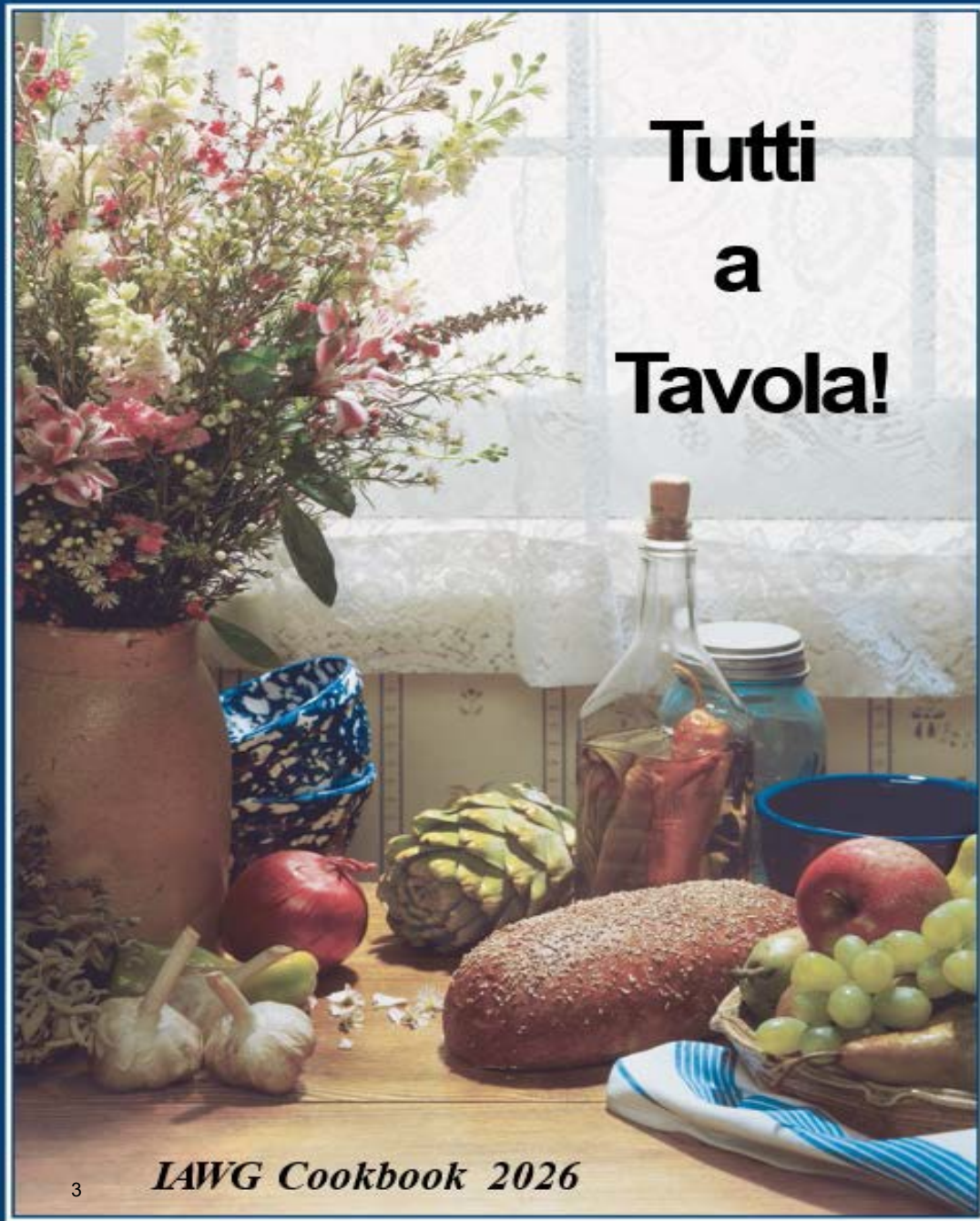

2026 IAWG Scholarship Recipients

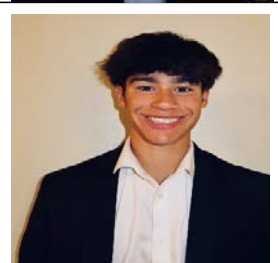
It is with great pleasure to introduce the 2026 IAWG Scholarship Recipients.



Gabriella Belforte - My name is Gabriella Belforte, and I will be attending Gonzaga University this fall where I will pursue a degree in Communication Studies!



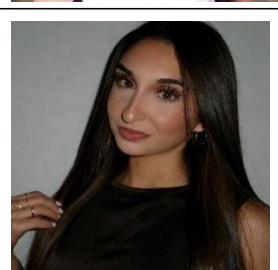

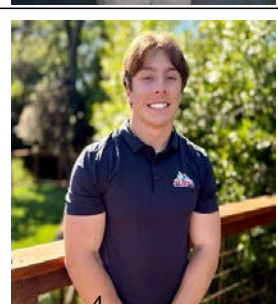

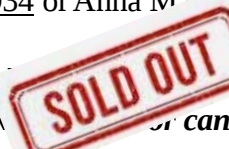
