For New England Foot Drop Center to attach the MyQuest Soft AFO Brace to your shoe/shoes:

- 1. Review shoe selection guide before sending shoe/shoes to ensure appropriate shoe style is selected. If unsure, contact us before shipping shoe.
- 2. Fill out form and send along with shoe/shoes to New England Foot Drop Center, 10 Faith Road, Windham, NH 03087. Send only the shoe/shoes requiring modification. If hardware has already been purchased, send along with shoe/shoes.

Customer is responsible for costs to ship shoe/shoes to New England Foot Drop Center (NEFDC). Return shipping is included with your order. We recommend that you insure your order for the full replacement value of items shipped and include tracking as you are responsible for the package until we receive it. Please use adequate packaging.

Installation Information

- New England Foot Drop Center (NEFDC) will attach the hardware your shoes. We will NOT be responsible for ANY damage to the shoe as a result of attachment, removal or use of the MyQuest soft AFO brace. If the shoe supplied by the customer does not fall within the recommended specifications and is not appropriate for use with the MyQuest soft AFO brace, we will return the shoe, unfilled with a written explanation. Return shipping will not be refunded.
- Select shoes that are supportive with structure (not flimsy, such as ballet shoes or flip flops) and made of sturdy materials, such as leather or reinforced canvas. Select a shoe with no heel or a sturdy heel. A shoe with a back or strap is required. If used with waterproof footwear, the shoe will no longer be waterproof. If you are unsure about the appropriate shoes for the MyQuest brace, see the shoe selection guide or email us a photo.
- New England Foot Drop Center cannot control the design, materials, workmanship or condition of the footwear worn by the purchaser. Therefore, we are not responsible for any damage, injuries or product failure resulting from failure of the shoe material where the MyQuest brace has been attached.
- Even in cases when a customer's shoe appears to be appropriate for the MyQuest soft AFO brace, we cannot know for certain that the interface is safe initially, or that it will remain safe over time. We, therefore, will NOT be responsible for any damage or for any injuries resulting from failure of the shoe material where the MyQuest soft AFO brace has been attached to the shoe.
