

The Italian American Women's Guild extends sincere sympathy to the family of Karen Casazza. Karen was the first president of the Guild, 1995-1996, and very instrumental in the formation of the Guild.

Karen was born in Canada, June 15, 1944 and was one of 12 siblings. When she was 18yrs. old she emigrated to the U.S. She went to work at The Arthur Murray Dance Studio and there she met her future husband, Renzo Casazza. Eventually they married and made a home in San Mateo.

When the idea for an Italian Women's Club was born, Karen took the lead. She met with an attorney for legal advice and write by laws, advice on Calif. club status, an accountant on club finances, etc. She established a choir and spent many hours practicing with the rest of the choir members, they sang at our Christmas Dinners, retirement/nursing homes, Filoli and many other places in the Peninsula. She was very involved in our first Christmas Boutique. Needless to say, Karen was more than generous with her time and talents to help grow our Guild. When her husband became ill, they moved to Vacaville to be near their son.

When Renzo passed away, Karen remained in Vacaville. The last few years Karen had been in ill health and on September 23, 2024 she passed away. We honor her memory and thank her for her role in helping to make the Italian American Women's Guild a reality. She is survived by her daughter Lisa and her family, son Michael and his family.

May she rest in Peace.






