

The Pathogenesis of Fatal Cerebral Malaria: Pieces of the Puzzle

Dr. Terrie Taylor has, with the full support of the Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine, been living and working in Malawi for six months each year since 1986. There, she has coordinated a series of studies into the pathogenesis of fatal cerebral malaria in Malawian children, providing care on the Paediatric Research Ward whilst exploring a series of different hypotheses. She has been fortunate to work with a wide variety of collaborators over the years: neurologists, pathologists, radiologists, ophthalmologists and, most recently, pediatric intensivists. At the same time, she has hosted final year medical students from Michigan State, providing them with an opportunity to care for patients in a vastly different setting. Her work has been recognized by numerous awards over the years. In December of 2024, Dr. Taylor stepped away from the bedside and is now a Senior Advisor to the Dean for Research Initiatives and Global Scholarship.

Conference summary: Beginning in 1986, Drs. Terrie Taylor and Malcolm Molyneux, at the behest of the Malawi Ministry of Health, began studying cerebral malaria in Malawian children. In her lecture, Dr. Taylor will discuss nearly forty years of clinical research during which the team in Malawi has combined bedside observations, autopsy findings, neuroimaging, EEGs and transcranial doppler data to understand how *P. falciparum* kills over 500,000 African children annually. Work on the Paediatric Research Ward produced the Blantyre Coma Score, enshrined in the WHO's clinical case definition of cerebral malaria. The clinicopathological study showed that the standard clinical case definition of cerebral malaria misclassified ~23% of patients --- but when 'malarial retinopathy', a constellation of up to three clinical features observable on ocular funduscopic examination, was included, the specificity of the standard clinical case definition, which misclassifies ~25% of cases, increases to 88%. The autopsy study failed to identify the cause of death in the retinopathy-positive cases of true cerebral malaria, but when magnetic resonance imaging became available, the importance of increased brain volume became apparent. The heterogeneity in this patient population has recently been revealed by transcranial Doppler studies; there are five different clinical phenotypes, suggesting that a single "silver bullet" to treat increased brain volume is unlikely. Potential mechanisms underlying the TCD phenotypes and potential treatments will be discussed. The puzzle is nearing completion, but work remains to be done.

From Touch to Action: Neural Circuit Mechanisms of Tactile Processing and Behavior

Andrew Michael Seeds, PhD

Dr. Andrew Michael Seeds is an Associate Professor at the Institute of Neurobiology at the University of Puerto Rico Medical Sciences Campus, where he investigates how neurons in the brain connect to produce complex behavior. After earning his Ph.D. in Pharmacology from Duke University, Dr. Seeds conducted postdoctoral research at Janelia Research Campus of Howard Hughes Medical Institute, uncovering fundamental mechanisms of sensorimotor processing and behavioral sequencing. His lab integrates genetic, imaging, and computational tools to map and manipulate neural pathways that control highly coordinated grooming actions, shedding light on how networks in the brain orchestrate animal movement. A recipient of multiple grants, including a BRAIN Initiative award, Dr. Seeds is also a dedicated mentor and conference organizer, advancing the frontiers of neurobiology while fostering the growth of the next generation of scientists.

Conference summary:

How does the body translate a simple touch into a precise, location-specific response? This process involves the activation of specialized neural circuits, starting with sensory neurons that detect mechanical stimuli and progressing to the processing networks that integrate this information and generate appropriate behavioral responses. In our work, we investigate these circuits in detail, using tools like synaptic resolution electron microscopy, live imaging, and computational modelling to map the flow of activity and connectivity through these pathways. By studying these processes in fruit flies—an ideal model system for exploring neural circuit function—we uncover insights into the fundamental mechanisms that govern how the nervous system processes touch and drives behavior.

Essential Competencies for Public Health Teaching: A Regional Framework for the Americas

Gabriel Listovsky holds a bachelor's degree in educational sciences, a specialization in Trainer Training, and a master's degree in public health, all from the University of Buenos Aires, Argentina. He has extensive international experience in adult education within the workforce. He has worked as an instructional designer, tutor, and coordinator of various virtual education projects, with a particular focus on training healthcare personnel. He previously served as Director of Training and Development

at the Ministry of Health of the Government of the City of Buenos Aires. Currently, he is the Head of the Special Program for the Virtual Campus of Public Health within the Department of Health Systems and Services at the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO). The Virtual Campus of Public Health (VCPh) is PAHO's educational platform. Its mission is to lead strategic collaborative efforts among Member States and other partners in the Americas to promote human resource training in health, ensuring access to education for everyone, everywhere. Lic. Listovsky also contributed to the development of the Regional Framework of Teaching Competencies in Public Health.

Conference summary:

The Regional Framework of Teaching Competencies in Public Health is a joint initiative of the Virtual Campus for Public Health of the Pan American Health Organization and the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health. This conference aims to present the collaborative process, the working methodology, and the resulting competencies that make up the framework, with the goal of promoting regional training practices in public health through the development of transversal competencies among educators. These competencies seek to foster debates and connect regional thinking and action in public and collective health with a transdisciplinary and participatory vision. The Regional Framework of Teaching Competencies in Public Health was developed through an iterative consultation process involving 123 experts from public health institutions and schools, primary care professionals, and pedagogy and teaching specialists from 19 Latin American countries. The framework consolidates 10 domains and 40 essential competencies, which are offered as a regional tool to be used from multiple perspectives.

Community Outreach for Health Across the Lifetime: Our Path to Action Oriented Transdisciplinary Research

Dr. Maribel Campos Rivera is a board-certified physician-scientist in Pediatrics, Neonatal and Perinatal Medicine, Obesity Medicine, and Lifestyle Medicine, with expertise in healthcare administration and clinical research. A Robert Wood Johnson Interdisciplinary Research Leaders alumna, she has over 20 years of experience in clinical and translational research. She founded the Center for Community Outreach for Health Across the Lifespan at the UPR School of Dental Medicine and has mentored trainees to address social determinants of health. Her research focuses on fetal and early childhood exposures and their lifelong health effects. She has led community health initiatives, spoken at the White House Conference on Hunger, and serves on the President's Council on Sports, Fitness, and Nutrition. Formerly a NICU Medical Director, she founded Emerge, a public benefit corporation for integrated family-centered healthcare.

Conference summary:

As a Physician Scientist with a broad network of collaborators, Dr. Maribel Campos-Rivera has led and/or collaborated with the implementation of research to transform health services. Her contributions range from achieving the only Neonatal Intensive Care Unit with rooming-in services in Puerto Rico, leading an interdisciplinary team of volunteers deployed to provide services during the aftermath of Irma and Maria while supporting government agencies in the development of and adaptation of their action plans to address the needs of the communities we serve. Her focus on the developmental origins of health and disease has provided a framework for her contributions to research across the lifespan and her partnership with community-based organizations to develop and implement action-oriented projects. Our contributions to the Voices for Healthy Kids efforts to inform the campaign to improve existing food security programs deepened the narrative and dissemination strategies used by the Institute for Youth Development and Furia, Inc. as partners of the advocacy program. She is the Principal Investigator of Semilla, a transdisciplinary STEM+M capacity-building program that has been implemented in partnership with the Mayo Clinic and Boys and Girls Clubs of Puerto Rico. This work has provided the opportunity for stakeholders of diverse age groups, affiliations, and backgrounds to join as members of the SemillaPR Community to address the impact of toxic stress for all.

Bridging the Evidence Gap to Support Healthcare Decision Making: The Case for Observational Studies

Dr. Homero A. Monsanto holds a B.S. in Pharmacy from the University of Puerto Rico, an M.S. and Ph.D. in Pharmacy Administration from Purdue University, and an Advanced Certificate in Health and Public Policy from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County. He began his career as a community pharmacist and later joined the faculty of the UPR School of Pharmacy, where he is now a Professor (Ad Honorem). He worked at

Merck & Co., Inc. as Outcomes Research Manager and later as Director of Market Access for Puerto Rico and the Caribbean. In 2014, he transitioned to regional roles in Latin America, supporting observational studies on vaccine-preventable diseases, diabetes, and infectious diseases. After retiring in 2022, he now collaborates with the UPR School of Pharmacy, VOCES Puerto Rico, and the Master of Public Health program at Ponce Health Sciences University.

Conference summary:

Real-world evidence (RWE) is increasingly being used to bridge the gap between evidence generation and actionable decision-making, such as regulatory and reimbursement decisions for new technologies. RWE studies use existing data to answer research questions. They are used as a complement to randomized clinical trials (RCTs) to generate deeper insights into treatment effectiveness, expand findings to broader patient populations, and improve decision-making across diverse settings. This presentation will highlight the importance of real-world observational studies in addressing public healthcare problems by providing examples of different types of studies that can be conducted within the evidence ecosystem, discussing their advantages and limitations, and describing tools for their evaluation. The presentation will end with a few examples drawn from observational studies conducted in Puerto Rico.

The Role of Research in Improving Health: Type 2 Diabetes in 2025 – A Global Disease

Dominic Reeds, MD

Dr. Dominic Reeds received his undergraduate degree in biochemistry from the University of Texas at Austin. He completed his doctorate in medicine at Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center and his residency and chief residency in Internal Medicine at the University of Rochester, New York. He subsequently completed a fellowship in endocrinology, diabetes and metabolism at Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis, Missouri in 2003. Dr Reeds has several NIH grants centered on workforce development, training, and diabetes prevention and management within the United States and globally. He is nationally known for his expertise in diabetes and nutrition.

Conference summary:

Type 2 diabetes has ceased being a disease of affluent, high-income countries and is emerging as a major health threat. This condition afflicts 500 million people globally and will increase to 750 million by 2045. Unfortunately type 2 diabetes is increasing not only in young people but in low- and middle-income countries (LMIC); indeed, % of people with diabetes live in LMICs For more than 70 years, type 2 diabetes has been viewed as a disease caused by obesity and inactivity however recent studies show that this is a heterogeneous disease with a variety of causes in differing populations. In order to address this emerging epidemic, there will have to be a global commitment to increase the number of healthcare workers and efforts to train researchers to better understand the causes of type 2 diabetes in differing populations. This workforce will require skillsets ranging from basic cellular methods to implementation studies. Dr. Reeds will discuss differing presentations of type 2 diabetes from across the globe, the underlying pathophysiology and the unanswered questions of this global emergency. He will also discuss training opportunities and pathways for scholars interested in becoming engaged in research in diabetes and nutrition.
