

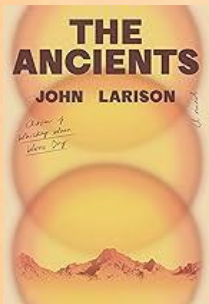

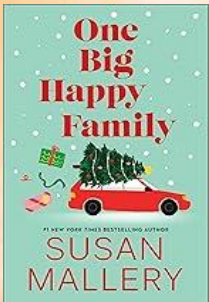
October - Adventure Begins At Your Library – October
