



RD 1 2023 QLD-NSW SPRINT CHALLENGE & RD 1 2023 SHORT CIRCUIT TOURING CAR SERIES 11th – 12th FEBRUARY 2023 FURTHER REGULATIONS To be read in conjunction with the Supplementary Regulations for the event.

1 AUTHORITY:

The event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules of the Motorsport Australia, the Superpsrint Standing Regulations, the Short Circuit Standing Regulations, the Short Circuit Vehicle Regulations, Short Circuit General Regulations, the Supplementary Regulations these Further Regulations and any further regulations or instructions which may be issued in respect to Motorsport Australia Permit Number **423/1202/02**.

The Speed Event Standing Regulations refers only to the super sprints. The Short Circuit Standing Regulations, Vehicle Regulations and General Regulations refer only to the short circuit.

7 JUDGES OF FACT:

(e) The Clerk of the Course shall be deemed to Judges of Fact in respect to drifting.

8 START:

Please Note: Access to Morgan Park will be from 2.00 pm on Friday afternoon.

The event will commence at **9.00 a.m**. and will conclude at approximately 5.00 p.m. on Saturday 11th February 2023 and will continue from **8.00 a.m**. until approx. 3.00 p.m. on Sunday 12th February 2023.

9 ENTRIES

Competitors are required to report to the Administration area at the Control Tower to finalise any documentation issues and collect their information packs and hired transponders.

No Motorsport Australia licences will be issued on the day.

Camping ids and Sheds have been allocated to those who have paid with their entry. Competitors can still pay for camping or hire a shed on the weekend. Please read the attached Note (1)

12 SCRUTINY CHECK IN:

Competitors are required to complete a Scrutiny Check which will be held at the Morgan Park, Warwick from 2.30 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday 10th February 2023 and on Saturday 11th February 2023 from 7.00 a.m. to 8.00 a.m. however, vehicles may be checked outside of these times at the discretion of the Clerk of Course and Chief Scrutineer.

If required special arrangements can be made with the chief scrutineer for Sunday scrutiny.

13 DRIVERS BRIEFING:

The compulsory attendance of all drivers is required at the driver's briefing to be held at the base of the Control Tower on Saturday 11th February 2023 at 8.30 a.m. and Sunday 12th February 2023 at 7.30 a.m.

While drivers will not be required to sign on at the briefings the names of those who should be attending will be called out by a member of the administration staff and checked against an attendance sheet. A penalty will be imposed on competitors failing to attend the driver's briefing,

Note: Covid 19 Social distancing protocols are to be observed at the briefings.

14 INSURANCE::

Third Party Insurance: All competing vehicles carrying civil registration in Queensland require a Third Party extension certificate or letter (CTP) stating the full title of the event, location and date.

The extension document is to be brought to the event. A registered vehicle will not be allowed to run without the extension.

17 SPRINT EVENT:

The Sprint event will be run the 1500m or 2100m track over the weekend. Competitors will be advised at the drivers briefing which track is to be used.

19 TIMING:

For those who wish to hire timing transponder the hire rate is \$20.00 per unit, **<u>plus</u>** a security deposit of **\$140.00** which is to be lodged on issue of the transponder. This now can be paid by providing your credit card details*.

*To minimize the handling of cash, competitors, on collection of their hired transponders, will be given a security deposit form on which they can record their credit card details. The form will be placed in the envelope provided which will be given back to the competitor when the transponder is returned at the end of competition.

Transponders will be available for sale.

Please Read Note (2) re Transponders

PLACEMENT OF TRANSPONDERS

Competitors must supply their own cable (zip) ties suitable to attach the transponder to the vehicle. Transponders must be placed on the vehicle so it has a direct line of sight to the ground. Each driver must have a separate transponder and only **one** transponder is to be on or in the competing vehicle at any time.

29 PENALTIES:

Drifting is not allowed. Any competitor drifting during competition may be excluded from the event. Any driver, considered by the Clerk of the Course in consultation with the Stewards, driving in an unsportsmanlike manner will be excluded from the event.

33 APPAREL:

Competitors are reminded that the use a Frontal Head Restraint is now a mandatory requirement for competitors of certain vehicle types and categories in Speed Events. These are outlined in the Motorsport Australia Manual.

37 GENERAL:

Catering will be available during the weekend. The Canteen will be open for Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning.

END OF FURTHER REGULATIONS

COMPETITORS NOTES:

(1) **Camping -** Those crews who have paid for their camping will be issued with a band at documentation that must be displayed on the door of your van, camper or tent.

Those people who wish to camp and have not paid with their entry must come to the event secretary's office and fill out a camping disclaimer and pay the \$30.00 fee.

Sheds - Those people who wish to hire a shed and have not paid for one with their entry must come to the event secretary's office and fill out a shed hire form and pay the \$60.00 fee,

(2) Transponders-

At this round you will be able to purchase a transponder; however, we will still be providing the opportunity for rental.

If you wish to purchase a transponder with warranty the cost is \$165.00. If you wish to buy one over the weekend they can be purchased from the event secretary's office.

We also provide a replacement battery service for \$20.00.

(3) COVID 9

This event is being run under the Motorsport Australia Return to Race and Queensland Health Covid management protocols. It is the responsibility of every person to do the right thing and be Covid safe.
