### Message from Father Alexander

#### **Opening our Eyes and Hearts**



What a beautiful Pascha! We were so blessed to have His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos of San Francisco with us and it was so great to see our Cathedral so full. We most likely have returned to our usual routine of life, but God willing there is something within us that has changed even just a little bit with this encounter with the Resurrected Lord. As His Eminence said so beautifully at the Agape Vespers, we too must proclaim that "we have seen the Lord!" But how? Where do we go from here?



Well we continue in the life of the Church which shows us a path in the Gospel readings between Pascha and Pentecost, let's take a look at them:

**Thomas Sunday:** We too must not simply rely on other's accounts of God but search Him out ourselves, "probing" the hand of our heart out to the Lord, touch, seeing, knowing He is Risen!

Sunday of the Myrrhbearers: Our faith necessitates bravery and love. These women ran to the tomb at the first moment they could to anoint the Lord, something which could have had them arrested by the soldiers they knew were there. Yet they ran anyway out of their great love for Jesus, we must run to Him too against all odds!

**Sunday of the Paralytic:** We too are often paralyzed in our faith and have no recourse. It is not I who can empower myself to do what is needed to be healed, but only God who can come and heal me when I cry out to Him and ask for His healing and admit that I indeed what to be healed.

Sunday of the Samaritan Woman: I am never too far gone. I have never sinned too much. I can never hide my sins from God. He knows them and desires even me to be forgiven and when I seek it He will forgive me. But then I must run and tell the world of His great mercy!

Sunday of the Blindman: God can do unheard of things. No one has heard of a man born blind receiving his sight, but God can do it. Whatever instance I find myself in, God can heal me and bring me out of it.

We read the Gospel of John after Pascha for a reason, John reveals to us the depth of the wonder and power of Jesus that is fully accomplished in His Rising. We should take heed to these lessons in our life to let His power shine forth from us for our salvation and that of the world around us! **Christ is Risen!**






