

Message from Father Alexander

Let Us Cleanse Ourselves!



This line or ones like it are often repeated throughout the upcoming time of Lent in the services of the Church. Our reaction to it should be for us a bit of a test. Am I offended by it? Do I feel ashamed? Do I ignore it (the easiest but worst option!)? Or does it excite me? Is the possibility of renewal, of cleansing of my mind, heart, soul, and even body something that I desire?

I hope it is! When I was a child I absolutely dreaded cleaning my room, yes I had made the mess and it was crazy but it was just fine! And that was a lot of work. But then I grew up and realized, yes it is a bit of work but the pay off is great, a clean room or house is a peaceful one. We must "grow up" in

a way as Paul says and put "away childish things" and realize this Lenten period is a period of work, but one that grants a large pay off. I can be clean, renewed, and at peace and have the Resurrected Christ shining from my heart, no small thing!

But again there is the work portion that we perhaps balk at, I need to change things and perhaps make hard decisions on what to move on from and choose the clean over the mess, the godly over the worldly and this can be hard! But it grants immense freedom and peace and power from on high.

So I challenge each of you to examine this line, the prayer of the Publican even **"Have mercy on me O Lord."** Do I think I need it? Do I loathe to say it? Or do I find peace in it? This time of Lent can be a time of peace, perhaps not in our life and world around us but certainly in our heart. This can only come by responding to this entreaty of the Church to cleanse ourselves with the determined work of an adult with a day off and a messy house. "I can do it and it will be worth it." And we will find ourselves on Pascha with an even greater satisfaction and peace than we can imagine. So let us cleanse ourselves with all the cleaning tools the Church offers: prayer, fasting, almsgiving, the services, confession, reading of Scripture, and let us see how shiny the Lord makes us.


In addition, we are grateful to every single Steward for your generous giving in 2024. We had a wonderful year and we look forward to continuing our upward trend of growth.







The maintenance committee has been very busy the last few months!

We are happy to announce that after two years of research, the short causing the loss of power to the chapel has been found. We worked diligently with our electricians to repair the issue. New electrical lines and panels are in process and the chapel should be back up and running with safe power very soon.

We are in the process of repairing the parking curbs around the parking lot. Much damage has been caused by vehicles hitting our curbs. We are working on a redesign of the curbing to inhibit more damage to them.

The Community Center bathroom septic lines have been jetted as they were backing up due to people flushing hand paper towels down the toilets. We are currently researching options to install electric hand dryers to elevate the backup issues. *Please do not flush hand paper towels down our toilets*.

Two new air conditioners were installed in the Community Center so we should see much improvement in our cooling/heating and electrical bill.

Seven new smart/wifi thermostats have been installed in the Community Center, Chapel, and Cathedral to assist with temperature management and electrical savings.

A new Maytag washing machine was donated and installed in the Community Center to assist with washing needs.

A new Halon extinguishing system was installed in the Community Center kitchen for safety and fire extinguishment. Our prior system was outdated and not operable.

We have many projects in the works!






