

IRS owners 70 ½ and older can gift up to \$100,000.00 of their Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) to Holy Trinity Cathedral, and their spouse can do the same. Simply ask the custodian of your IRA to issue a check <u>directly</u> from your IRA to Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral. You can send any amount, up to \$100,000.00. By doing so, you will reduce the amount of your taxable income, thereby reducing the taxes you have to pay. You must do so before December 31, 2021. Consult your tax advisor on this, and thank you for helping Holy Trinity, while helping yourself.



St. Nectarios Books & Beyond

Great and Holy Pascha (Easter)



On the Great and Holy Feast of Pascha, Orthodox Christians celebrate the life-giving Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. This feast of feasts is the most significant day in the life of the Church. It is a celebration of the




defeat of death, as neither death itself nor the power of the grave could hold our Savior captive. In this victory that came through the Cross, Christ broke the bondage of sin, and through faith offers us restoration, transformation, and eternal life.

One of the most symbolic of the Festal Icons of the Orthodox Church is that of the Holy Resurrection. In the center of this radiant event is Christ pulling Adam and Eve up from their tombs. The gates of the Realm of Death are broken and thrown down. Death, personified in human form is defeated, and bound hand and foot at the bottom of the scene. We recall the joyous words of St. Paul: "O death, where is

thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?" (1 Corinthians 15:55)

In the background stands the host of the departed, so numerous they cannot not be depicted. Among them in the front of the multitude are some of the righteous dead, though now invigorated by the Resurrection. King David and his son Solomon are seen on the left wearing crowns. Near the center is Saint John the Baptist. On the other side is Abel, the son of Adam and the first man to ever die. He wears a shepherds robe and has a cane. Many Icons of this subject depict large crowds with a few other recognizable prophets.


