CURRENT BYLAW

PROPOSAL TO CHANGE BYLAW TO

Article IV Section 4: TERM

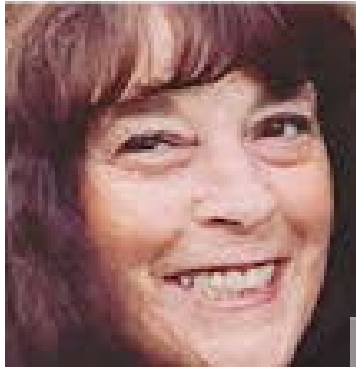

BARBARA VALLE –Being a member of IAWG since 2018 and on the Board of Directors for the past four years, has been my pleasure to work with so many amazing Ladies.

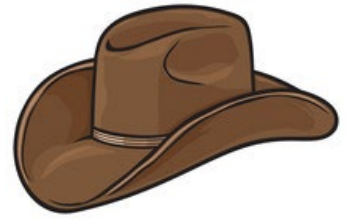
