Nighttime boating

Nighttime boating can be more challenging than boating during the day, but boaters can take precautions to safely operate their boats in the dark.

Keep your windshield clean. If you can see your windshield as opposed to seeing through it, it needs cleaning. Salt spray is a notorious windshield fouler. If necessary, stop the boat and clean the windshield.

Wear a life jacket with an attached strobe light and whistle. A person in the water is a lot harder to see than a navigation light.

Wear sunglasses until the sun gets lower in the sky during late afternoon. Normally, your eyes take a half hour to achieve maximum night vision, but a few hours of bright sunlight can delay this for hours.

At night, look slightly to the side of an object to see it. Using averted vision in darkness helps your eyes see the object better than looking directly at it.

Cover one eye when you approach a dock or lighted area. According to the AAA magazine

"Car and Travel," truckers sometimes do this when gassing up at night to preserve their night vision in one eye.

Use red instrument lights. Your eyes are less sensitive to red than any other component of visible light. Some cabins have the choice of a white or red overhead light; the red light will give enough visibility to locate what you want but not take away my night vision.

Lastly, just take it slow at night.

Regular inspection of outboard and sterndrive propellers is a task many boat owners fail to conduct. If you are pulling your boat for the winter here's how to check and maintain this essential part of your boat's performance.

Your propeller is subject to damage from a number of sources, including impact damage from rocks or floating debris, cracks, and corrosion issues. Any of these can lead to <u>vibration</u>, poor performance, increased fuel consumption, or (in extreme cases) blade failure if not corrected promptly. Regular inspections and maintenance are the key to good prop performance and longevity. Catching and correcting minor damage early can help prevent more serious problems and costly repairs, both to the prop and other engine components. Here's what to look for.

Inspect your propeller for problems such as nicks, dings, cracks, and corrosion, as well as rolled tips or bent blades. Lightly run your finger around the blades and hub (be careful of sharp blades!) while feeling for any abnormalities that may not be easily visible.

Sight the blades while comparing their angles and curves to see if there are differences. Place a ruler or marked straight edge against a fixed point on the lower unit or on the ground (near the edge of a propeller blade), then slowly rotate the propeller to see if there are any visual differences between the blades.

Blades that are distorted or even slightly out of true due to "soft damage" (a result of running through silt or sand, for example) can decrease performance and cause vibration. Worse still, as blade damage in such cases is rarely uniform, imbalance vibrations can cause additional damage to motors and lower units. Props with worn or flattened blades can also allow an engine to accelerate beyond recommended rpm, possibly causing engine damage.

If you have the equipment, assess the prop's balance, by "spinning" it on a spare piece of shaft that fits the hub and can be anchored in a vice grip or by other means. This may uncover imbalances that would be missed otherwise. If there is indication of something out of true, prop shops have equipment that can do this much better.


