

Our Grandfather, Carlo Gelardi By Anna Murphy & Toni Wootten

Our grandfather, Carlo Gelardi, was born in Sciacca, Sicily and immigrated to the United States with his family to San Francisco. He learned his trade as a fisherman from his father. In 1906 at the age of 23 he married our grandmother Accursia (Augusta) LaRocca and together they raised twelve children. For many years they all lived on Chestnut Street in flats in North Beach area of San Francisco.

His boat, the *Josie G*, was named after his youngest daughter. It was purchased around 1936 and used until he purchased the *Baby Carl* in 1960. He went out fishing with his sons, Calie and Dotty, in Bodega Bay, Point Reyes, Santa Cruz and Monterey areas. They would often go out for many days or even weeks at a time and fish for salmon or crab. Not an easy way to make a living.

Our grandfather, with his ruddy complexion spoke "broken" English and was very hard working. His mustache would feel scratchy when he kissed our checks. He always had a smile for his many grandchildren. He managed to purchase flats on Bay Street so he could walk down to Fisherman's Wharf because he never learned to drive. His garage was filled with crab traps; orange buoys hung from hooks and he was constantly repairing heavy fishing nets. He grew vegetables in his very small but well-maintained garden and there was always a small wooden box filled with fresh parsley. The scent of his homemade wine and vinegar that he stored in large oak barrels in his dark cellar still lingers in our memories.

One of our favorite memories was gathering all the family at his house during crab season for a huge cioppino dinner. I remember him coming home with huge buckets of live crabs and clams. We had a feast with plenty of pasta and lots of French bread for dipping. With our little cousins we would collect the crab claws as "weapons" and chase each other through the hall. We also loved to color the clamshells.


