LAO REPORT

As of the date of this report, Maryland's Governor hasn't signed HB0719, which increases boat registration fees. He also hasn't signed SB0168, which places a 4-year moratorium on confined aquatic disposal of dredge material. That signing could come at any time. We'll keep you posted.

With the Maryland 2025 legislative session behind us, attention now focuses on federal budgets. Most news reports indicate very severe cuts to environmental funding and this does put funding for the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries at risk. As most of you who follow the news know, a lot of currently approved grant funding has been withdrawn or curtailed. Considering major cuts to veterans services and cancer research, including childhood cancers, it isn't surprising that funding to support the Chesapeake will be cut. Details will not be known for weeks or months. Would anyone be surprised if Congress takes all the way to September 30 to approve a budget that starts on October 1?

While we will keep you up-to-date on what happens to Chesapeake funds, it's unlikely we will have much impact on the outcome.

Protocol Matters

Protocol MattersBy P/C Joe Hellner

The Opening Ceremony

Ahoy There! It has been several years since we published the recommended traditional Opening Ceremony Protocols. We hope the below pointers will be helpful as you plan your 2025 opening or attend an opening as a visiting official.

Basic Order of the Opening Ceremony: Introduction of the M/C, Post Honor Guard, Introduction of Senior Host Officer (usually the Commodore), Introduction of Visitors, Introduction of VIP Visitors such as the Queen of the Chesapeake, Introduction of Host Club Officials, the princess court, and, finally, the club princess, Dismiss Honor Guard, Introduction of "Fun" visitors (e.g. King of the Chesapeake), Invocation, National Anthem, (these may also be placed at the beginning or near the end of the ceremony), Speakers (usually Queen, Princess, Commodore (the host club Commodore always speaks last), Memorial to the Departed (this may also be done after the invocation/anthem, Presentations (e.g. Skunk Flag. Princess Gifts) & Awards (e.g. Most Officers in Line), Fleet Captains Report, Commodores Declaration the "Club is Open for the Season" followed by a cannon shot, which ends the ceremony. The host club may add additional agenda items as it sees fit.

Proper Rank Order (Official Visitors): 1. Flag Officers, Elected Officers, & Appointed Officers ranked in highest to lowest order per their club bylaws & protocols. 2. Board Members (if in uniform) 3. Past Commodores (Oldest in time of office to the most recent – usually the IP/C)

Right Rank and Line Up (Official Visitors): 1. Senior Officer **only** salutes the Honor Guard 2. All break ranks to salute the Flag. 3. Always line up facing the podium with the senior officer at the extreme right and follow decreasing rank order to the left. 3. Senior Officer speaks for their club, introduces officers, princess, and leads group salute.

Proper Rank Order (Host Club): Reverse Order with the V/C introduced last as follows: 1. Past Commodores (oldest in time to most recent) 2. Board Members 3. Officers from lowest ranked to highest ending with the Flag Officers (Flag Raised on crosstree when they come aboard)

Keep the Ceremony Moving: 1. Start line not too far from the podium 2. **Only the senior officer shakes hands or gives hugs to the hosts** – All others walk off following their senior officer. 3. Line up ONLY with clubs to which you belong (rare exceptions can be made for a worthy purpose with host club agreement) 4. Keep remarks brief and to the point. 5. Place princess gifts at their chairs ahead of time

Guest Officer Behavior: Sit/stand in the VIP seating area and support the ceremony, be quiet and respectful of the ceremony in progress, take long discussions away from the ceremony area, all rise for Queen, Host Club Princess, Anthem, Invocation, Memorial for Departed.

What to wear (Official Visitors): A proper and complete matching uniform of the club or organization being represented. Persons who represent more than one organization must match the attire and insignia of one organization and can be introduced while not matching the other organizations. Clubs who do





not use the traditional uniform should wear a smart shipshape alternative appropriate for a ceremony with all participants matching. Proper wearing of yacht club attire shows respect for the host club.

Invocation: Stand uncovered with uniform hat crooked in left arm.

Memorial for the Departed: 1. All Hands rise, Commodore and Mate, often escorted by requested persons (e.g. Queen, Princess) go to the water and cast a symbolic item (Usually a Wreath) 2. Taps or Amazing Grace is played 3. All Hands face the wreath, which symbolizes the departed 4. All Hands in uniform with cover on salute the departed, All others salute Hand over Heart 5. Salute ends with canon shot.

Canon Shots: 3 Minimum (End of Anthem, End of Taps or Amazing Grace, End of Ceremony). Clubs may add shots if there is a significant ceremonial reason to do so.






