Legislative Affairs Officer Report

2026 Session of the Maryland General Assembly

We've looked at the proposed bills introduced in the 2026 session of the Maryland General Assembly. As of January 18, 2026, there are 332 bills introduced in the House of Delegates and 273 introduced in the Senate. These are the bills that may be of some interest for YCM members:

- HB0097 (SB0135) – This proposal would designate the Megalodon as the State Shark. I doubt that any boaters will encounter any of these critters.
- SB0021 would make the holder of a Maryland Golden Age Pass entitled to free day–use entry at certain State parks and let the holder of the pass to launch a boat at any State park without paying a boat launch fee; alter the days of the week on which the holder of a Maryland Golden Age Pass may camp overnight in a State park at a discounted fee; establishing that the free day–use entry applies to everyone in the vehicle with the holder of a Maryland Golden Age Pass under certain circumstances.
- SB0066 would increase the maximum periods of imprisonment for an individual convicted of manslaughter by vehicle or vessel.
- SB0145 (HB0174) requires an individual who is the sole owner of a marine vessel or multiple individuals who jointly co-own a marine vessel to apply to the Department of Natural Resources to designate a beneficiary to take ownership of the marine vessel on the death of the owner or each co-owner.
- SB0214 (HB0244) requires an individual who is the sole owner of a certain vessel to apply to the Department of Natural Resources to designate a beneficiary to take ownership of the vessel on the death of the owner; requiring a designated beneficiary who survives the owner of a vessel to apply to the Department for a new certificate of title for the vessel; and requiring an application for a certificate of title for a vessel to contain certain information. This one seems to duplicate SB0145.

I don't see anything controversial in these bills, unless you think the state shark should be something other than the Megalodon. We'll keep tracking the legislation.

Conowingo Dam Settlement

Of concern for years to those who cherish the Chesapeake Bay is the debris contained by the Conowingo Dam. Constellation Energy has agreed to spend \$344 million in operational improvements and environmental projects at the dam. This includes tens of millions of dollars for shoreline stabilization, pollution reduction efforts, expanded trash and debris removal, fish and eel passage improvements, studies in dredge feasibility, creation of a fresh water mussel hatchery to improve water filtration, and invasive species management.

Days Cove Landfill Update

Recently, the Maryland Board of Public Works approved a short-term extension of the landfill's lease on state park property until May 29. The lease extension allows the landfill to continue to operate while the Maryland Department of the Environment finishes reviewing a pending discharge permit application for the landfill.
