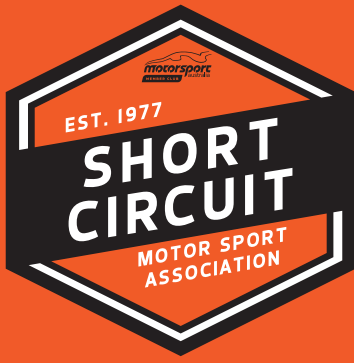
CARNELL RACEWAY WORKING BEE
