BY LAW PROPOSAL BALLOT FORM

ARTICLE IV SECTION 4: TERM

CURRENT BY LAW

The term of office shall be for one (1) year. No Officer or Board member shall serve in the same position for more than ~~two (2)~~ consecutive years. A member may run again for Officer or Board position one year after the end of their completed term.

PROPOSAL TO AMEND BY LAW TO

The term of office shall be for one (1) year. No Officer or Board member shall serve in the same position for more than **three (3)** consecutive years. A member may run again for Officer or Board position one year after the end of their completed term.

The positions of Secretary and Treasurer require specialized duties and a term limit for these positions shall not apply.
