Hello Neighbors,

Starting on September 1, 2023, Smoky Hill 400 is now being managed by KC & Associates, LLC. Our Community Manager is Kevin Christensen (Kevin.Christensen@kchoa.com). A welcome letter was sent out to the neighborhood that explains how to sign up for the new portal through www.kchoa.com. Our President, Craig Maroney, also included information on the HOA having to start imposing fines for covenant violations. The Fine Policy has not been finalized but the proposed policy is:

- When a violation occurs, the management company will send a **Courtesy Letter** giving the homeowner **15 days** to fix the violation.
- If the violation is not fixed, a **Warning Letter** will be sent giving another **15 days** to fix the violation.
- The final letter is a **Violation Letter** that will be sent via certified mail and fine the homeowner **\$50**. After 30 days, if the violation is still not fixed, the fine will raise by \$25 every 30 days.
