

Legislative Affairs Officer Report

2026 Session of the Maryland General Assembly

As of February 16, 964 bills had been introduced in the Maryland Senate and 1,595 in the House. There are some duplicates, meaning the same bill was introduced in both the House and the Senate. There are no significant bills related to the boating community. We'll monitor the current legislative session and notify you if anything arises that requires our attention. There is one bill that may be of interest to our more senior boaters. That is SB0382, which gives credit towards state income tax for those who reach the age of 77. At that age you get a 25% credit, at the age of 78, you get a 50% credit, at age 79, the credit is 75% and at age 80, it's 100%. The credit applies to incomes under \$175,000 if filing individually and \$250,000 for joint filers.
