LAO REPORT

Here are some recent news items from Maryland's DNR:

Chesapeake Bay Grass Health

Underwater grass abundance in Maryland's portion of the Chesapeake Bay - a key indicator of water quality - fell from 38,188 acres in 2023 to 36,794 acres in 2024, according to data reviewed by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources. This acreage remains short of the state's 2025 restoration goal of 79,800 acres.

New APP of Interest

The Maryland Department of Natural Resources is introducing a new free mobile app – MD Outdoors – which will be the official app for the state's outdoor enthusiasts, hunters, and anglers. The MD Outdoors app **replaces the AccessDNR app, which will no longer be supported**. Users will need to remove the old app and download an updated version from the DNR website.


