1. Attorney and former Prince George's County State's Attorney.
2. Believes in a hands-off approach and just appointing people, then making excuses for failures. Focuses most on desires of real estate developers.
3. Just recently mentioned, for the first time, that citizens might be able to invest in the project in Cheverly, but only said maybe franchises, not the larger more lucrative building projects.
4. Kept silent about the cams, until a citizen in handcuffs was shot in a police cruiser. Even now, only a small number of officers have the cams. Asked the former chief to stay on, but he later resigned in connection with a Federal Investigation.
5. Claims to support reform in law enforcement, but after 8 years as State's Attorney and almost 4 years as County Executive, no results are evident.
6. Now claims to support an elected School Board, only after her appointed Chair created a more toxic environment.
7. Quiet on prayer back in schools.
8. Reportedly accepted nearly \$2 million from real estate developers since 2018.
