cotton prices will remain weak in the 2019/20 and 2020/21 seasons as supplies of cotton outstrip demand and surpluses grow, according to a report in Issue 200 of Textile Outlook International from the global business information company Textiles Intelligence.

In fact, the average price of cotton has been falling since the beginning of 2018/19, and in 2019/20 it is forecast to fall further to only 76

US cents/lb—which would be 11 US cents/lb lower than the average for 2018/19.

One factor affecting the price of cotton is weak demand caused by uncertainty arising from the US China trade war. Until relations between the two countries improve, demand for cotton will remain suppressed and so will the cotton price—unless there are major revisions to crop estimates or there are signs of greater strength

in the global economy. The continued weakness in cotton prices has been reinforced by an increase in the size of the global stockpile which has reversed recent declines. Indeed, surpluses are growing in the main producing nations, and stock levels at the end of the 2019/20 season (July 31, 2020) are expected to be 1.3% higher than they were at the beginning (August 1, 2019). Admittedly, global consumption of cotton

will continue into

is expected to rise in the 2019/20 season as Chinese demand stabilises. But there is also expected to be a rise in global cotton production during 2019/20 as yields in India rebound and plantings increase in the USA. As a result, global cotton production will exceed demand, stocks will rise and this will put downward pressure on the cotton price. This pressure on prices will continue into

2020/21 as demand is forecast to remain weak while yields are expected to improve as a consequence of better weather conditions. In fact, the global cotton crop in 2020/21 is forecast to reach its second highest level ever.

India to hit \$7 bn in MMF textiles exports in 2020: SRTEPC

Exports of Indian man-made fibre (MMF) textiles is expected to reach \$7 billion by the end of fiscal 2020-21, witnessing a growth of at least 10 per cent from the current level, according to Ronak Rughani, chairman of the Synthetic and Rayon Textiles Export Promotion Council (SRTEPC), which is

optimistic about a further momentum in the sector this fiscal.

Though the present trend of total MMF textiles exports from India is not encouraging, exports in value-added segments like fabrics witnessed nearly 8 per cent growth during April-October period in

2019-20 as compared to the same period in the previous fiscal, the council said in a press release.

SRTEPC has prepared a 20-point strategy for the development of MMF fibre textile segment. The points include bringing in fibre neutrality, lowering

interest rates, making raw materials to be made available at international price, considering textile job work as manufacturing in the goods and services tax regime, considering textile merchant exporters as manufacturer exporter, branding and WTO-compatible schemes.

INDIAN GOVT NOTIFIES CHANGES TO RULES ON INPUT TAX CREDIT

India recently notified changes to the goods and services tax (GST) rules, lowering the input tax credit to 10 per cent from 20 per cent of eligible credit, if invoices or debit notes are not reflected in filings. It also permitted officers at the level of commissioners to bar debit of input tax credit for a year in case of credit being availed fraudulently.

At its meeting on December 18, the GST Council had approved a proposal in this regard to check tax

evasion and fake invoicing. The new rules will come into effect from January 1.

The government also notified that e-way bill of taxpayers who have not filed their Form GSTR-1 for two months or two quarters shall be blocked. It also allowed waiver of late fee for entities furnishing outward supply details in Form GSTR-1 between December 19, 2019 and January 10, 2020, for the period between July 2017 and November 2019.
